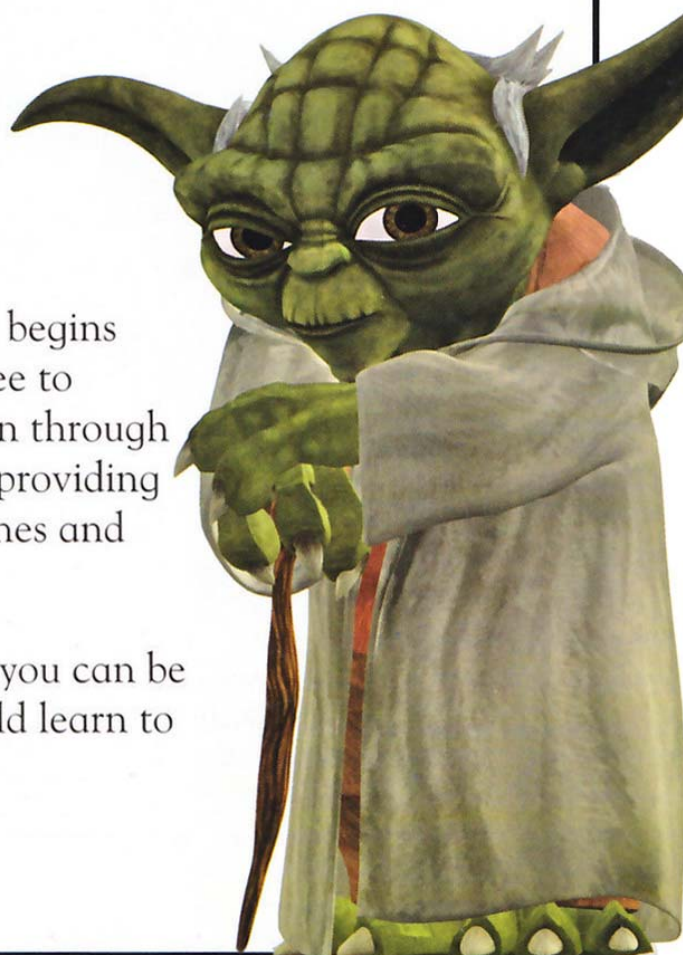

King Katuunko

King Katuunko is the King of the Toydarians. Toydarians are an alien species that has small wings. They can hover in the air.

The figure lowers her hood to reveal a white face and cold eyes. It’s Asajj Ventress – the deadly assassin!

Ventress lowers a holoprojector to the ground, and a hologram of Count Dooku appears. Count Dooku wants the King to join the Separatists.

