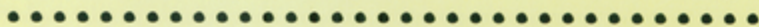

I love to race on banked tracks like this one. Often races are 200 laps long and the leading car changes many times.



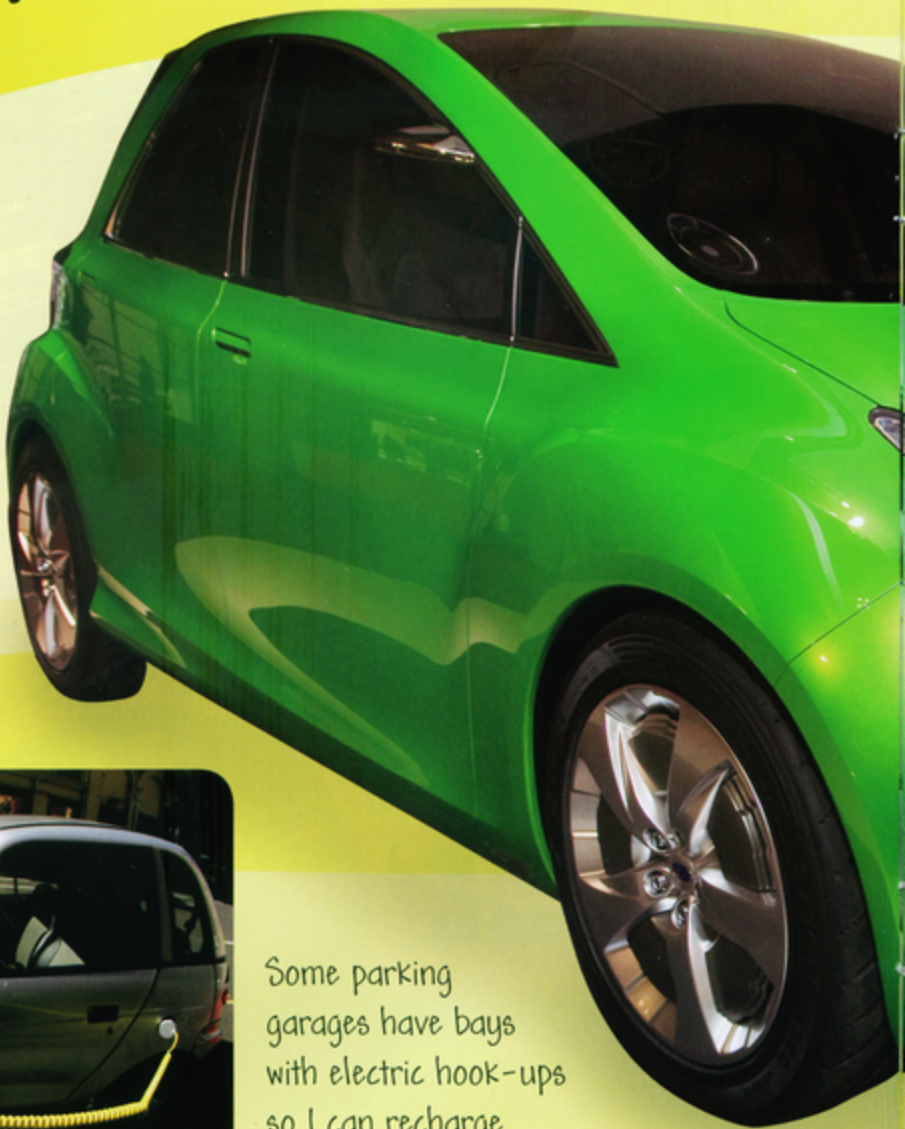
My tires wear out after only 50 miles. I make a pit stop so my mechanic can change them.

