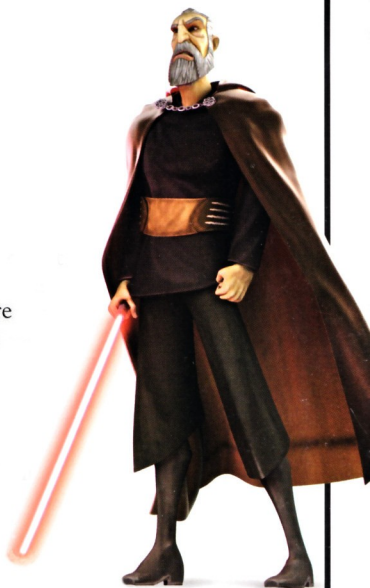

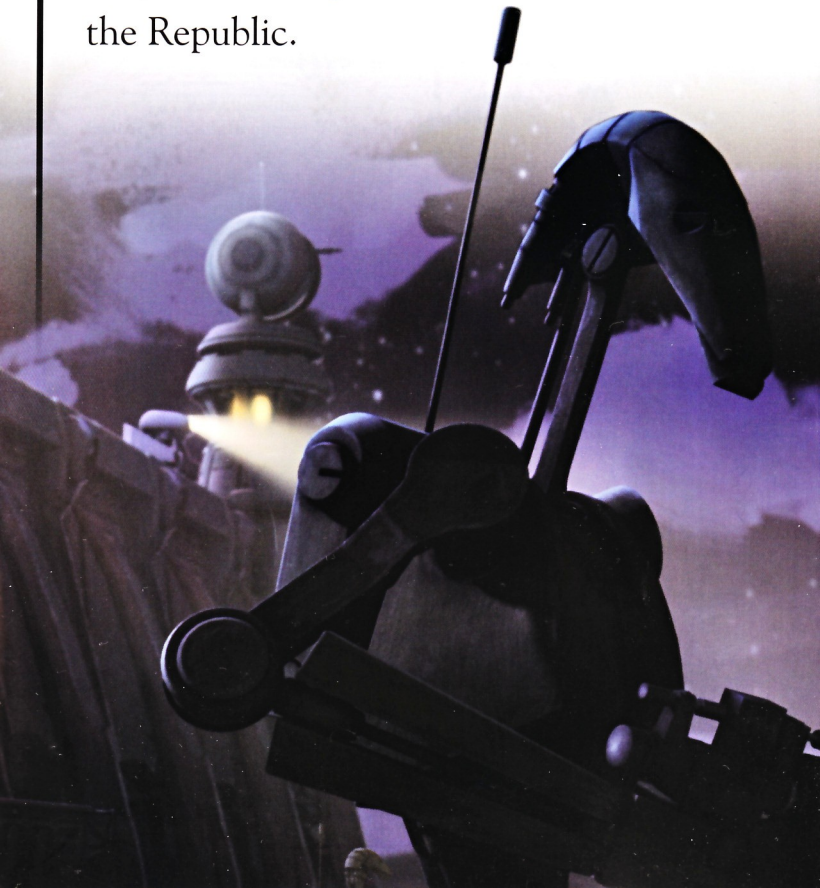

The Forces of Darkness

The galaxy is no longer a safe place. Very powerful organisations are waging a war. They call themselves Separatists, because they want to separate themselves from the Republic.

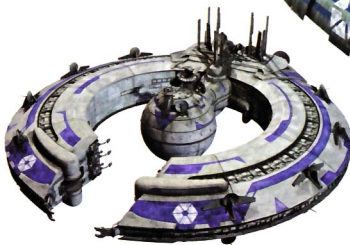


But they are far more sinister than that. Behind them is a force of darkness that wants to rule the galaxy. They use huge spaceships to attack planets and battle droids to invade them.

Darth Sidious

Although Darth Sidious is a Sith Lord, nearly no one knows this.

To everyone else, he is Supreme Chancellor



Chancellor Palpatine

Palpatine, leader of the Republic. He pretends to be working for the Republic, but secretly he is trying to destroy it. He is using the Separatists and their armies to gain power for himself.

