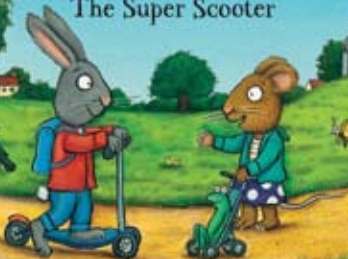
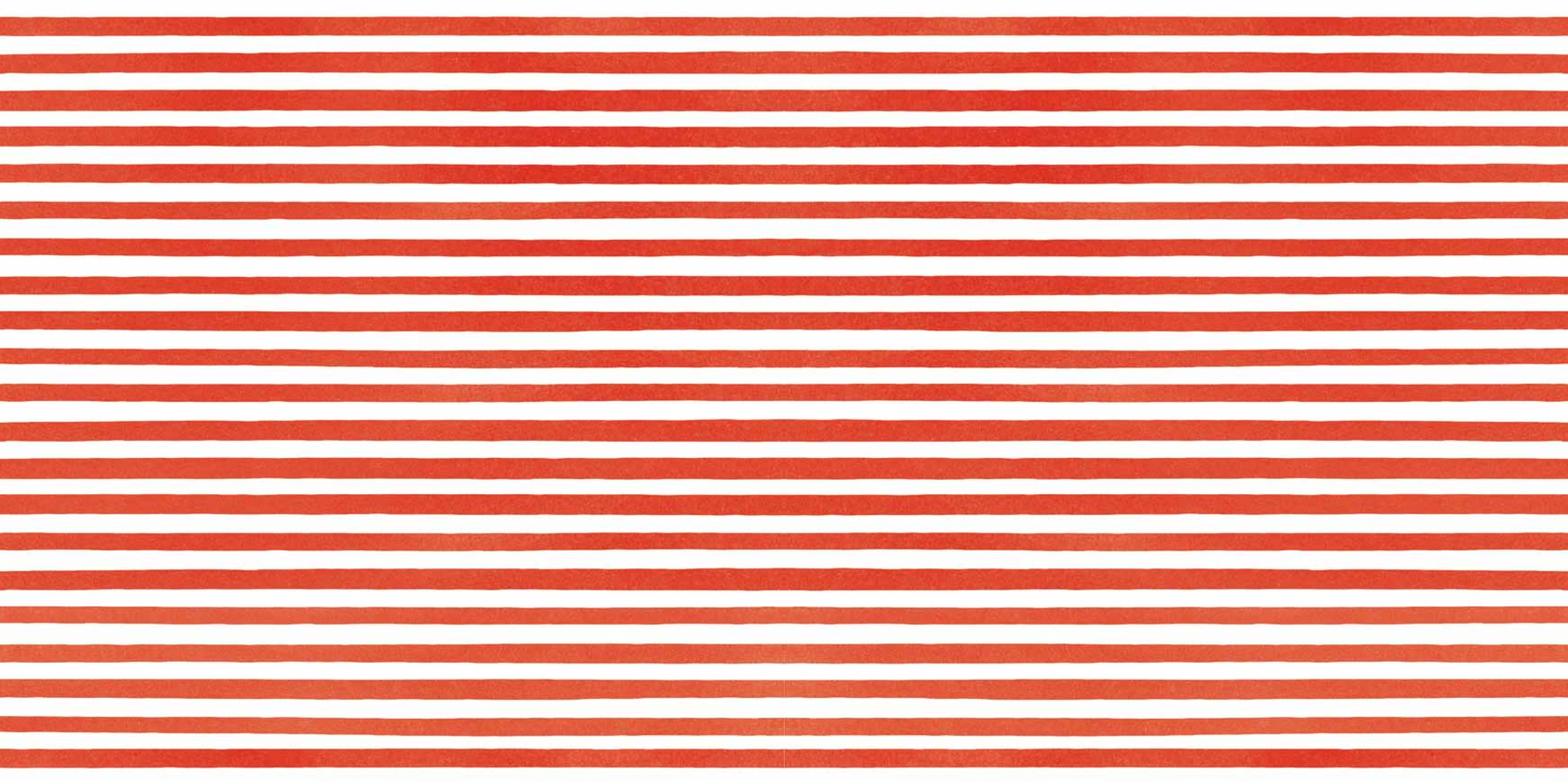

