

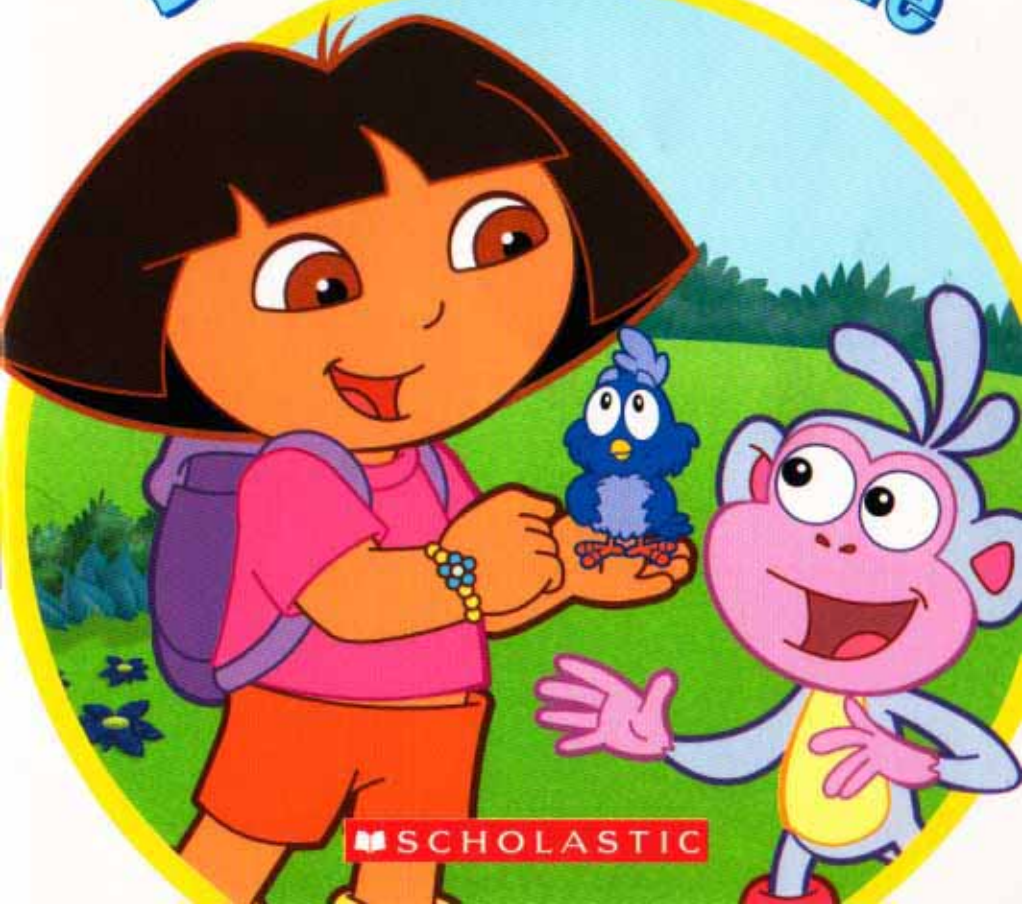

In this story, you can learn all about the "r"-controlled vowel sound. Here are some words to sound out.

