CAB



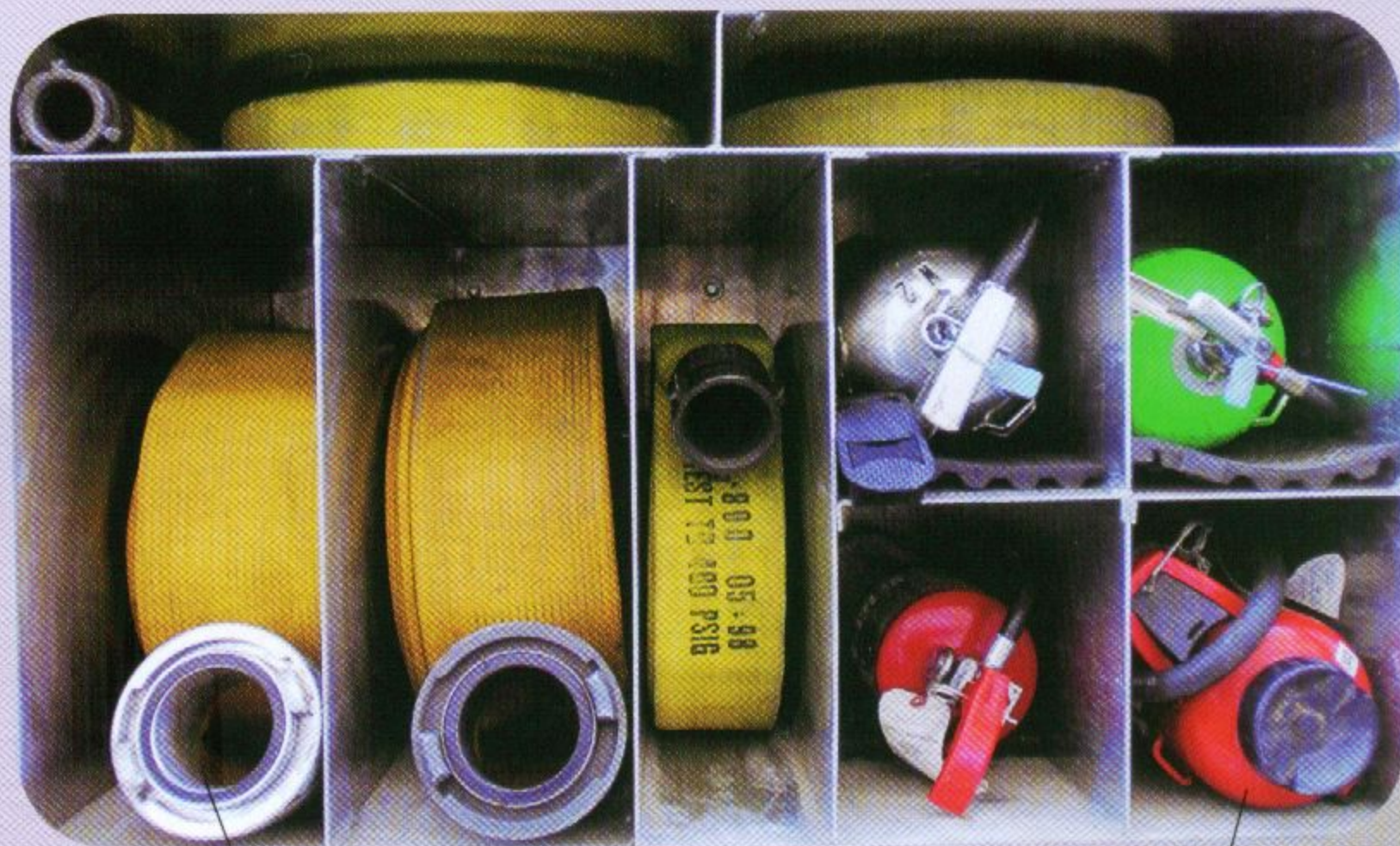
I AM A FIRE TRUCK

My rescue team unload just what they need, then set out on foot to help.