## The Super Scooter

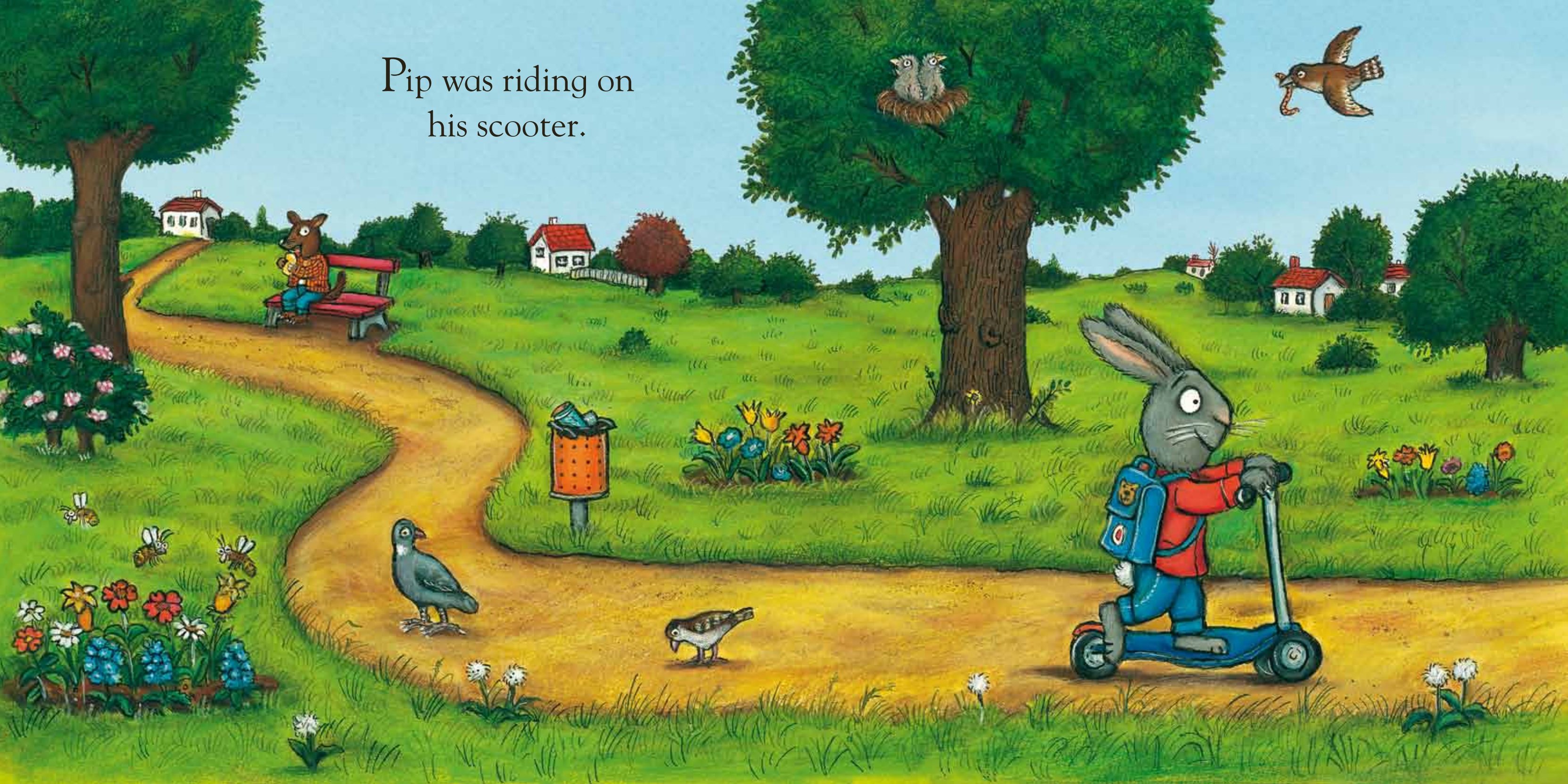

He went up,