Shadowy Sith leader

Sidious remains in the shadows, but he is always advising his cronies, such as Count Dooku.

Count Dooku

Count Dooku is the public leader of the Separatists. His Force abilities are amazing and he is a brilliant lightsaber swordsman.



Yoda

Yoda is a Jedi elder and trains all the young Jedi at the Jedi Temple.

He was once a Jedi. Jedi Master Yoda helped train him. But Darth Sidious recruited Dooku to the dark side. He is very devious and invents clever plots to trick the Jedi.



General Grievous

Darth Sidious and Count Dooku have teamed up with some shadowy figures. General Grievous leads their huge army of droid soldiers. He doesn't have any Force powers, but he can fight with a lightsaber. His arms can split into two, so he can fight with four lightsabers at once. He hates the Jedi and when he defeats one, he collects their lightsaber as a trophy.

Grievous can fight with lightsabers just like the Jedi.

The *Malevolence*

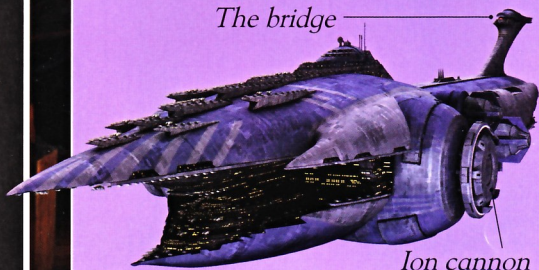
General Grievous patrols the galaxy in a huge ship called the *Malevolence*.

The *Malevolence* is armed with a deadly weapon that cuts off all the power on enemy ships. This means they cannot defend themselves from an attack.

The *Malevolence* is one of the most advanced ships built by the Separatists.

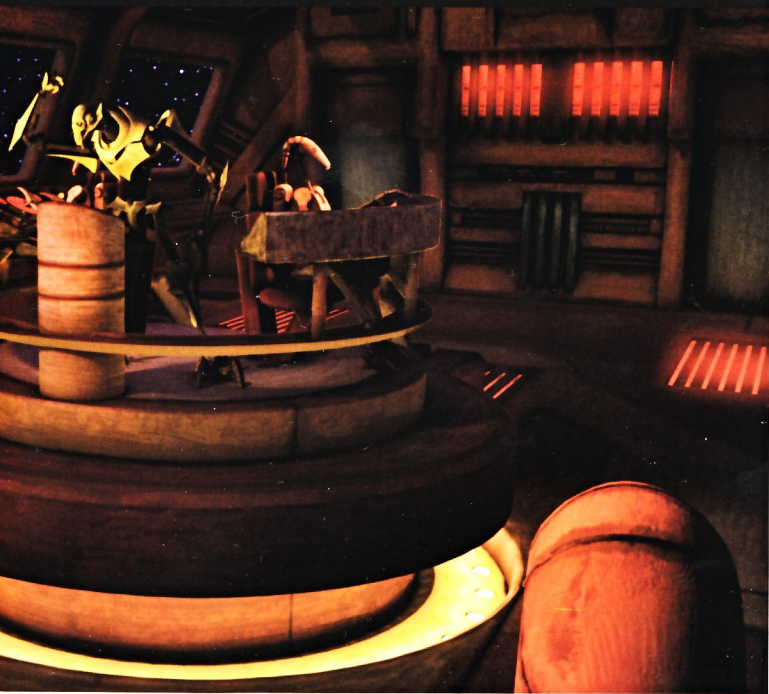
Ion cannon

The *Malevolence* blasts Jedi Master Plo Koon's ship with its deadly weapon.



The secret weapon is called an ion cannon.

