


BEWARE THE DARK SIDE



Sith Lord

Darth Sidious was a Sith Lord. The Sith had been around for many centuries. The first Sith was a Jedi who turned to the dark side. Others followed him. Together they tried to destroy the Jedi. The Sith even tried to kill each other because they were so full of evil and hatred. The Jedi thought they had managed to defeat the Sith. In fact, one Sith survived. He took an apprentice and went into hiding. Since then, the Sith have plotted revenge on the Jedi.

The Sith were the Jedi's most feared enemies. The Sith used the dark side of the Force to gain terrible powers. Like the Jedi, they fought with a lightsabre, which is a sword whose blade is made of pure energy. The Sith and the Jedi were the only people in the galaxy who used lightsabres. The lightsabre was the ancient weapon of the Jedi but since the Sith were once Jedi they used them too.

Evil temptation The Jedi understood that the dark side was a powerful temptation for all Jedi. Most managed to resist it, but a few gave in to its evil powers.

Sith Powers

The Sith believed that the dark side of the Force was more powerful than the light. Turning to the dark side seemed to bring results quickly, while the Jedi had to patiently study the light side of the Force for many years. The Sith also rejected the Jedi's teachings that emotions must be controlled. They used anger and hatred to become stronger but the Sith had no loyalty and were often destroyed by the dark side.



In battle, the Sith tried to crush their opponents with heavy objects, which they threw using their dark side energies.

The dark side of the Force gave the Sith powers that the Jedi did not have. One of them was deadly Force lightning. They could fire it from their fingers at an opponent. However, this power was very dangerous and could also harm the user. Force lightning

Galactic Republic When the galaxy was united in peace, a Galactic Republic was formed. It was a democracy, which meant that every person in nearly all the worlds had a voice.

The Phantom Menace

Before Darth Sidious became Emperor of the galaxy, he was a popular politician called Senator Palpatine. At this time, the galaxy was at peace and laws were made in the Senate. All the different planets had a voice in the Senate and large armies were outlawed.



Palpatine secretly wanted to take over the galaxy. He planned to destroy the Senate and build a massive army so that he could force every planet to do what he wanted.



No one suspected that Palpatine was really a Sith Lord. After he secretly started a war in the galaxy, Palpatine convinced the Senate to make him their leader, the Supreme Chancellor. Then he gave himself the power to make all the decisions. Finally, he crowned himself Emperor. Now the dark side ruled the galaxy.




Jedi Defenders

When the Sith revealed themselves after two thousand years in hiding, only the Jedi had the powers to face them. The Jedi vow to use their Force powers only to do good. The good side of the Force is known as the light side.

Learning to use the light side of the Force takes many years. Those who become Jedi begin training as young children. They must leave their families behind and live in the Jedi Temple on a big planet.

Yoda Yoda was the wisest Jedi of all. He was hundreds of years old when the Sith reappeared.



The Jedi learn to control their emotions so that they can remain calm and practical in all situations. The ledi seek to keep the Force in balance in the galaxy, which means that they must stop those who seek to use the dark side.

The Jedi can actually listen to the Force telling them that there is trouble happening somewhere. This is known as a disturbance in the Force. It means there's a problem some place in the galaxy – and the Jedi must find it and do whatever they can to stop it.





Obi-Wan Obi-Wan Kenobi was a powerful Jedi. While the Sith ruled the galaxy, Obi-Wan went into hiding. Yoda also went into hiding.

Jedi Council

The wisest, most experienced ledi sat on the Jedi High Council. Before the Sith attacked, Yoda felt great disturbances in the Force but even he was not able to see where the threat came from.



Masked man Vader's armour and breathing equipment were created in a secret medical facility.



Vader uncovered Vader removed his helmet only in a special isolation chamber. Mechanical arms lifted the helmet from his scarred head.

Darth Vader

Darth Vader ruled the galaxy alongside Darth Sidious. Vader was also a Sith Lord. His knowledge of the dark side of the Force made him a powerful and dangerous figure. Vader would kill anyone who got in his way or disobeyed him, even his own generals. He used his Force powers to strangle people without even touching them.



