


Anakin Skywalker.

Some people want to stop him.



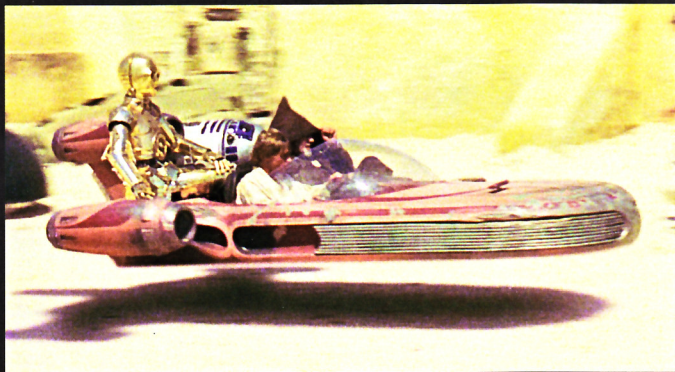
They are called Rebels.

the Stormtroopers.

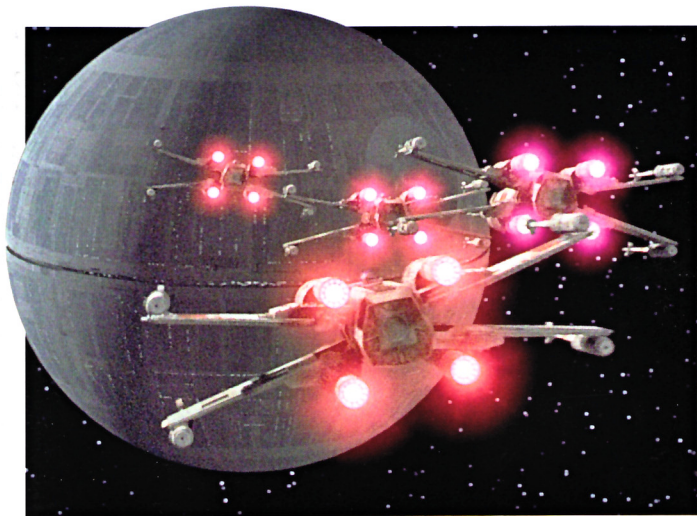


They rescue Princess Leia.

The Rebels attack the Death Star in their spaceships.



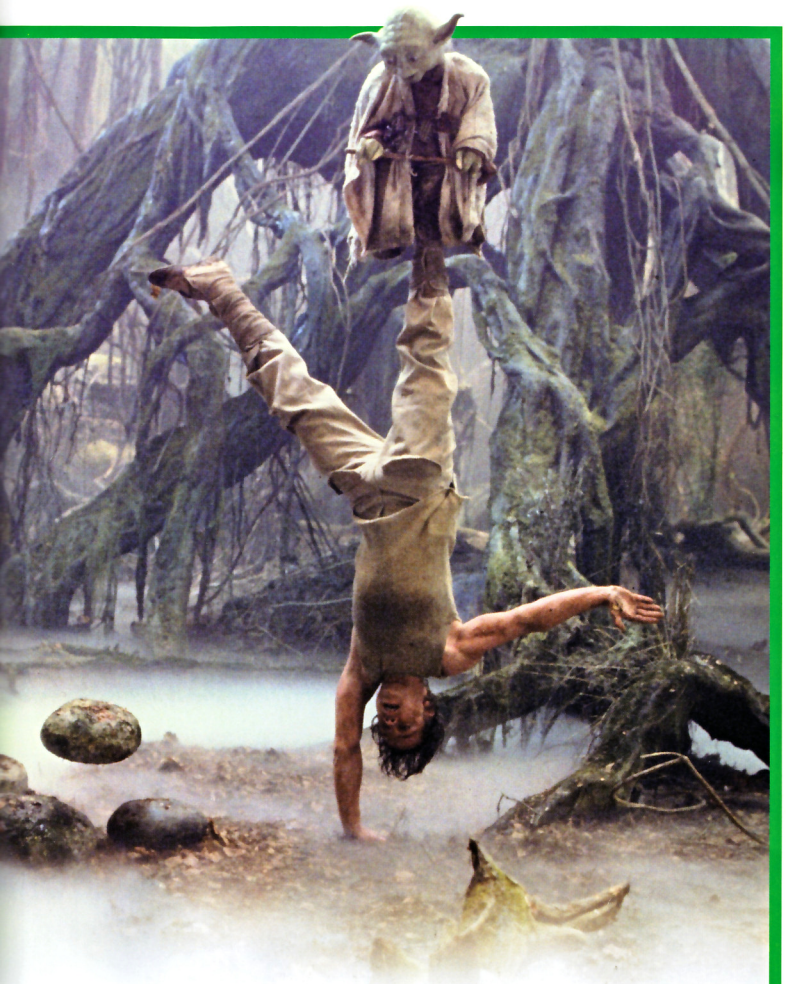
Luke blows up the Death Star with a very lucky shot.