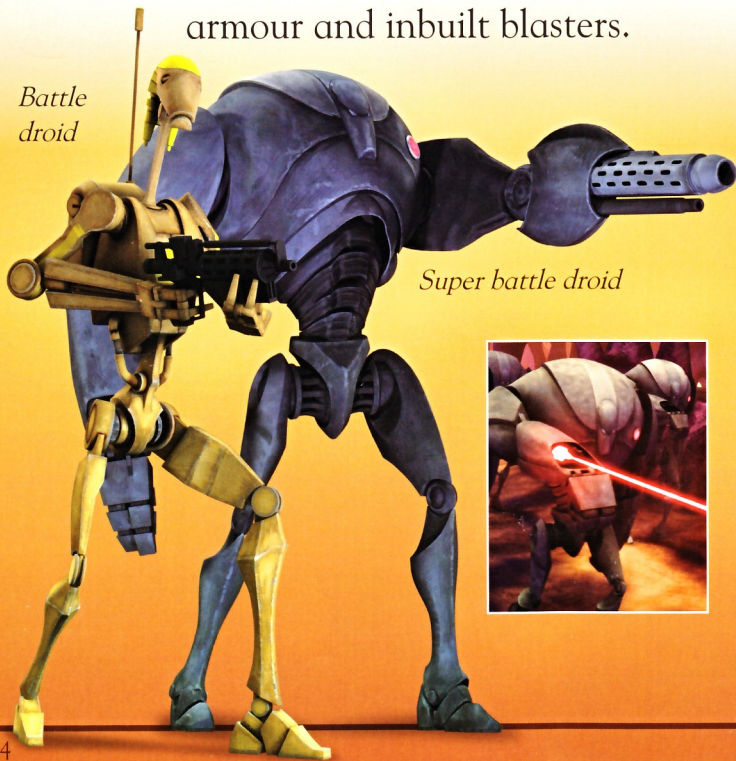
General Grievous is convinced his secret weapon will win the war for his armies.



Droid Army

The Separatists' deadly droid army is made up of battle droids, super battle droids, droidekas, vulture droids and many more. Battle droids can follow only the simplest orders, but they are armed and lethal. Super battle droids have more armour and inbuilt blasters.

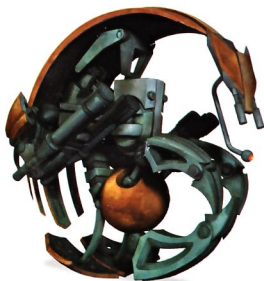
Vulture droids are flying droids. They look like spaceships, but can also walk into battle like battle droids. They flip their wings down and walk on the tips.

Droidekas

Droidekas can roll along the ground in a ball then stop, uncurl and fire at their target.





Rocket Battle Droids

Rocket battle droids are specialist battle droids that can fly in space. They have rocket packs attached to their backs and torches on their heads.



Plo Koon waits for the rocket battle droids on top of the pod.

After Plo Koon's ship is destroyed, the rocket battle droids pursue the survivors. But Plo Koon waits for them on top of his escape pod and attacks them. He uses his lightsaber and the Force to defeat them.

Super battle droids can also have rocket packs fitted.



