








Jake sat down and read his book. After a few minutes, a nurse came and called Jake's name.

It became tighter and tighter as it filled with air.



"That's healthy!" said the nurse.




Then she took Jake's temperature [TEM-pur-a-chure] using a thermometer [ther-MOM-i-ter].






Dr. Hill checked Jake's ears, nose, and mouth.

"This light helps me to see if there are any infections [in-FEK-shunz]," Dr. Hill said. "I'm also checking your teeth."




Dr. Hill checked different parts of Jake's body. "These all look and feel healthy," she said. "Do you exercise every day?"


"I ride my bicycle," said Jake. "Do you wear a helmet?" asked Dr. Hill. Jake nodded.




"Now I'll check how well you can hear and see," said Dr. Hill. Jake put on some earphones.