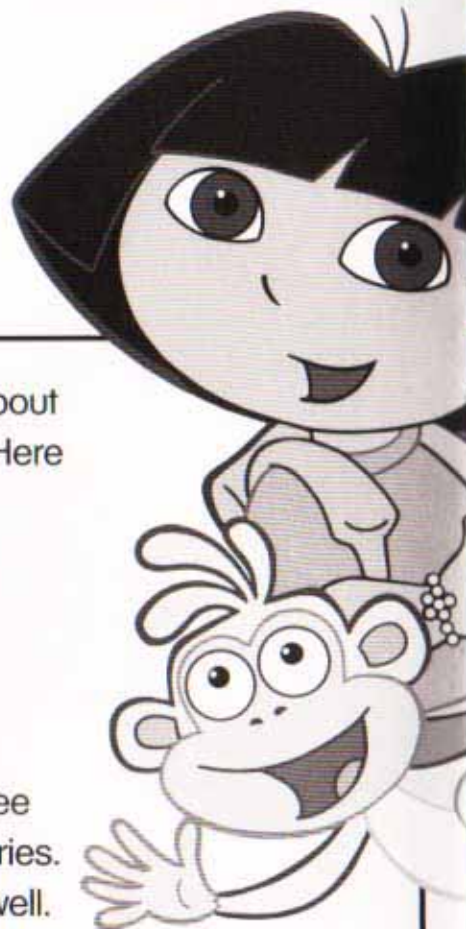

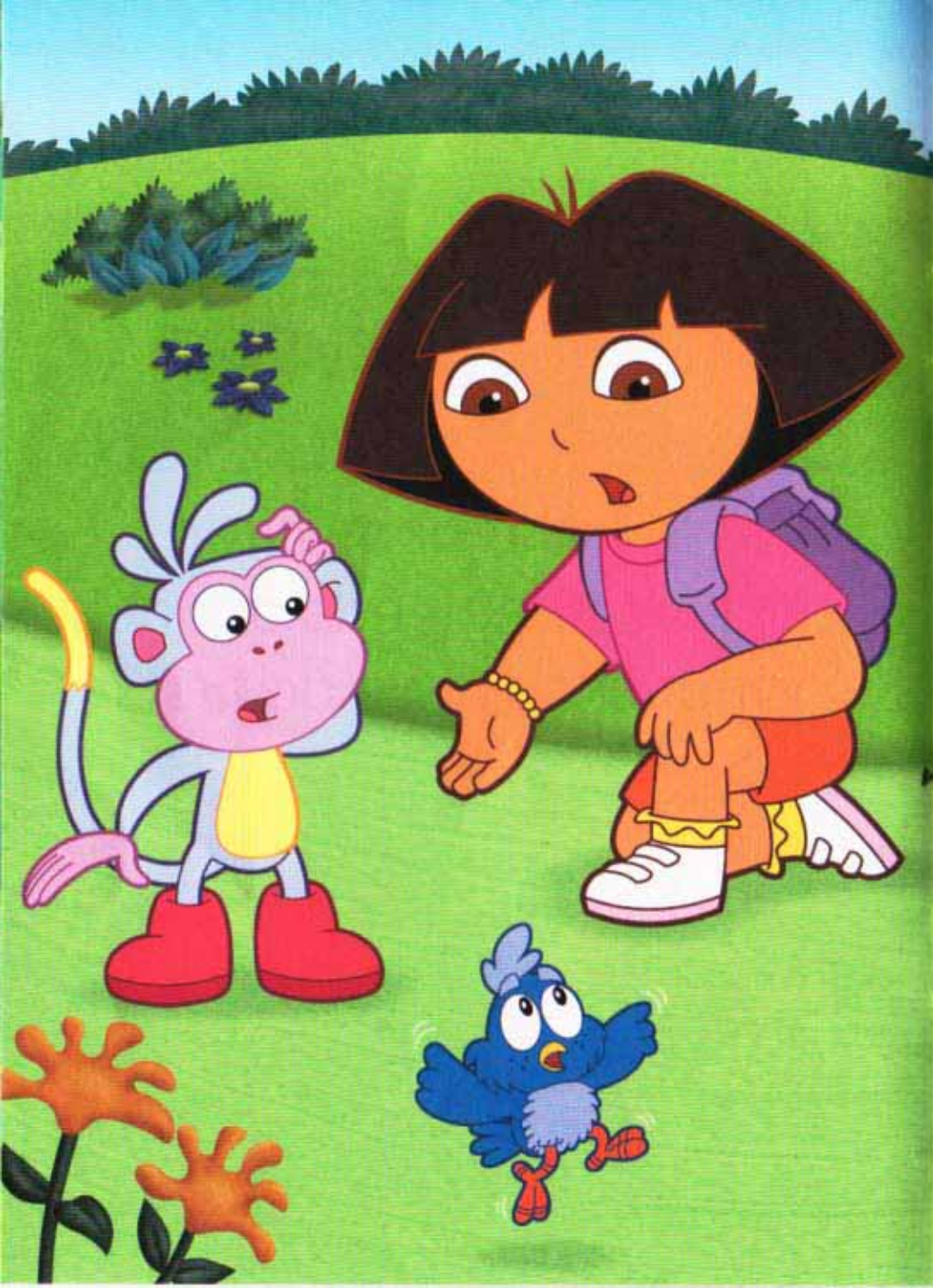
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Hi, I am Dora.