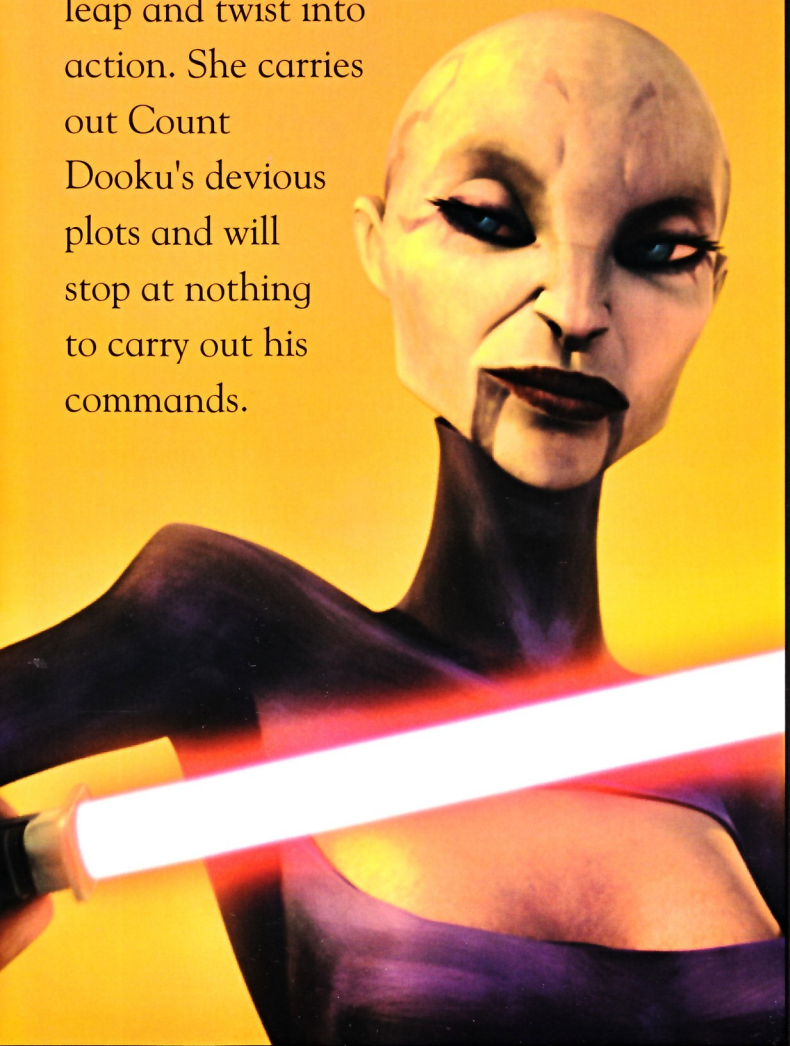


Asajj Ventress

Count Dooku employs Ventress to carry out dangerous missions. She is a deadly assassin. Ventress fights with a double-bladed red lightsaber, which she can split into two separate lightsabers to fight two enemies at once.

Ventress is Dooku's secret Sith apprentice.

She has an athletic body that she can leap and twist into action. She carries out Count Dooku's devious plots and will stop at nothing to carry out his commands.





MagnaGuards

MagnaGuards serve as General Grievous's bodyguards. They are a special type of

battle droid. They carry weapons called electrostaffs, which have deadly energy flowing through them. They are programmed to protect him and have amazing fighting skills. General Grievous wanted them as his bodyguards as they are very powerful and more intelligent than normal battle droids. They sometimes guard Count Dooku, too.

Commando Droids

Commando droids are another type of specialist droid. Commando droids are quicker, more intelligent and braver than normal battle droids. They can also disguise their voices. A unit of commando droids attack a Republic outpost on Rishi.



They make their voices sound like clone troopers and dress in clone armour to fool the real clones.

