Smokin' steam train!

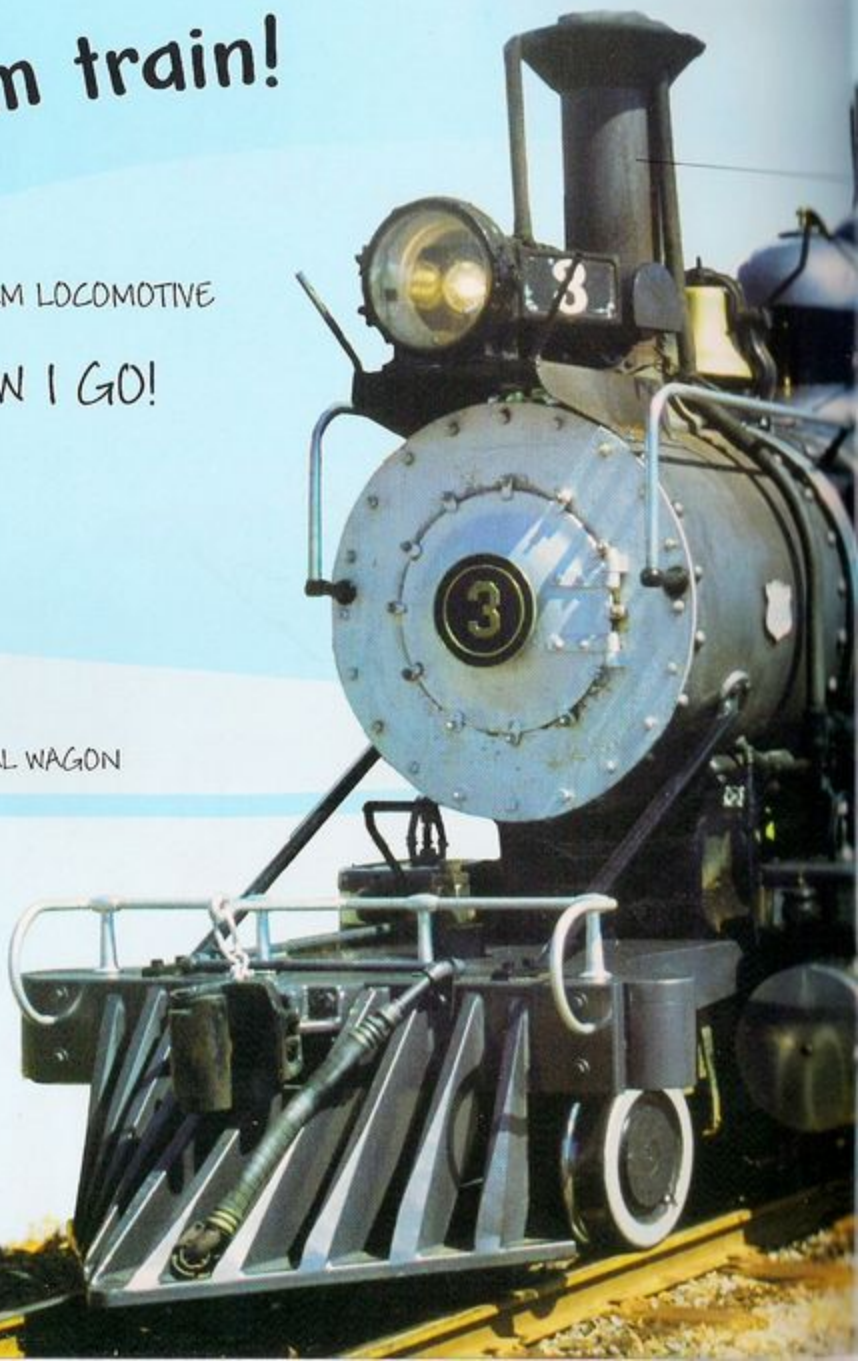
I AM A STEAM LOCOMOTIVE


SEE HOW I GO!