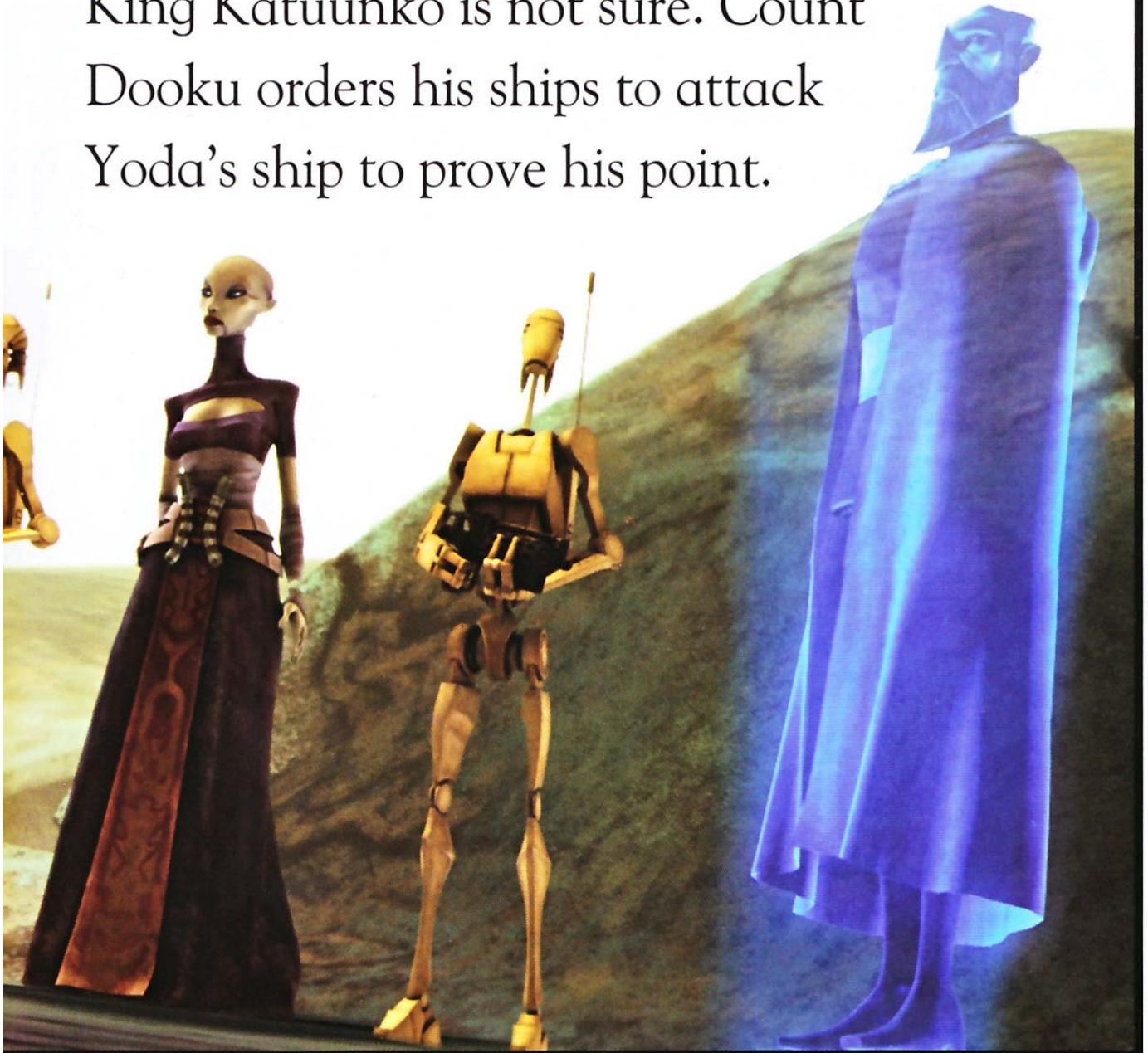




Asajj Ventress

Ventress used to be a Jedi. She turned to the dark side after her Jedi Master was killed. She fights with twin red lightsabers.

He says that the Separatist Army is much bigger and will beat the Republic's army. King Katuunko is not sure. Count Dooku orders his ships to attack Yoda's ship to prove his point.



Yoda and his clone troopers are rocked by the sudden explosions. Another one of Count Dooku's ships appears and fires on Yoda's ship, too. Yoda realises that it is too late to escape in his ship. Yoda must still get down to the moon's surface if he is to meet the King.

"Quickly now. Reach the moon's surface we must," urges Yoda.

"In a life pod, sir? The enemy will fire at anything we launch," says Captain Zak.

“That remains to be seen, Count,” replies King Katuunko.

“Indeed. When you decide to join us, my apprentice will contact me,” says Dooku as he bows and fades out.

“My Lord, Master Yoda’s warship has fled the system. What further evidence do you require of the Jedi’s weakness?” asks Ventress.



Separatist Army

The army of the Separatists is made up of Destroyer Droids (also known as droidekas or rollies), Battle Droids, and Super Battle Droids.



King Katuunko's holoprojector lights up. Yoda greets the King and tells him that he will still be able to come and meet him. Ventress interrupts.

