chirp hurt


These are words that you will see in this story and many other stories. You will want to learn them as well.



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
Hi, I am Dora.

What do you think it is?




We found a baby bird.

Maybe she needs our help.


What should we do first?




Are you hurt, Baby Bird?

We can search for her.




Baby Bird chirps.