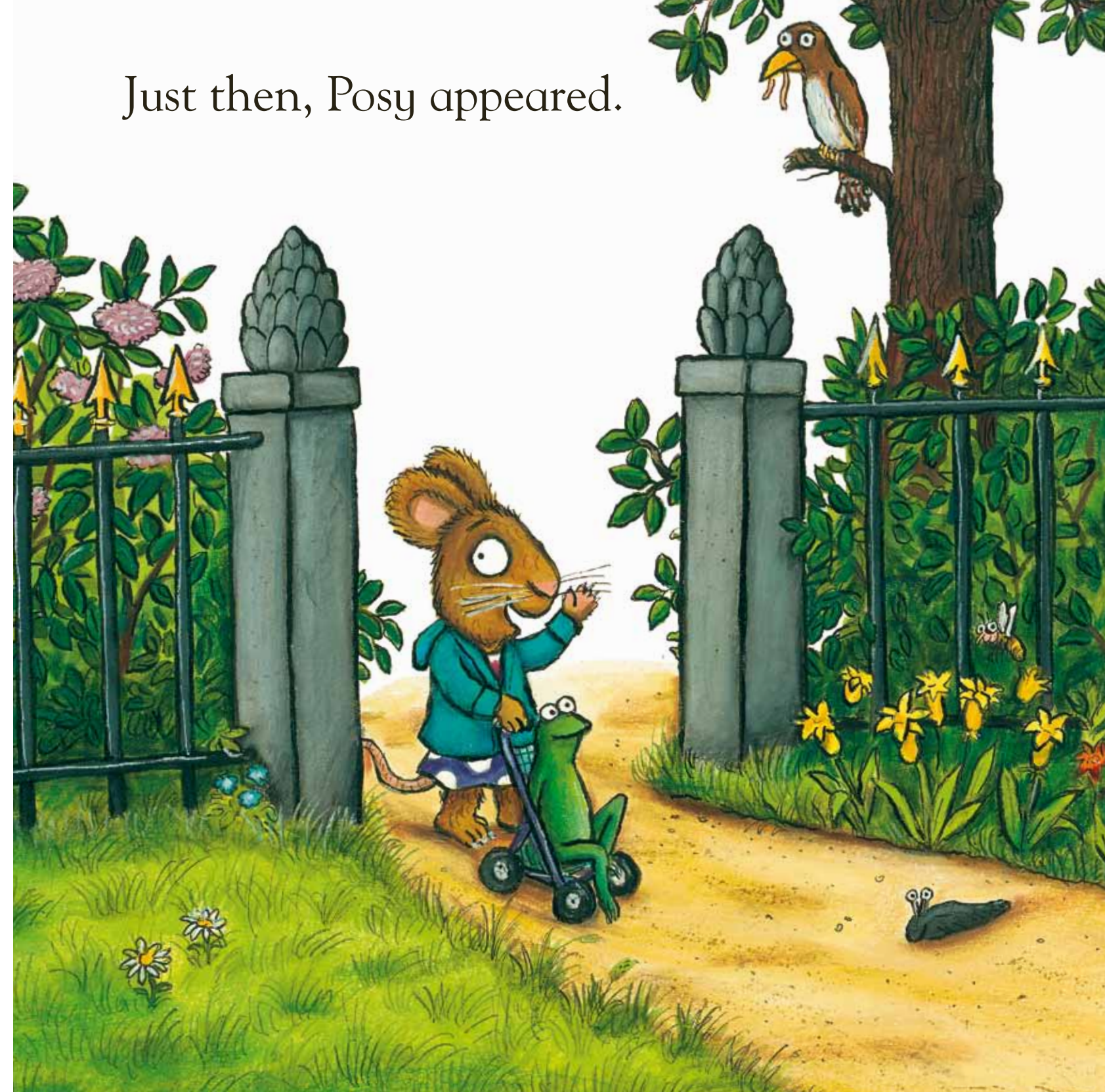
he went down,

“Thank you for looking after me.”