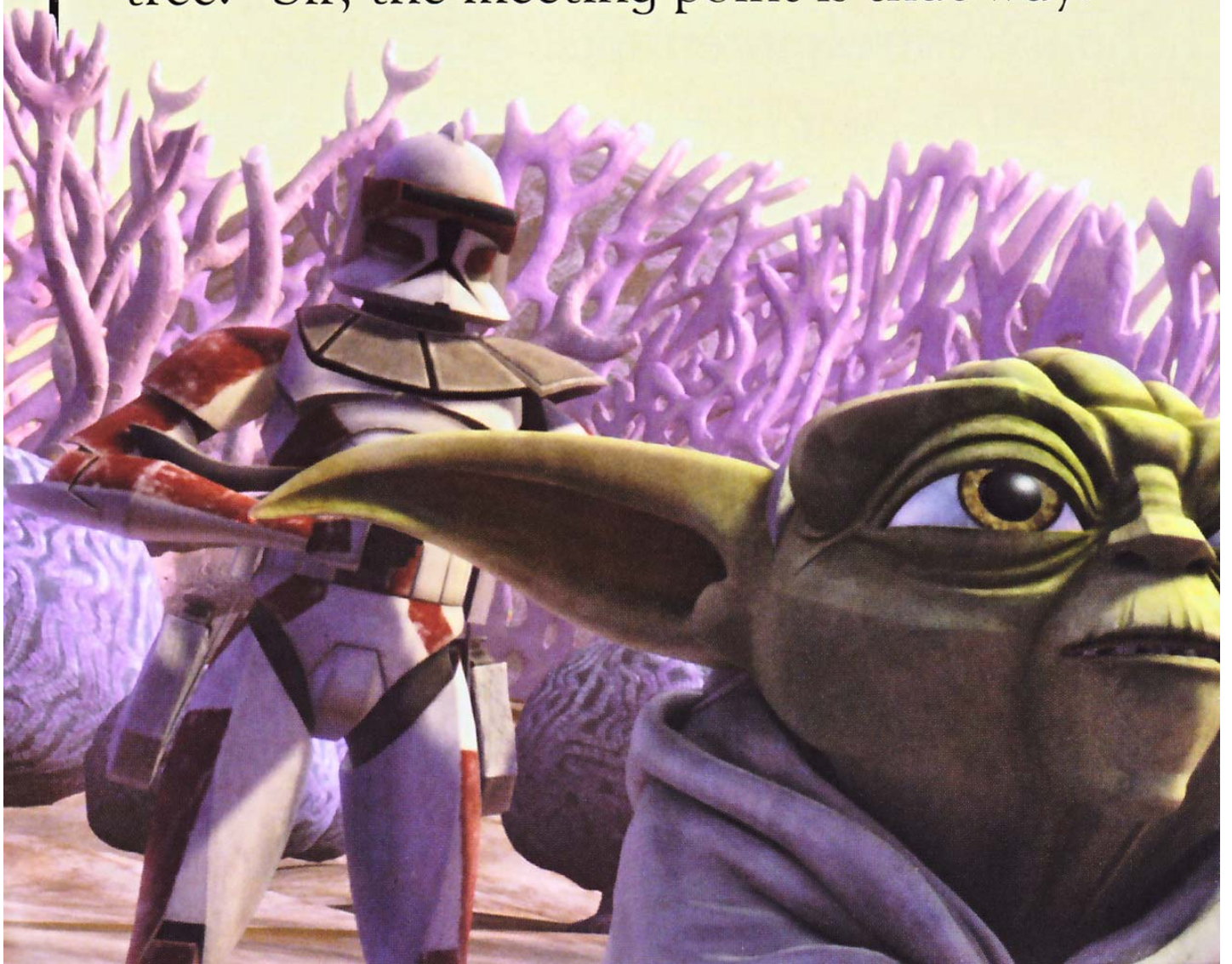
“Allow me to send my best troops to capture him. If he escapes, join the Republic. But should my droids defeat Yoda, consider an alliance with the Separatists,” Ventress sneers.

“Accept the challenge I do, Your Highness. Arrive by nightfall, I will,” Yoda promises.

Yoda and King Katuunko are to meet at a distant coral tree. A Separatist ship lands on the moon, right between Yoda and the coral tree.

“Carry only what you need. Too much weight, slow you down it will. Destroy Ventress, your weapons will not,” Yoda tells his clone troopers.

Lieutenant Thire points to the coral tree. “Sir, the meeting point is that way.”