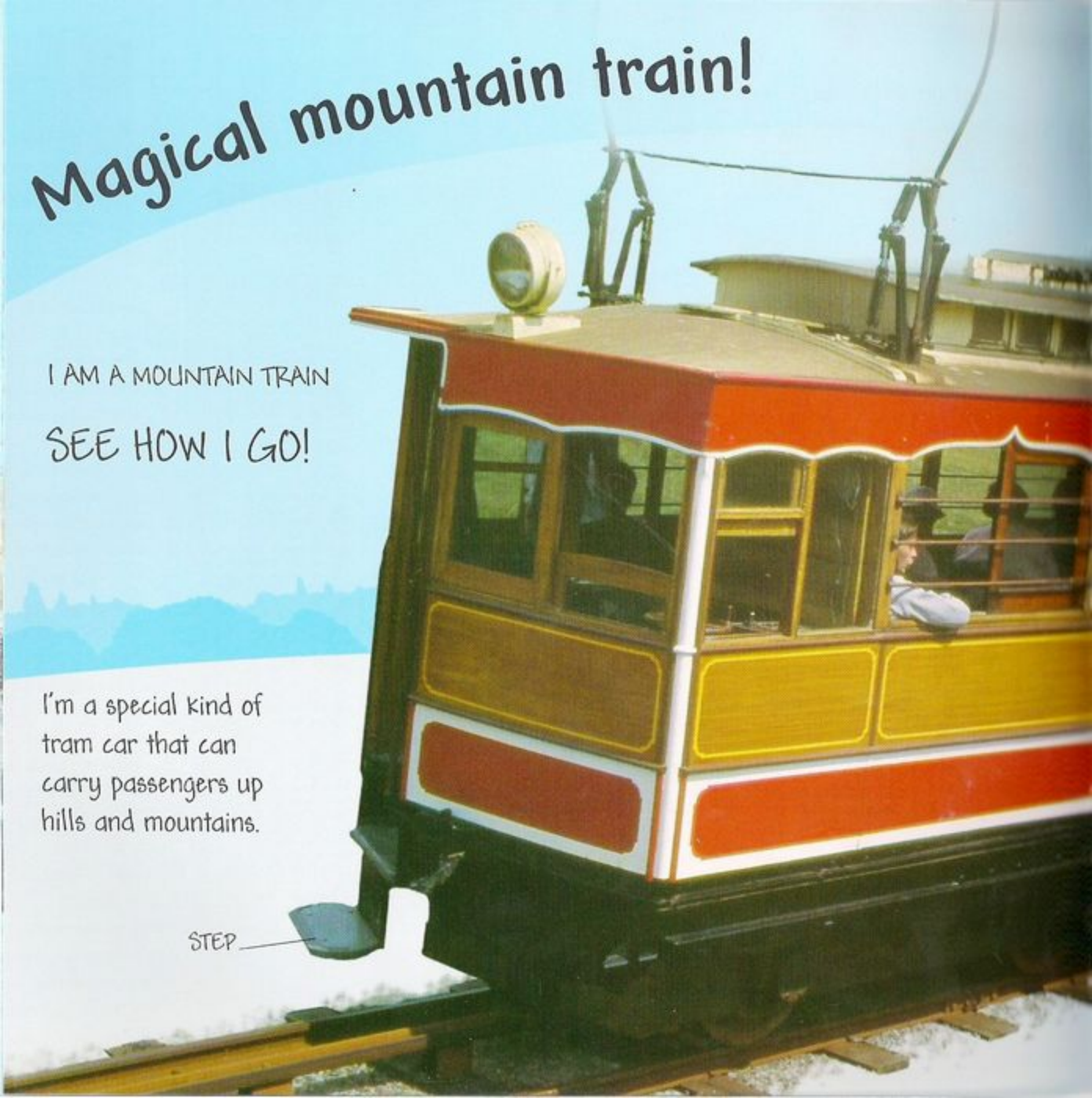
Magical mountain train!


WIPER BLADES

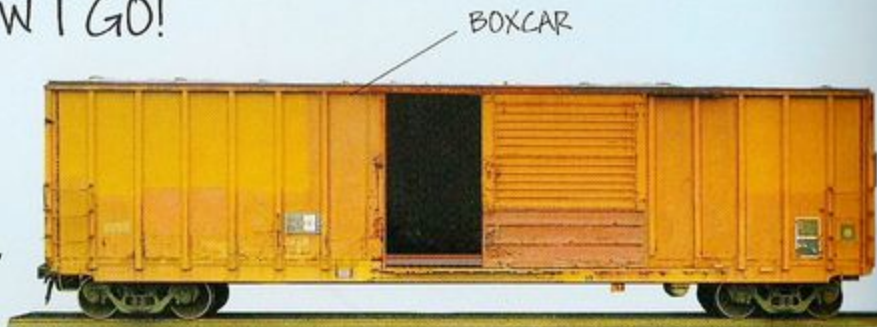
My rail tracks are extra-strong and straight, so I can go fast for most of my journey.

