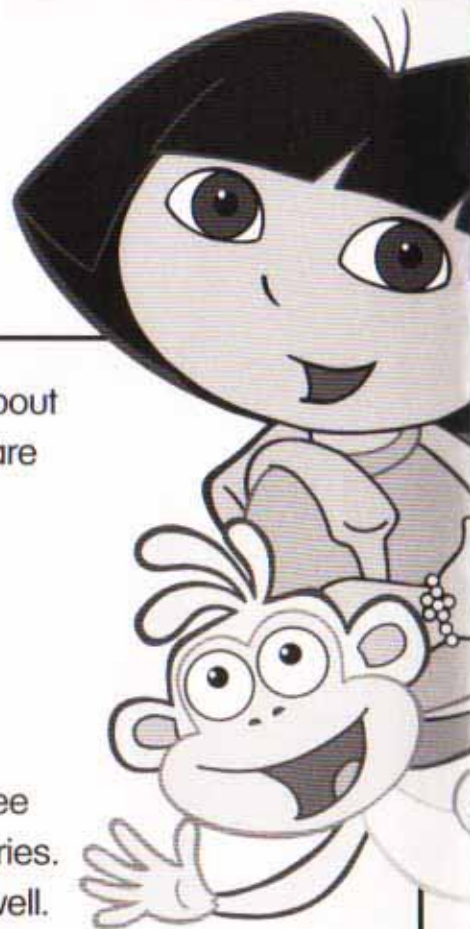

all the way!



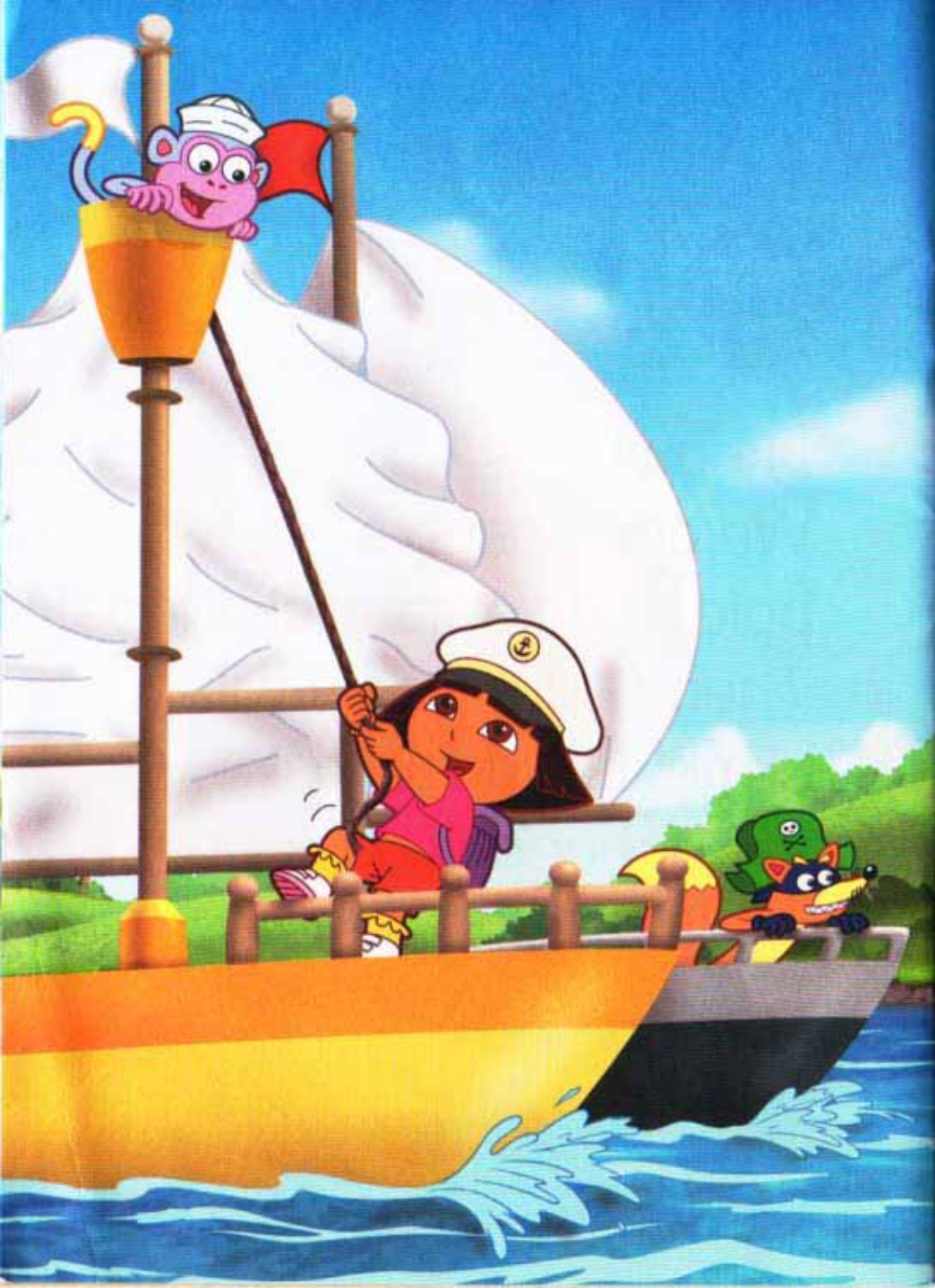
Oh, no!