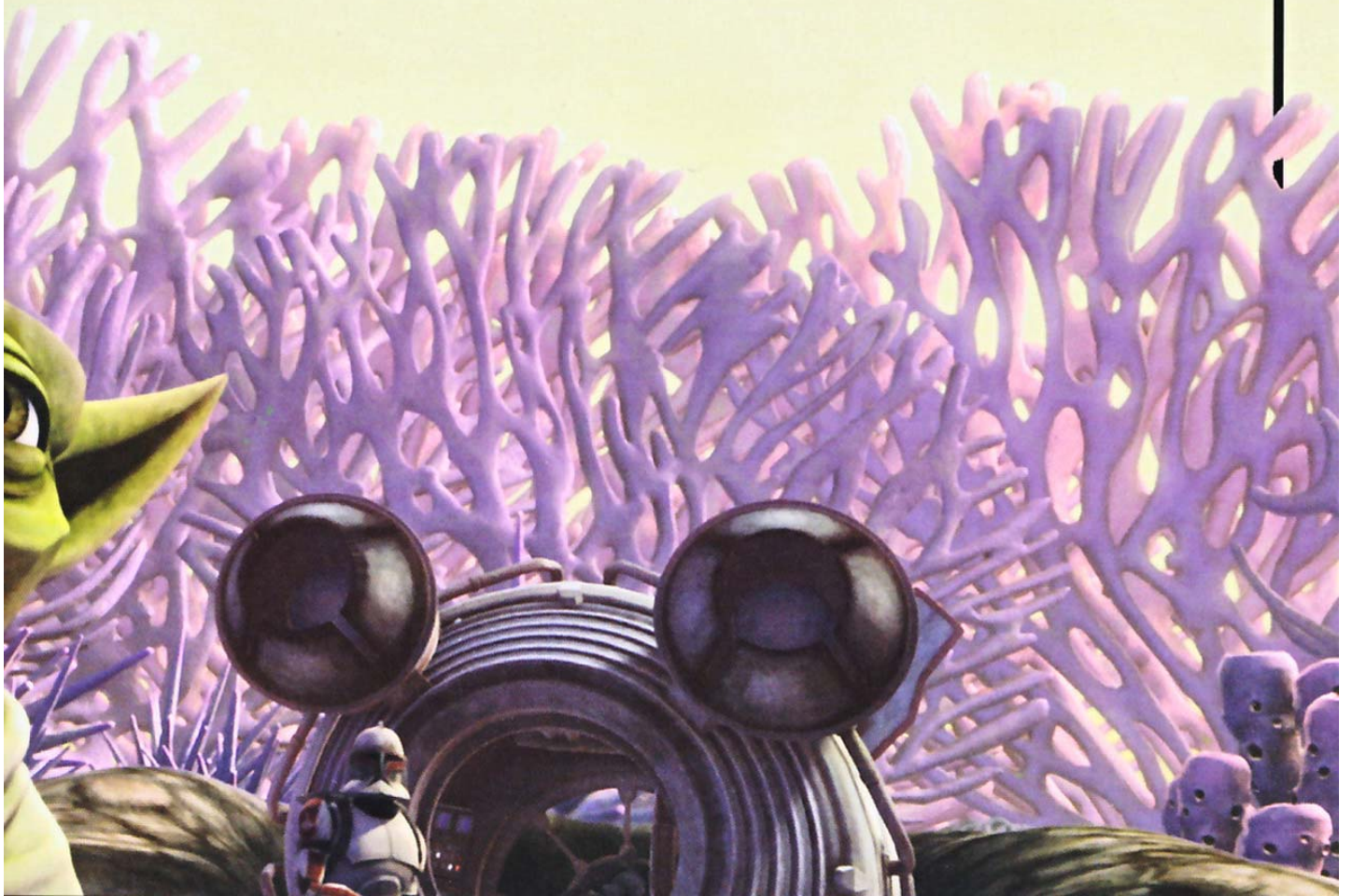


Ancient Moon

Rugosa has many ancient corals because it was once covered by huge oceans, which later dried up.

“As is our enemy. To reach our goal, a straight path we will not follow,” Yoda says wisely.