Luke realises it is time to meet...

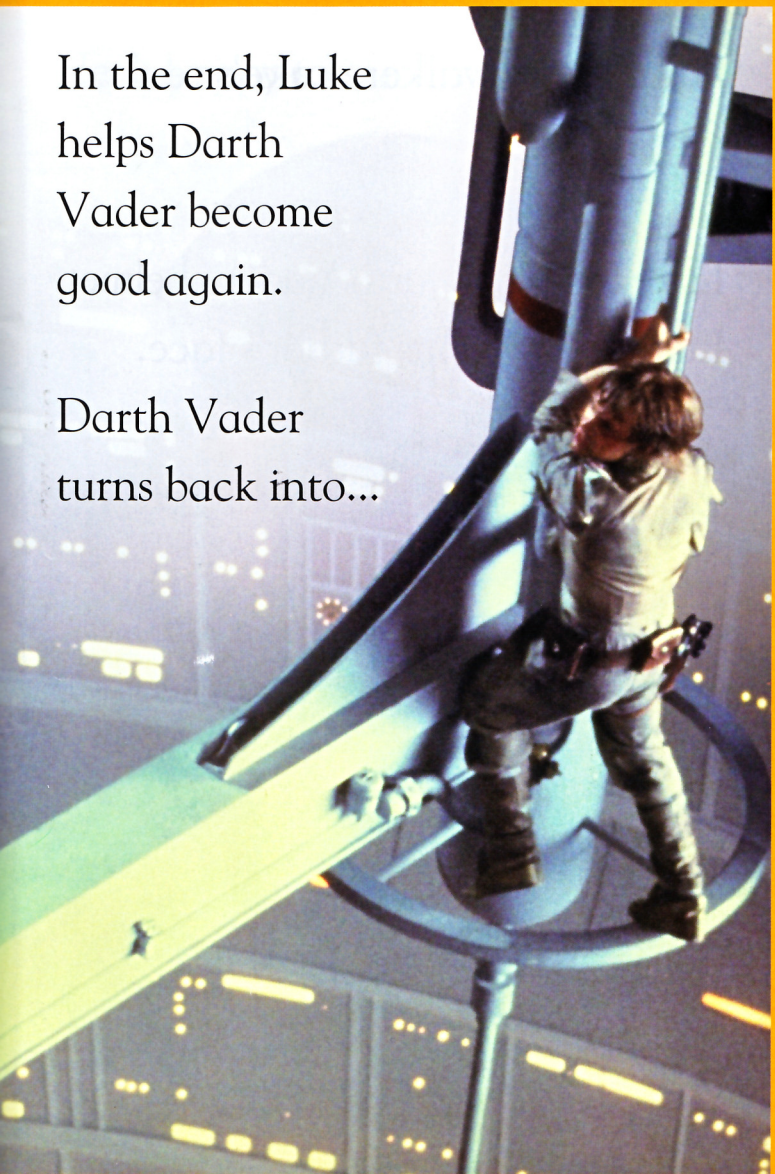
His father, Darth Vader.

Luke looks at his father's face.



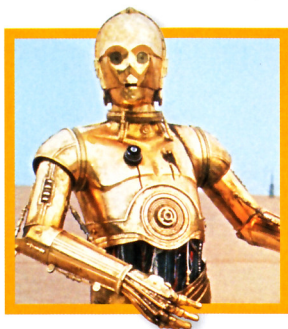