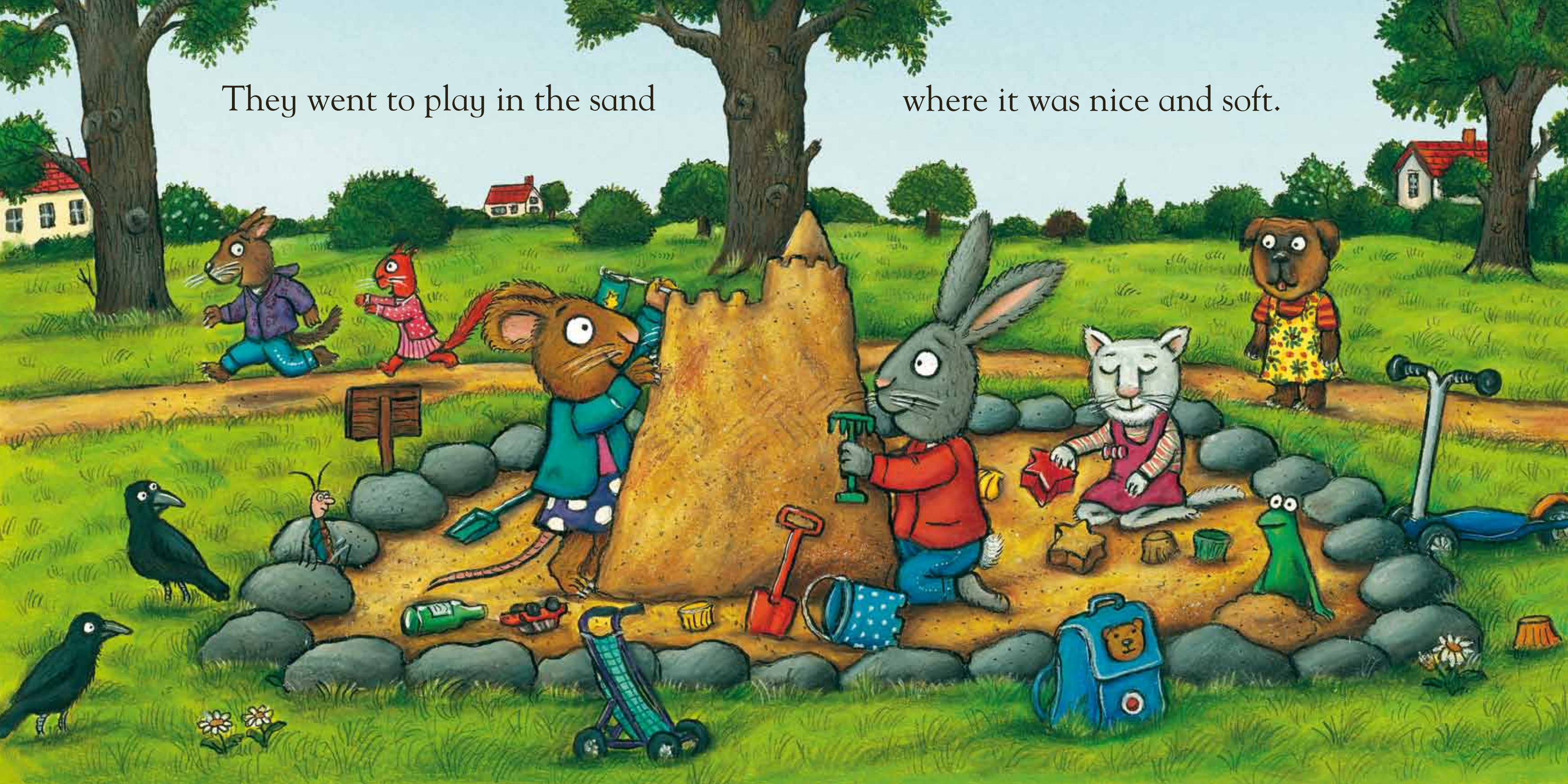
Pip and Posy had a **big hug**.