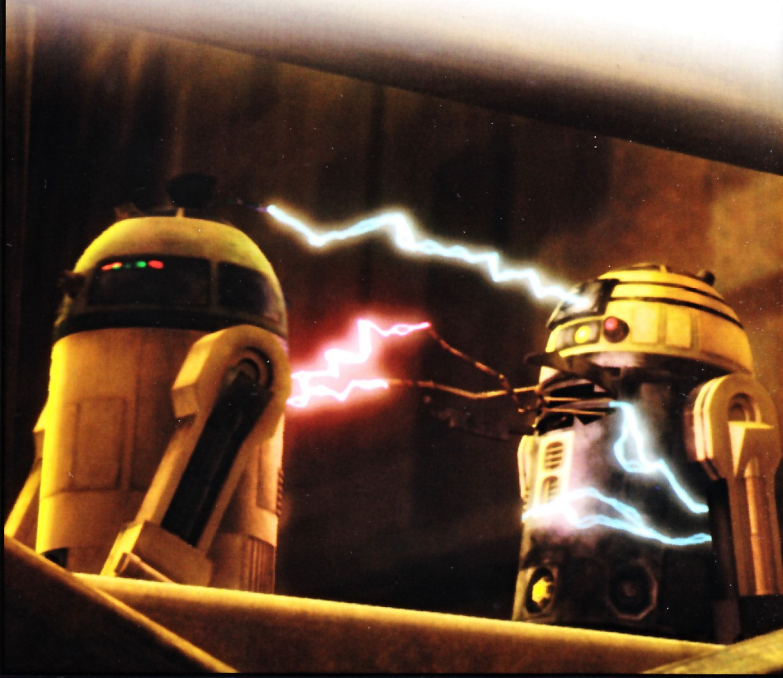
Rishi moon

The Republic outpost on Rishi is a lonely and remote place. It is very important because it lies on the edge of Republic territory.



Spies and Traitors

Sometimes the Separatists use spies and double agents. When R2-D2 is lost in battle, Anakin uses a replacement astromech droid called R3-S6. But Anakin does not know that General Grievous has programmed R3-S6 to spy on him and sabotage his missions.





R3-S6 nearly succeeds, but R2-D2 confronts the new droid and defeats him in a spectacular droid battle!

Gold top

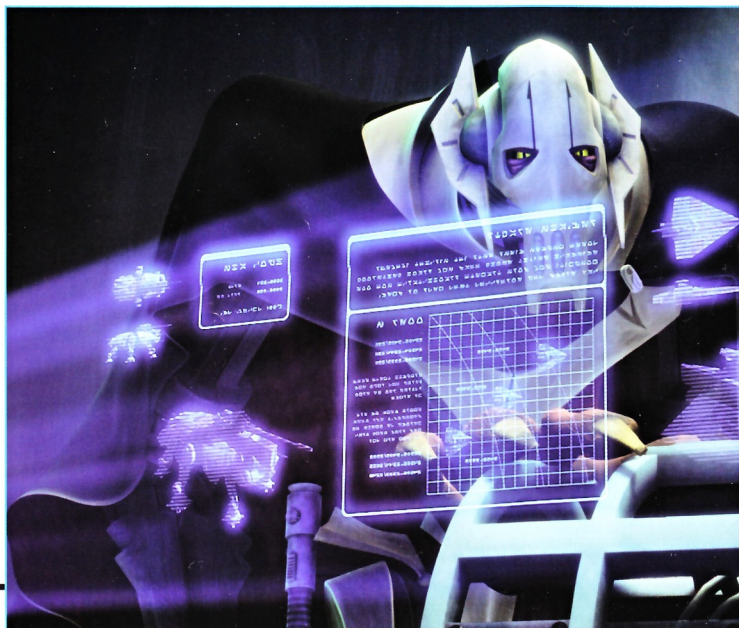
R3-S6 originally had a clear dome top, but he had to have it replaced with a gold dome from an R2 unit.





Gha Nachkt

Gha Nachkt is a shady character. After space battles, he searches the area for valuable spaceship parts that have been left behind to sell. He finds R2-D2 in space after a battle.

R2-D2 has lots
of plans in his



memory banks, which are valuable to the Separatists. Gha demands a lot of money from General Grievous for the little droid. General Grievous doesn't want to pay such a high price and kills Gha Nachkt.





Assassin Droids

Assassin droids are another type of deadly droid. They can be programmed to hunt down and kill a target. R3-S6 activates two assassin droids when Anakin and Ahsoka are on a mission to rescue R2-D2.



Anakin and Ahsoka work as a team to defeat the assassin droids.

R2-D2, but R2-D2 traps him in an
airlock and blasts him into space!



Cad Bane

Cad Bane is a dangerous bounty hunter. He has blue skin and red glowing eyes. He wears a wide-brimmed hat and a brown coat. He has lots of deadly weapons and will agree to capture anyone if the price is high enough. He is cruel and calculating, and will hunt his prey to the ends of the galaxy.



Cad Bane has two custom-made blasters.







