





I have to be careful that my route doesn't include any low bridges. Do you know why?




Can you see where the two ends of the bus join? Rubber curtains, or concertinas, keep it covered.








In some countries like Pakistan and the Philippines people decorate their buses by adding colors, decals, or special parts.