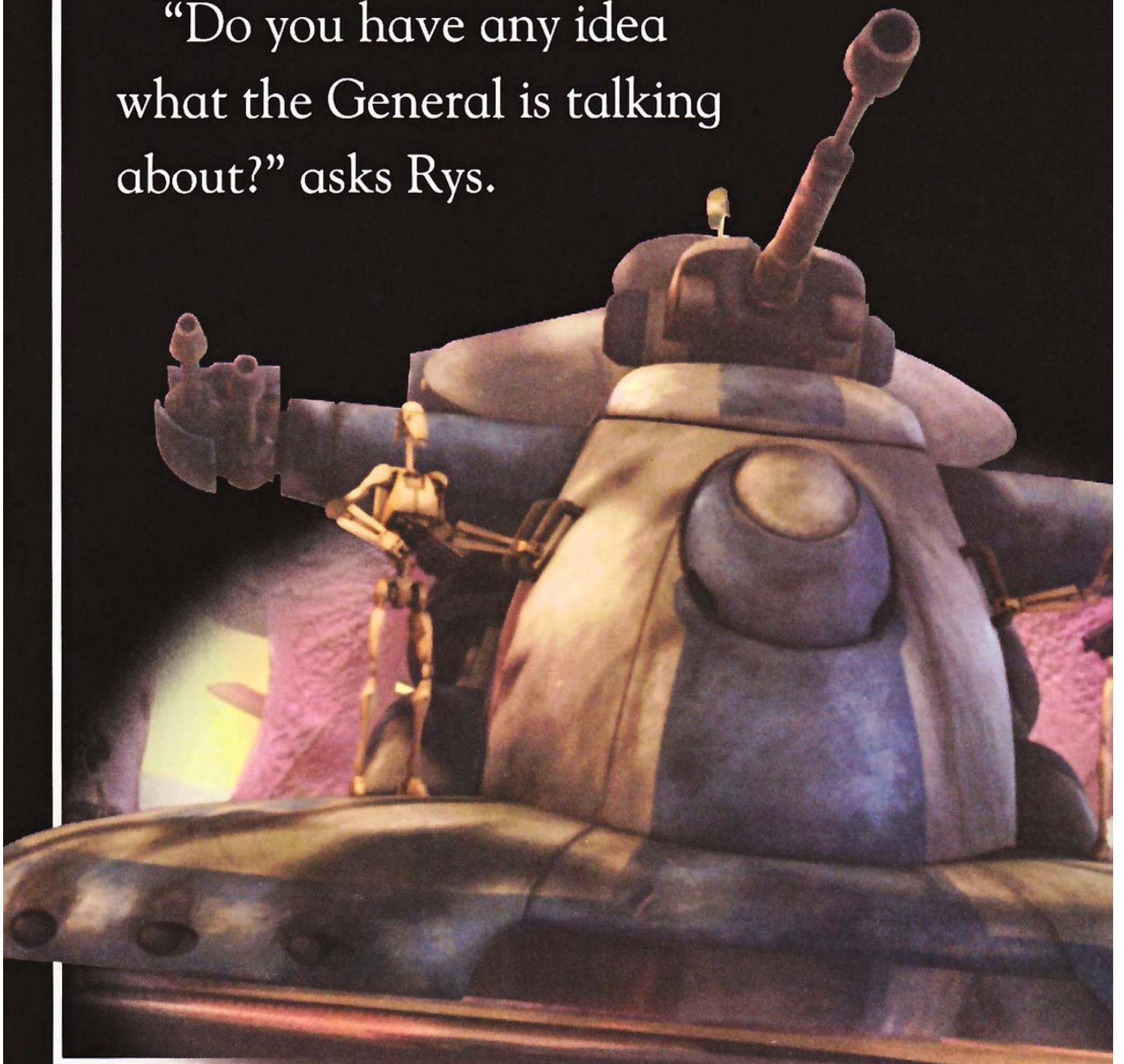
Yoda leads his troops towards a thick coral forest nearby. The droid army marches towards the coral forest, too.