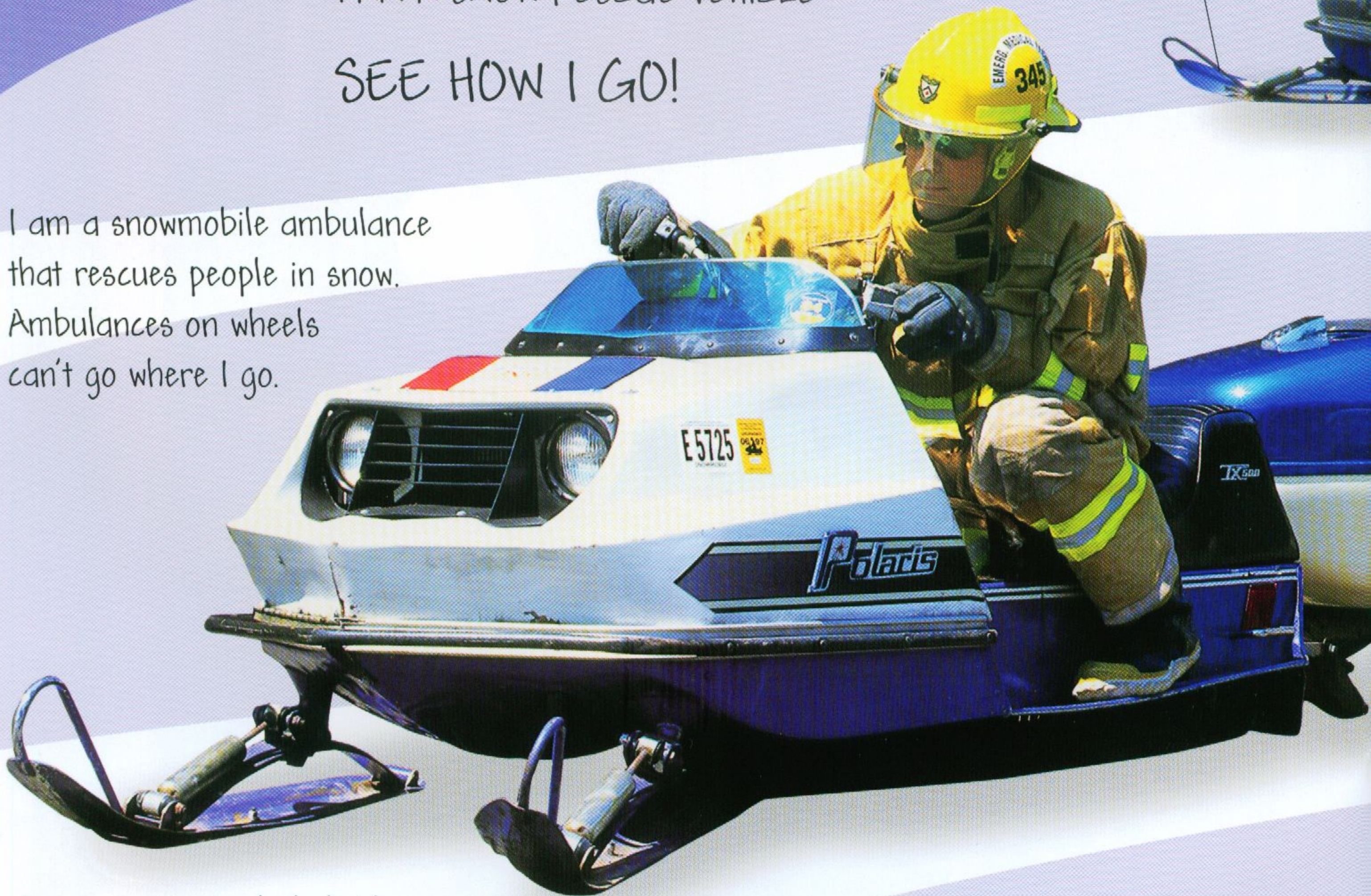


# Snowmobile

Sometimes a friendly snowplow helps clear my route.