CABOOSE



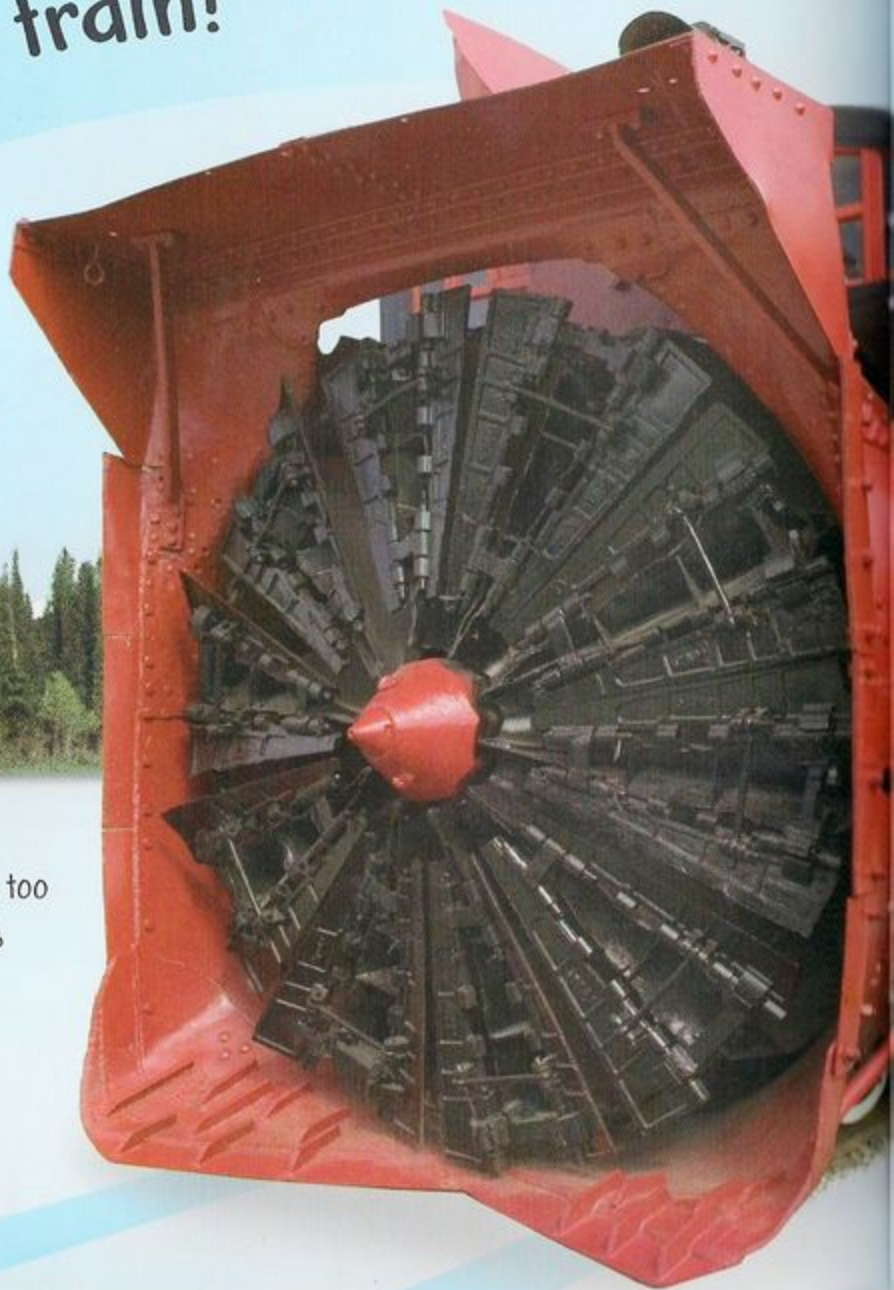
At the back of the train is the caboose where my conductor lives. From the top window, you can see all the cars and the locomotive.