I AM A SOLAR CAR

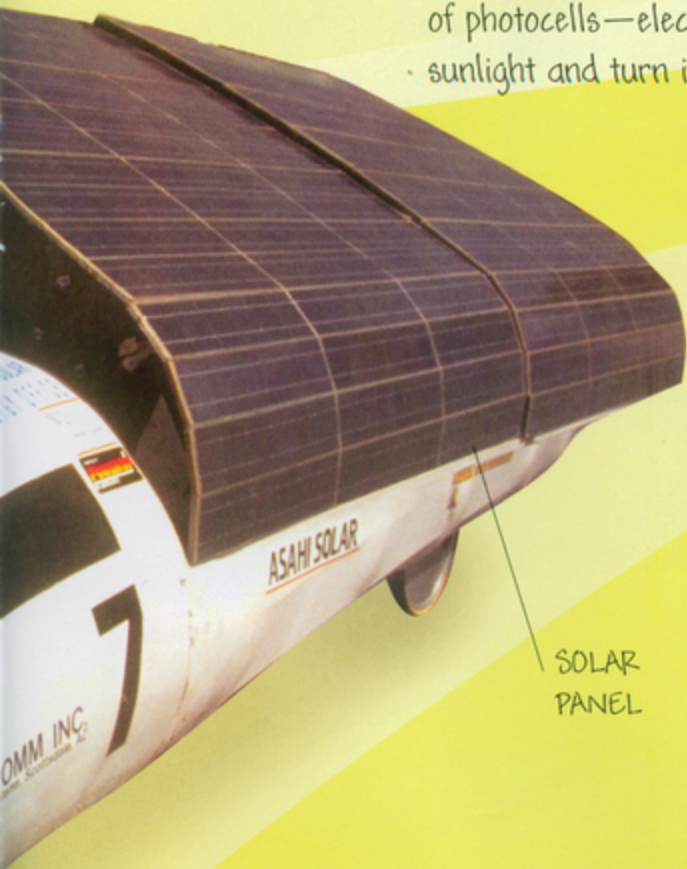
SEE HOW I GO!

I am an electric car that uses sunlight to recharge my batteries. In sunny weather, I can keep going without having to stop for power.

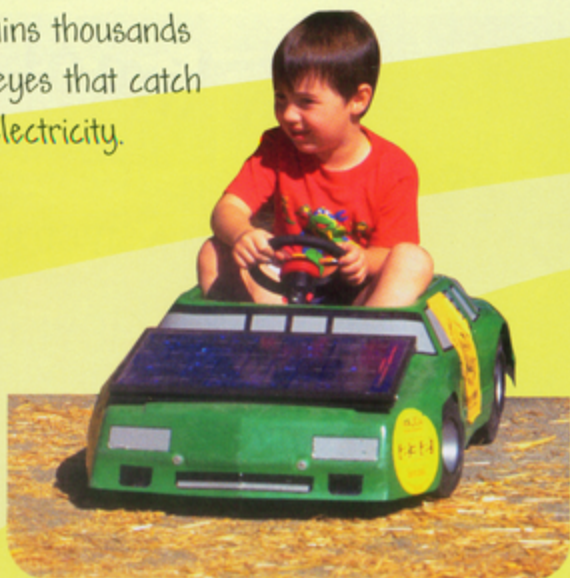


I am small and very lightweight so that I use as little electricity as possible.

This big black panel contains thousands of photocells—electronic eyes that catch sunlight and turn it into electricity.

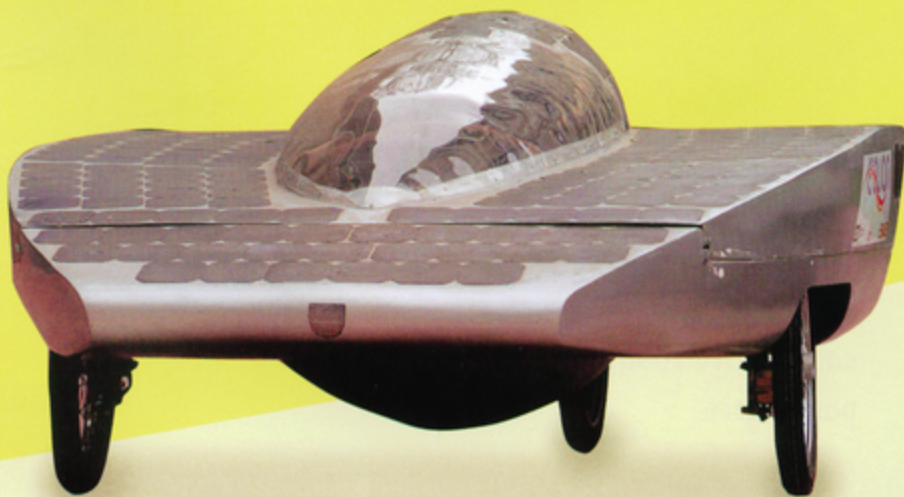

Inside I have widescreen television, a big music system, and party lights. I have a fridge full of food and drinks. Some of my friends even have a small hot tub!