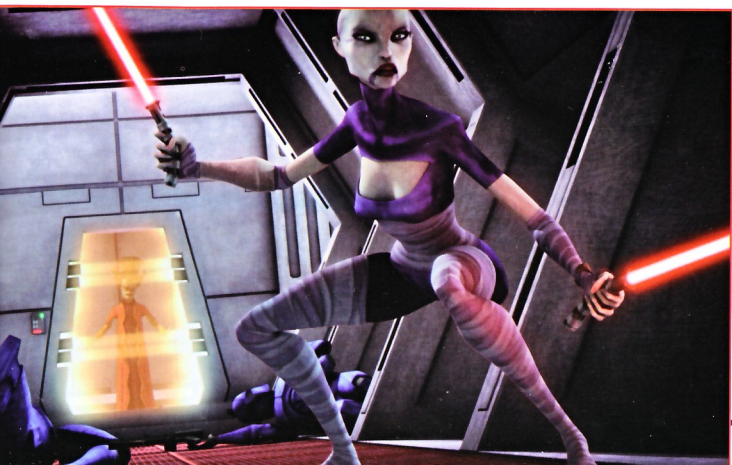
Nute Gunray

Nute Gunray is the leader of the Trade Federation, which supplies the droids for the Separatist army. Nute Gunray is a greedy Neimoidian and a coward. He loves money and will do anything for it.





When he captures Padmé Amidala on the planet Rodia, she escapes and Nute is arrested. He nearly tells the Separatists' secrets to the Jedi, but Ventress rescues him just in time.





Hondo Ohnaka

Hondo Ohnaka is the leader of the Weequay space pirates. Space pirates are dangerous, greedy and untrustworthy. They roam the galaxy attacking other ships and stealing their valuables.





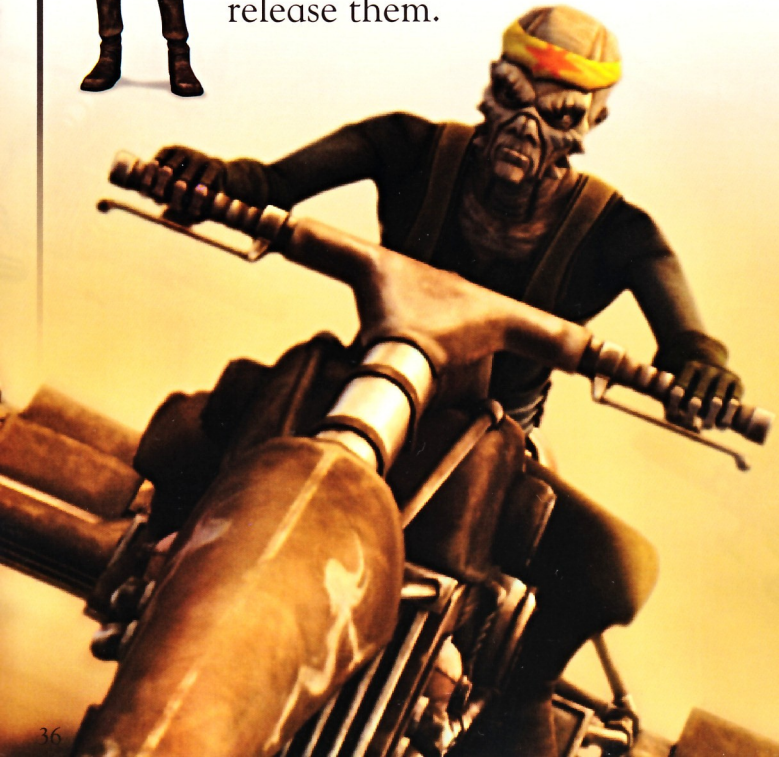
They even take people hostage for a ransom. They capture Count Dooku, as well as Obi-Wan and Anakin.





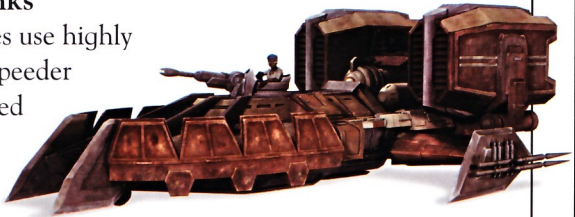
Turk Falso

Turk Falso is Hondo's second-in-command. But he is disloyal to his master. After his boss captures Count Dooku, Anakin and Obi-Wan, he tries to steal the ransom that was sent to release them.