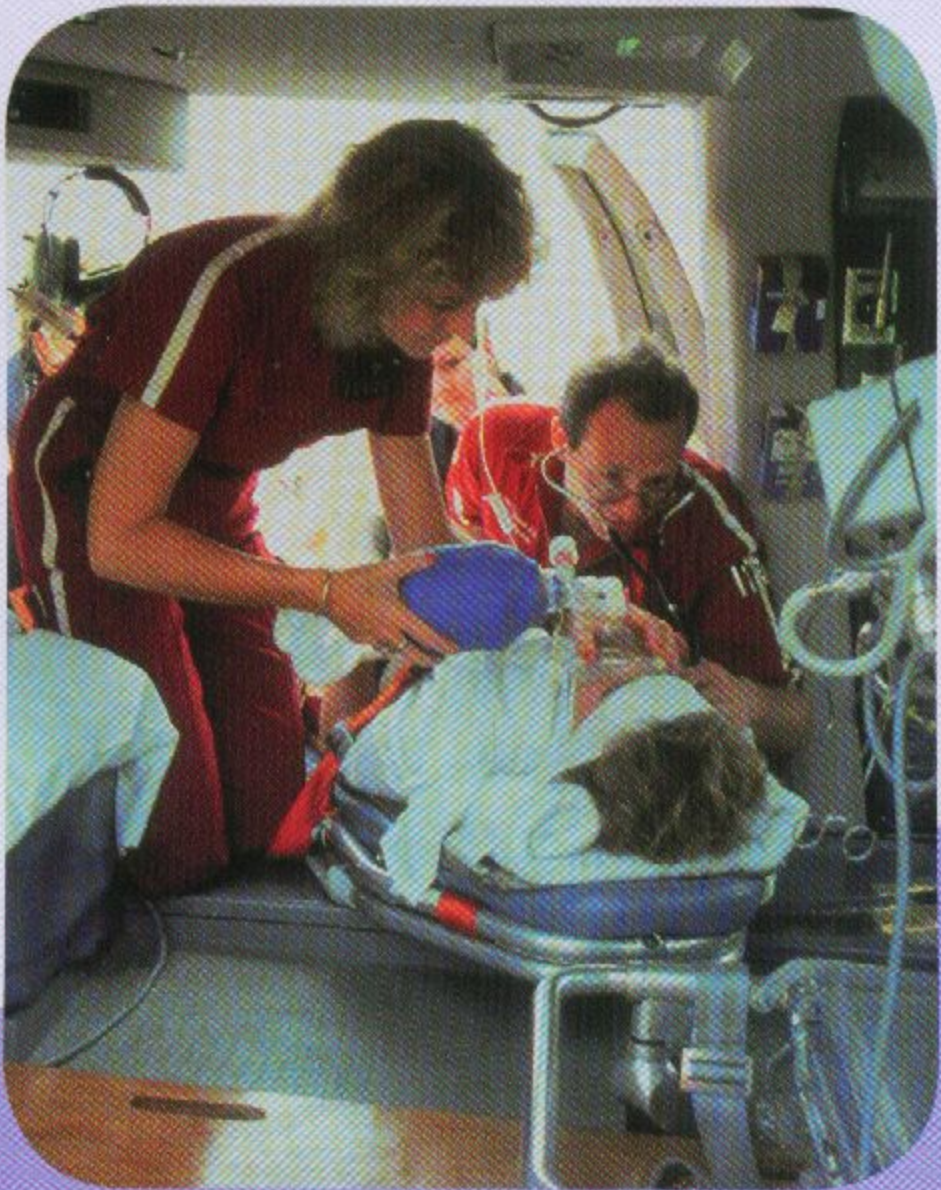




# Helicopter helper

SEE HOW I GO!