Darth Vader always wore a black suit of armour and a black mask because his body had been almost destroyed in a great

battle. His armour and mask contained breathing equipment and life-support systems to keep him alive. The wheezing sound of Vader's artificial breathing was enough to strike terror into the mind of anyone he approached.



Space fighter Vader flew his own fighter ship into combat. He was a very daring pilot.



Lightsabre duel Vader was a merciless opponent in battle and did not hesitate to cut down his former Master, Obi-Wan Kenobi.

Boyhood

Anakin was born on a poor desert planet called Tatooine. He spent his boyhood as a slave until a Jedi Master called Qui-Gon Jinn rescued him.



Before he became a Sith Lord, Darth Vader was a Jedi called Anakin Skywalker. Anakin was one of the most talented Jedi ever. His Force powers were incredibly strong but Anakin was impatient.

Senator Palpatine befriended Anakin and began to plant ideas in his mind.

He convinced Anakin to join him on the dark side and train to be a Sith. Palpatine told Anakin that the dark side of the Force was more powerful than the light side. He even told Anakin that he would be able to stop his wife from dying. Anakin wanted this more than anything, so he rejected his Jedi training and joined Palpatine.

When Anakin joined the dark side, he killed many Jedi. He even fought his best friend, Obi-Wan Kenobi. On the edge of a lava river, Anakin and Obi-Wan fought fiercely until Obi-Wan managed to strike down his former friend. Anakin fell near the red-hot lava and burst into flames. Palpatine rescued him and re-built his badly burned body with robotic parts and a suit of armour – and Darth Vader was born!



Padmé Amidala Anakin secretly married the Senator for Naboo, Padmé Amidala, even though the Jedi are forbidden to marry.

first chose a savage alien from the planet Iridonia. Given the Sith name Darth Maul, he served his master obediently, although he was only waiting for the day when he would take Sidious's place. Maul had horns on his head and yellow eyes. His face was tattooed with dark side symbols. Maul's





When two Jedi named Qui-Gon Jinn (pronounced KWY-GONN-JIN) and Obi-Wan Kenobi (pronounced OH-BEE-ONE KEN-OH-BEE) started to upset Sidious's plans, he sent Maul to kill them. The fight took place on the edge of a giant power generator on Palpatine's home planet, Naboo. The Jedi were not prepared for such a ferocious attack. Qui-Gon was killed but Obi-Wan defeated the deadly Sith apprentice.


Sith Master Sidious kept in contact with his apprentice using a hologram transmitter.

Count Dooku

Sidious needed a new apprentice after Obi-Wan killed Darth Maul on Naboo. His search led him to Count Dooku, who was once a Jedi Master. Although he joined the Jedi order at a young age, Dooku was interested in the dark side and wanted power to change things quickly. When Dooku joined Sidious, he took the new Sith name —

Droid Army

Count Dooku had persuaded many planets and organisations to buy powerful droid armies. The footsoldiers were blaster-wielding battle droids while heavily armoured super battle droids provided backup. Hailfire droids rolled across the battlefields, each equipped with deadly cannon or missile launchers. Deadly machines called droideka were used on special missions.

Heavily armed droid ships were also used for space battles. They included vulture droids, which could also walk along the ground, and trifighters. Swarms of tiny buzz droids attached themselves to enemy ships. Although they were very small, their cutting and sawing arms could inflict serious damage.

Bodyguards Grievous was accompanied by droid bodyguards, who were equipped with deadly energy staffs. battle-scarred body had been rebuilt with cyborg parts. The only parts of his original body left were his reptile-like eyes and his inner organs, which were protected by armour. Although he was more machine than man, Grievous would kill anyone who called him a droid.





Grievous became Supreme Commander of the droid armies. Dooku taught Grievous to use a lightsabre, although Grievous could not use the Force like the Sith and Jedi.

Grievous had a long-standing grudge against the Jedi and took the lightsabres of any Jedi he killed. In battle, Grievous could split his two arms into four, each of which could wield a lightsabre.