Pirate tanks

The pirates use highly modified speeder tanks armed with laser cannons.



He lies to Hondo, telling him that the Republic didn't send a ransom. He tells Hondo that they sent an army instead. Hondo sends his tanks into the desert to attack the imaginary army. Turk's greedy plan does not work and he pays a terrible price.



Turk is found out by his master, Hondo.





Grievous's Lair

The forces of darkness even mistrust each other.

Count Dooku secretly decides to test General Grievous. Count Dooku is enraged after General Grievous loses a battle and the *Malevolence* is destroyed. Dooku plants a Jedi tracking beacon in Grievous's lair.



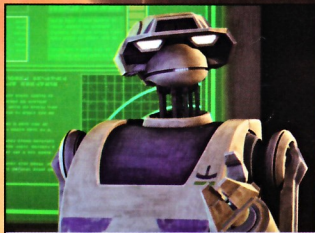
Jedi Kit Fisto and Nahdar Vebb follow the beacon to his hideout. General Grievous realises that the Jedi are after him and he is determined to prove his abilities and defeat the intruders. He succeeds in killing one of the Jedi and keeps the lightsaber as a grim trophy.





Wat Tambor

Wat Tambor is a Separatist General. He wears a special mask that allows him to breathe. His army of droids take control of the planet Ryloth. But greedy Wat Tambor wants to steal the planet's treasure for himself.



TA-175

TA-175 is programmed to advise the Separatists how to fight the war with minimum losses.

When the Republic army arrives to rescue the planet, his tactical droid TA-175 tells

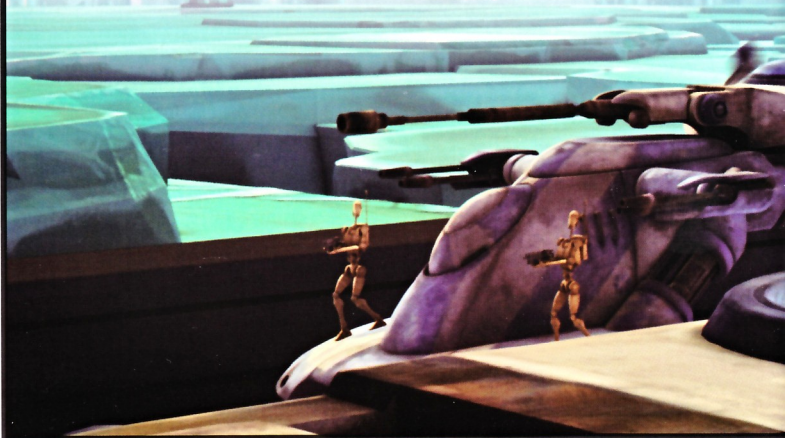


him that they must leave immediately. Wat Tambor's greed puts the evacuation in jeopardy. He is so slow packing up the treasure that TA-175 leaves him behind.



General Loathsom

General Loathsom is another Separatist General. He has blue skin and a long, pointy head. He leads the droid army on the planet Christophsis. The Separatists have a defence shield that allows the droid army to march forward without being hit. Loathsom believes that his droid army will easily defeat the Jedi's army.



Loathsom demands the Jedi's surrender, but his shield generator is shut down by Anakin and Ahsoka. They go behind enemy lines to turn it off. Loathsom's army is no longer protected by the defence shield and it is defeated by the Republic forces led by Obi-Wan.