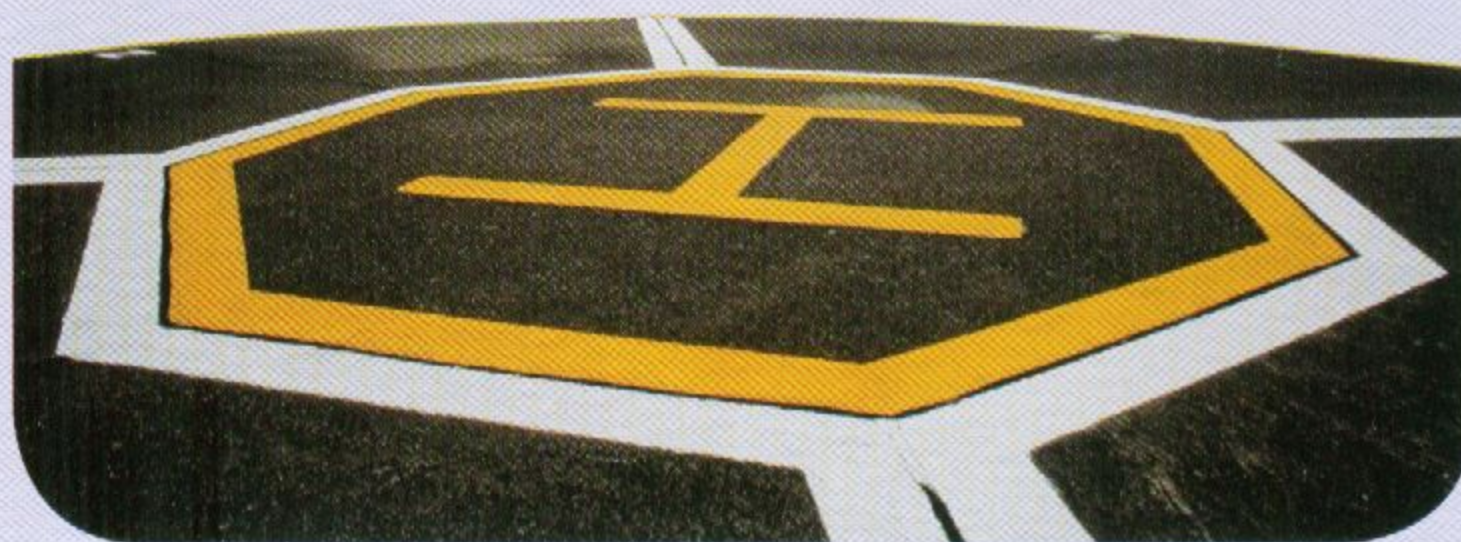
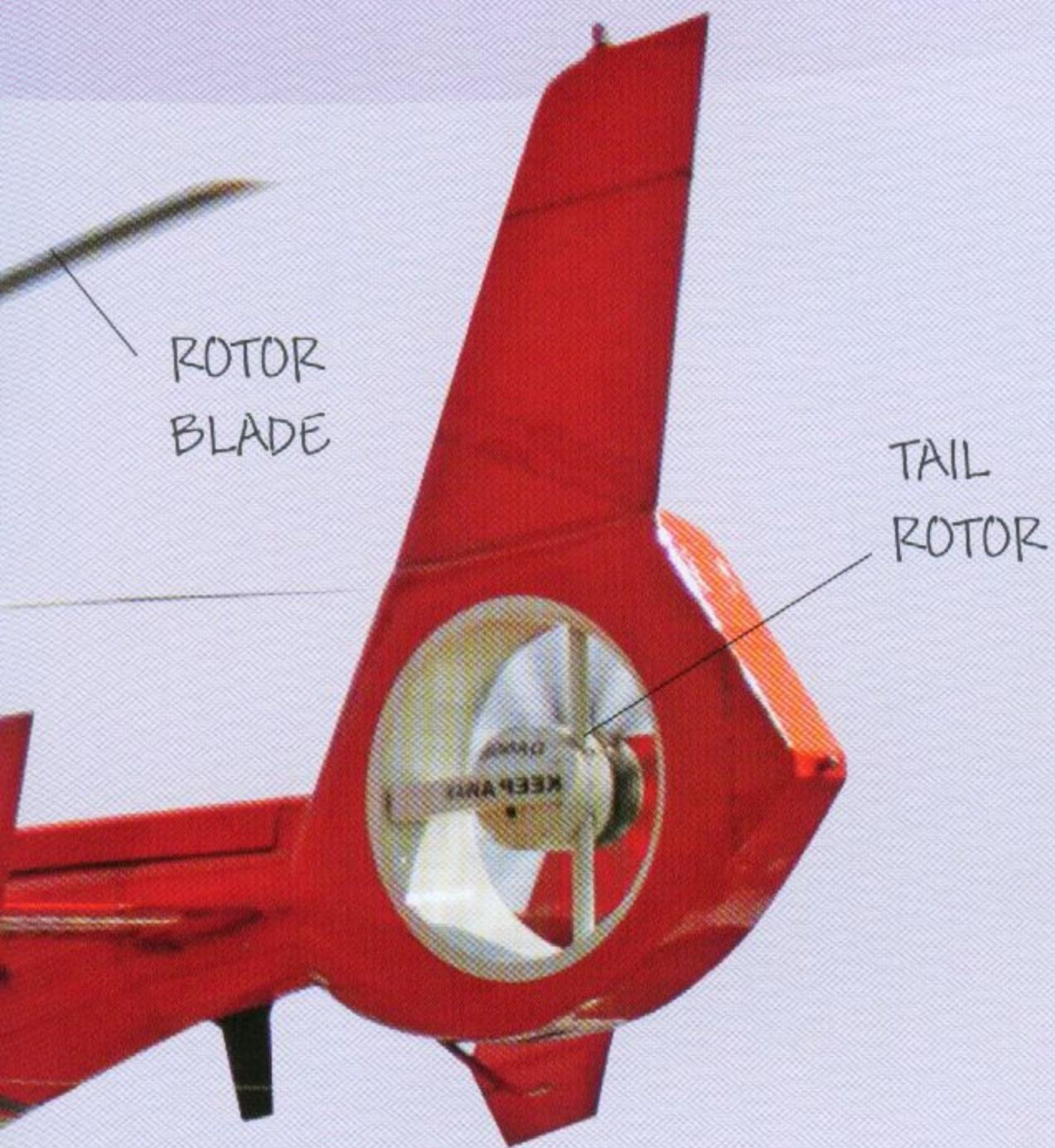
LANDING