He also used a deadly blaster and a powerful energy staff, which delivered fatal electric shocks to his opponents.

Final battle Grievous was no match for the combined power of the Jedi ObiWan Kenobi and Anakin Skywalker.





Clone Soldiers

Although Sidious had started a war in the galaxy, he didn't want

either side to win it. He wanted the war to go on just long enough for him to bring the Sith to power. He made sure that the Republic had an army of its own, so that each side was evenly matched. The Republic army consisted of well-trained clone soldiers and a variety of battle tanks, plus cannons, gunships and space assault ships.





Stormtroopers

When the war was over, Darth Sidious ruled the galaxy as Emperor Palpatine, and the clone soldiers became his personal army. He renamed them stormtroopers

He renamed them stormtroopers and forced many millions of human males to join their ranks. Military

Academies were formed in which new recruits were trained to be foot soldiers or more specialised troops, such as pilots or scouts. The stormtroopers were trained to be totally loyal to the Empire.

Empire and Rebels

When Darth Sidious came to power, a dark age began in the galaxy – the Empire. As Emperor Palpatine, Sidious used his massive armies to terrify the galaxy and to stop anyone from rising against him.

Nevertheless, a secret opposition was formed, called the Rebel Alliance. The most famous Rebels were the children of Darth Vader, Luke and Leia.





When Anakin Skywalker turned to the dark side, he did not know that his wife, Padmé Amidala, was pregnant with twins. Tragically, Padmé died while giving birth. The twins were hidden away in separate places, so that Anakin would not find out about them.

Han Solo The Rebels welcomed any support they could get, even from former smugglers like Han Solo and Chewbacca.

The first clone troopers were cloned from a single 'supreme warrior'. He was a man called Jango Fett. Jango made his living as a bounty hunter. This means that he was paid to hunt criminals and outlaws. Darth Tyranus knew of his





Jango also carried out certain special missions for the Sith Lords. For example, he would assassinate any public figures that stood between the Sith Lords and their ultimate goal of ruling the galaxy. One such person was the good Senator Padmé Amidala. Thankfully, Padmé survived the attempts on her life and the Jedi pursued Jango. Eventually, Jango was killed in a large battle between the Republic army and the droid army.

Jango Fett had many contacts in the criminal underworld. One such contact was the hired assassin Zam Wesell. Zam was an alien whose species could shape-shift, which meant that she could change her body shape to imitate other species. This was useful when she needed to blend in with another planet's species without being noticed.





Jango hired Zam to carry out the daring murder of the politician Senator Padmé Amidala, First Zam tried to blow up the Senator's spaceship. Then she released deadly insects called kouhuns into Padmé's bedroom while she slept, but her Iedi bodyquards were able to stop the attack in time. Zam was chased by the Jedi Obi-Wan Kenobi and Anakin Skywalker. They managed to capture her but before she could give anything away, she was shot by a mysterious figure in the shadows – Jango Fett.

Boba Fett

When Jango Fett was killed in battle, he left a young son called Boba. Young

Boba had spent his whole life learning from his father, so when he grew up, he too became a bounty hunter. Boba inherited his father's

Darth Vader, tracking down enemies of the Empire.

When Darth Vader learnt that he had a son, he wanted to track him down and see if he could turn him to the dark side. He would have liked to rule the galaxy alongside his son.

Like father, like son Boba Fett is an exact, unaltered clone of his father, Jango.

Jabba the Hutt

Another of Boba Fett's employers was a crime lord named Jabba the Hutt. This repellent slug-like creature was the leader of a large crime empire responsible for all kinds of shady deals, including murder, theft and fraud. Jabba lived in a palace on the desert planet Tatooine. He shared his palace with assorted gangsters, assassins, smugglers, corrupt officials, low-life entertainers and servants.

Jabba paid Boba Fett to bring him a smuggler who owed him money. That smuggler was Han Solo, who had

become friends with

Skywalker. When Han was captured and brought to Jabba, Leia set out with Chewbacca to rescue Han. When she was also captured, it was up to Luke to rescue all his friends. During Luke's rescue mission, Leia was able to wrap a chain around

Jabba's neck and defeat him.



