
COAL WAGON


My big wheels are turned by pistons powered by steam. A coal fire heats water in my boiler to make the steam.












Look at me pulling these freight cars through the desert. This train is over a mile a long.





At the back of the train is the caboose where my conductor lives. From the top window, you can see all the cars and the locomotive.