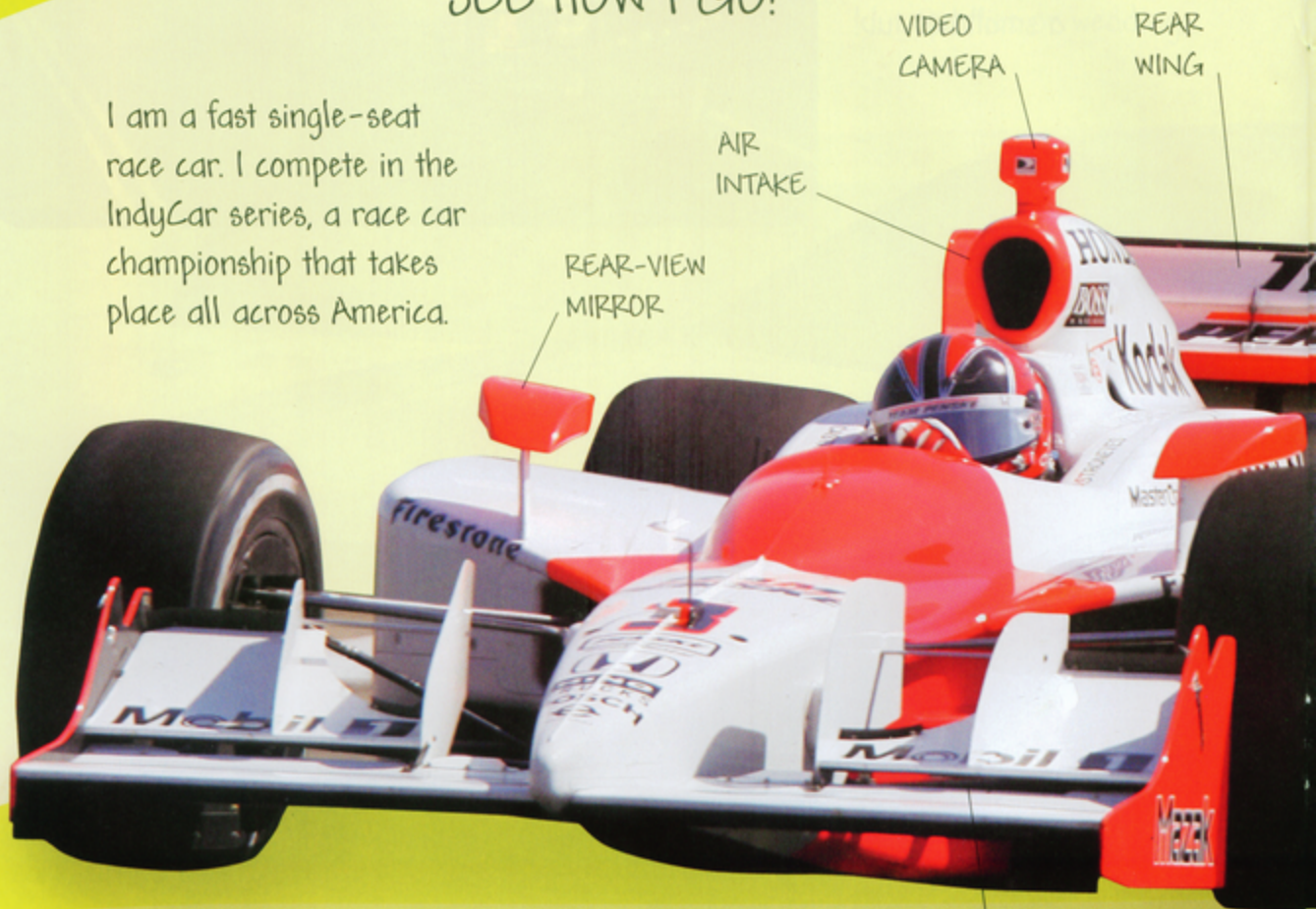