Bib Fortuna Bib Fortuna ran Jabba's palace for him. He had a large head tail, sharp teeth and scary red eyes.





Pet monster Jabba kept a ferocious rancor monster in a cellar pit. Sometimes he fed it human captives for fun.

Informer Garindan was a low-life informer who lived on Tatooine.

Watto Watto made Anakin and Shmi work very hard.

Rogues and Villains

Even before the Empire took control, parts of the galaxy were wild and lawless. On remote

wild and lawless. On remote planets like Tatooine, highly dangerous Podraces were organised, although they were officially banned. Slavery was also common. When the Jedi Qui-Gon visited Tatooine, he met a slave dealer called Watto. Watto owned Anakin Skywalker and his mother, Shmi. Anakin and Shmi both worked for Watto in his junk shop.





Under the Empire, crime was often rewarded. The Empire relied on spies to report suspicious behaviour. Often, it forced officials to do its shady business.

When Darth Vader wanted to capture Luke Skywalker, he threatened to shut down an entire city if its leader, Lando Calrissian,

did not lure Luke into a trap. When Vader broke his promise, Lando helped Luke and joined the Rebels. Calrissian Lando Calrissian had great charm.

Greedo was a small-time hitman hired to kill Han Solo.






Heavy weapons Star Destroyers were armed with many powerful weapons.

When the Empire discovered a Rebel secret base on the ice planet Hoth, it sent in massive walking tanks called AT-ATs. Pilots controlled the tanks from a cockpit in the head. Until the battle of Hoth, AT-ATs were thought to be unbeatable in battle, but the Rebels toppled them by wrapping cables


around their legs.

Sinister spy A probe droid spotted the Rebel base on Hoth and informed the Empire.




Torture

Death Star

The Death Star was the Emperor's most terrifying superweapon. It was the size of small moon but it was actually one of the largest starships ever built. Its gigantic superlaser weapon could destroy entire planets. To demonstrate its enormous power,

the Empire used it to destroy the planet of Alderaan. This was the planet on which Darth Vader's daughter, Leia, had lived most of her life.



Fatal flaw

The unquarded exhaust port was located at the end of a long channel on the surface of the Death Star.

Yet even the Death Star had a flaw. If a skilled pilot could fire torpedoes into a small exhaust shaft on the Death Star's surface, a chain reaction of explosions would blow up the entire starship. The Rebel Alliance sent their best pilots to reach the target. Luke Skywalker trusted in the Force and fired. A direct hit! Luke had managed to

destroy the Empire's most terrible weapon. Mastermind One of the Emperor's leaders, Grand Moff Tarkin, was the mastermind behind the Death Star.



Second Death Star After the Rebels destroyed the first Death Star, Emperor Palpatine ordered a replacement to be built.

Rebel Victory

The brave Rebels refused to give up the fight against Emperor Palpatine and his Empire of evil. Although the Emperor commanded the biggest army in the galaxy, he was not invincible. The Rebels teamed up with a band of forest-dwelling creatures called Ewoks on the planet Endor. Together they overpowered the Emperor's stormtroopers and helped the Rebels' spaceships to launch a full-scale attack on the second Death Star.





Look out!
The Ewoks only used weapons made of wood, yet they managed to defeat the well-trained and well-armed stormtroopers.



Meanwhile onboard the Death Star, Luke battled for his life against the Emperor and Darth Vader. When Luke refused to turn to the dark side, the Emperor forced the father and son to fight. In the end Luke could not kill Vader. When the Emperor tried to kill Luke, Vader turned against his Sith master and threw him to his doom down a deep shaft.

Luke had proved that even those who have turned to the dark side still have good inside them that can be reached – if you only know how.



Vader unmasked Luke lifted Vader's mask to gaze at the face of the father he had never known.

A Jedi's or Sith's weapon, made of glowing energy.

Light side

The part of the Force associated with goodness, compassion and healing

Rebel