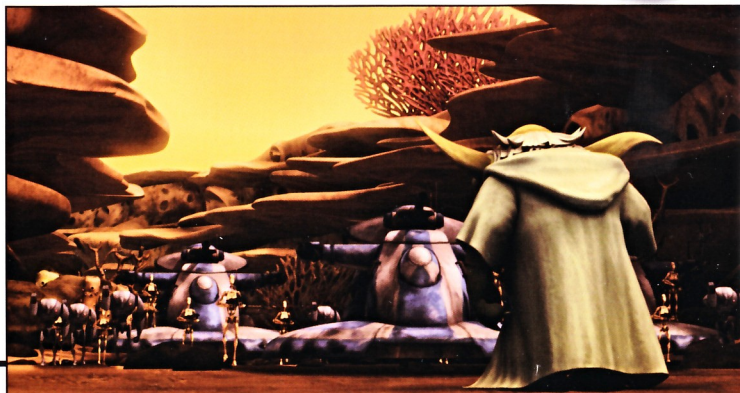




Tanks

There is no more terrifying sight than a row of Separatist

tanks on the horizon. The Armoured Assault Tank (AAT) hovers above the ground using special technology. They are armed with laser cannons and blaster cannons. An AAT needs a commander, a pilot and two gunners to operate it. The tanks follow Yoda into the coral forests on Rugosa.





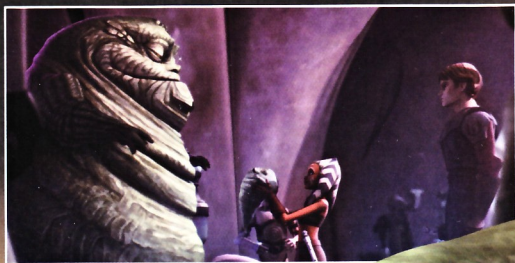
But they are too big to fit through the coral trees. They eventually force their way through the coral to pursue Yoda.

Hutt Gangsters

The Hutts are greedy crime lords and big slug-like creatures. Jabba the Hutt is the head of the powerful gangster family. His uncle is called Ziro the Hutt. He has tattoos all over his body that glow in the dark. Jabba is suspicious of everyone and is quick to believe they are plotting against him. Count Dooku kidnaps Jabba's son in order to make the Jedi look guilty, but his plot does not succeed.



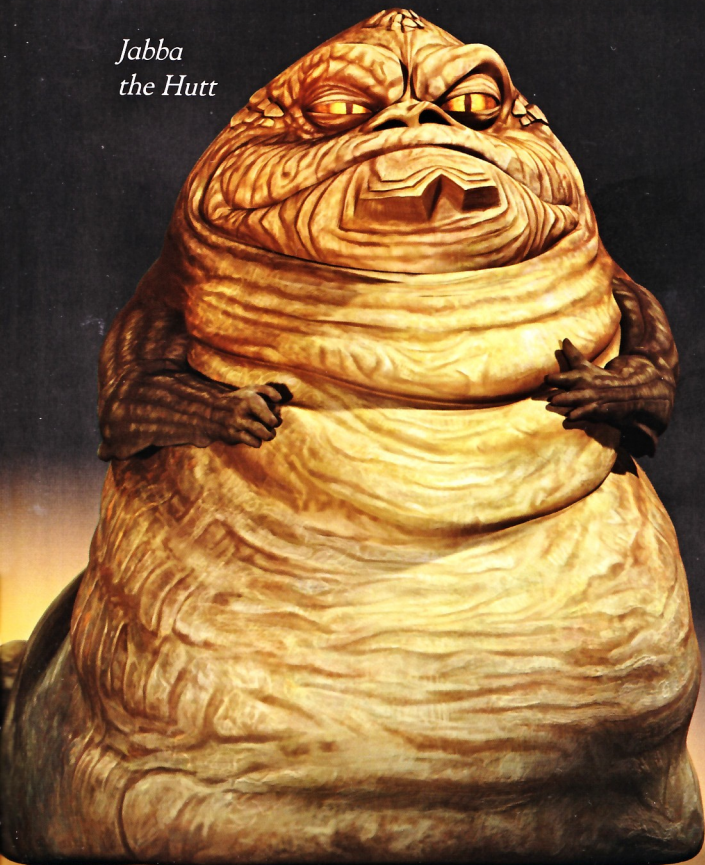
Ziro the Hutt
