



asleep, he steals from them!




The rest of the pirate gang is a ragtag bunch of villains. They have rough, wrinkled skin.




One pirate has a metal peg-leg.




Watch out! The pirates also ride around on flying speeder bikes.






The pirates capture a spaceship

While Turk is busy fighting Jar Jar, Anakin and Obi-Wan manage to escape.




Then the two Jedi Knights


