

Level 1: Beginning to read


Level 2: Beginning to read alone









Anakin's missions are dangerous. Ahsoka is brave and clever, but she still has a lot to learn.


Padawan

Apprentice Jedi Knights are called Padawans. Ahsoka is Anakin's Padawan.




Anakin isn't happy at first, but on her first mission Ahsoka saves his life.







She uses the Force to make the stone wall fall. Anakin is saved!


On their next mission, Anakin and Ahsoka have to rescue Jabba the Hutt's son, Rotta. Rotta was kidnapped and taken to a castle.




When Ahsoka and Anakin find Rotta, he is already sick and needs medicine.

Jabba is very pleased to see his son safe and well. He thanks Ahsoka and Anakin for their help.




Ahsoka and Anakin receive a message that Jedi Plo Koon is in trouble. He has been attacked by the enemy and must defend himself against battle droids.




The Jedi leaders tell

they cannot go to the




rescue. Ahsoka's Jedi instincts tell her she must go to help him.



When Anakin's droid, R2-D2, goes missing after a space battle, Anakin is sent a new droid. Ahsoka welcomes the new droid, who is called R3-S6.



Ahsoka tells Anakin that R3 droids are better than R2 droids, but Anakin wants to find R2-D2. They think R2-D2 is on an enemy base, so they go to investigate.





At the enemy base, another Jedi enemy called General Grievous (GREEVE-us) suddenly appears. He attacks Ahsoka, but she hides in the shadows.





R3-S6 shines a light on Ahsoka. R3-S6 is a traitor and a spy for Grievous! Luckily, Ahsoka gets away. Anakin finds R2-D2 and they all escape the enemy base.



Ahsoka goes on a mission with Jedi Master Luminara. They are taking a prisoner to stand trial. The prisoner's name is Nute Gunray. He knows a lot of enemy secrets, which the Jedi want to learn.



Ahsoka threatens Nute so he will tell them the secrets. Luminara doesn't like Ahsoka threatening Nute and tells her to stop. Ahsoka doesn't like being told what to do.




Ventress and the droid army attack the Jedi ship.




Ventress has come to rescue Nute Gunray. While Luminara is fighting the droids in another part of the ship, Ventress sets Nute Gunray free.



She has learned to work as a team with the other Jedi. Most of all, she has learned that she has what it takes to become a great Jedi Knight!