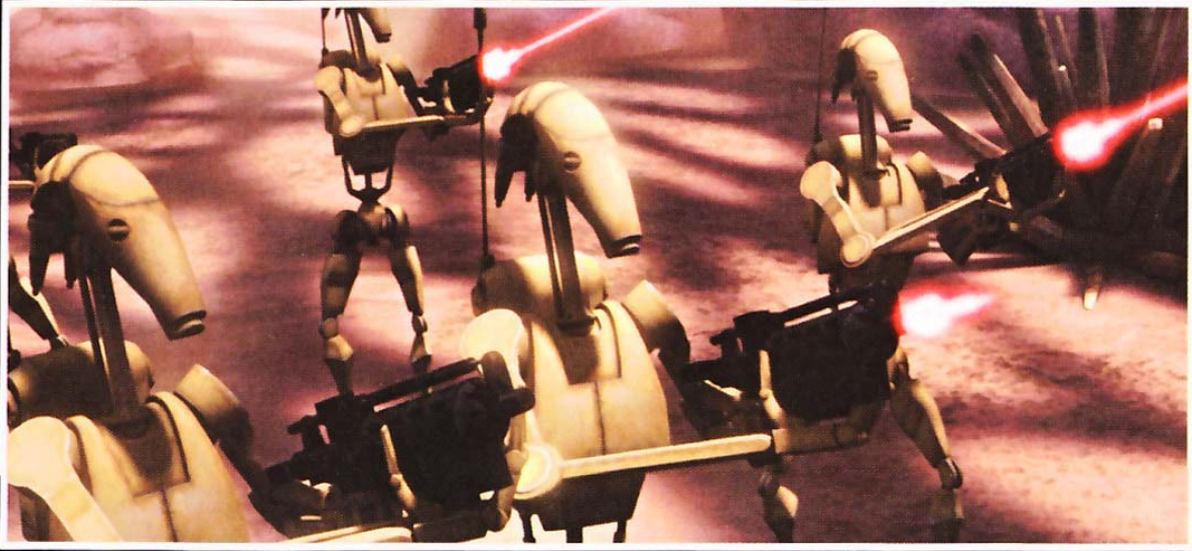


The droid tanks are too big to fit into the coral forest. So the droids march into the forest on foot.

“Size is not everything, mmm? Smaller in number we are, but larger in mind,” Yoda chuckles.

“Do you have any idea what the General is talking about?” asks Rys.





“How should I know? There’s no figuring a Jedi Master,” answers Jjeck.

Thire decides that they can attack the droids from the side. Yoda heads off in the other direction. A squad of Battle Droids walks past Jjeck who is hiding behind some coral. He blasts the head off of the lead droid. The other droids spot Jjeck and fire, as he turns and runs for cover.

A squad of Battle Droids sees Yoda, so they fire at him – but he jumps quickly on top of the coral and out of sight.

Suddenly, Yoda drops onto one of the droid's shoulders. The other droids aim and fire, but Yoda jumps away as the laser fire blows off the droid's head.



Yoda leaps from head to head, while the droids blast each other to pieces.

The three clones are outnumbered by a squad of Super Battle Droids, so they retreat into the forest.

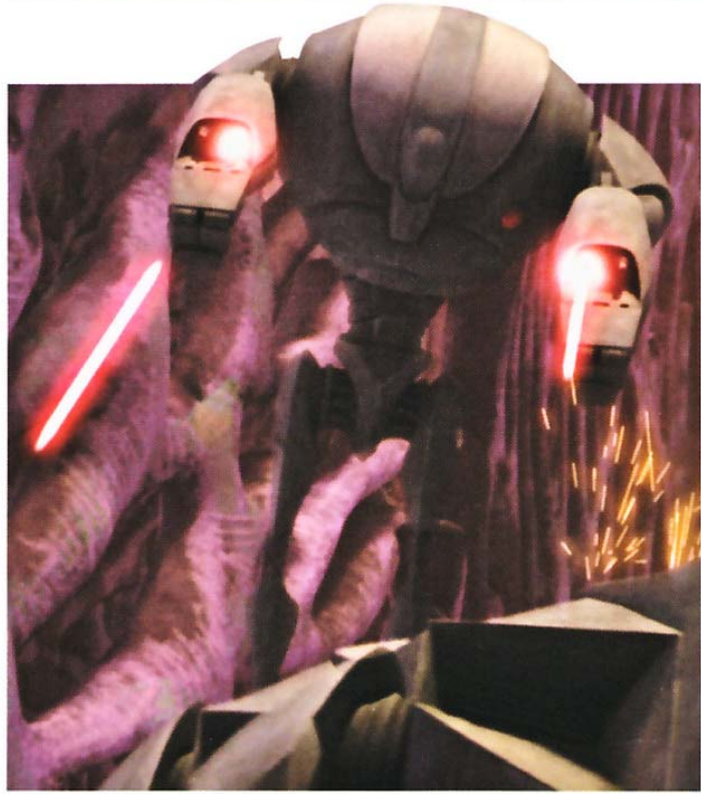


Squads of Super Battle Droids swarm into the coral forest after the clones. One of the Super Battle Droids fires a rocket which explodes, sending Thire flying into the coral and injuring his leg.

Yoda leaps in front of the clones and deflects the droids' laser fire with his lightsaber. The laser bolts hit some of the droids, but more of them are surging up from behind. Yoda and the clones are trapped. Yoda closes his eyes and meditates. As the Super Battle Droids march in, Yoda calmly raises his hand.



One droid lifts off the ground, and continues to walk and fire in mid-air. Yoda waves his hand, and the droid spins around and fires on his squad.



The droid doesn't know what is happening.

“Don't shoot! I'm on your side,” shouts the confused droid, but the other droids shoot back at him.

Yoda sends the droid flying into the remaining droids, destroying them. They have been defeated!

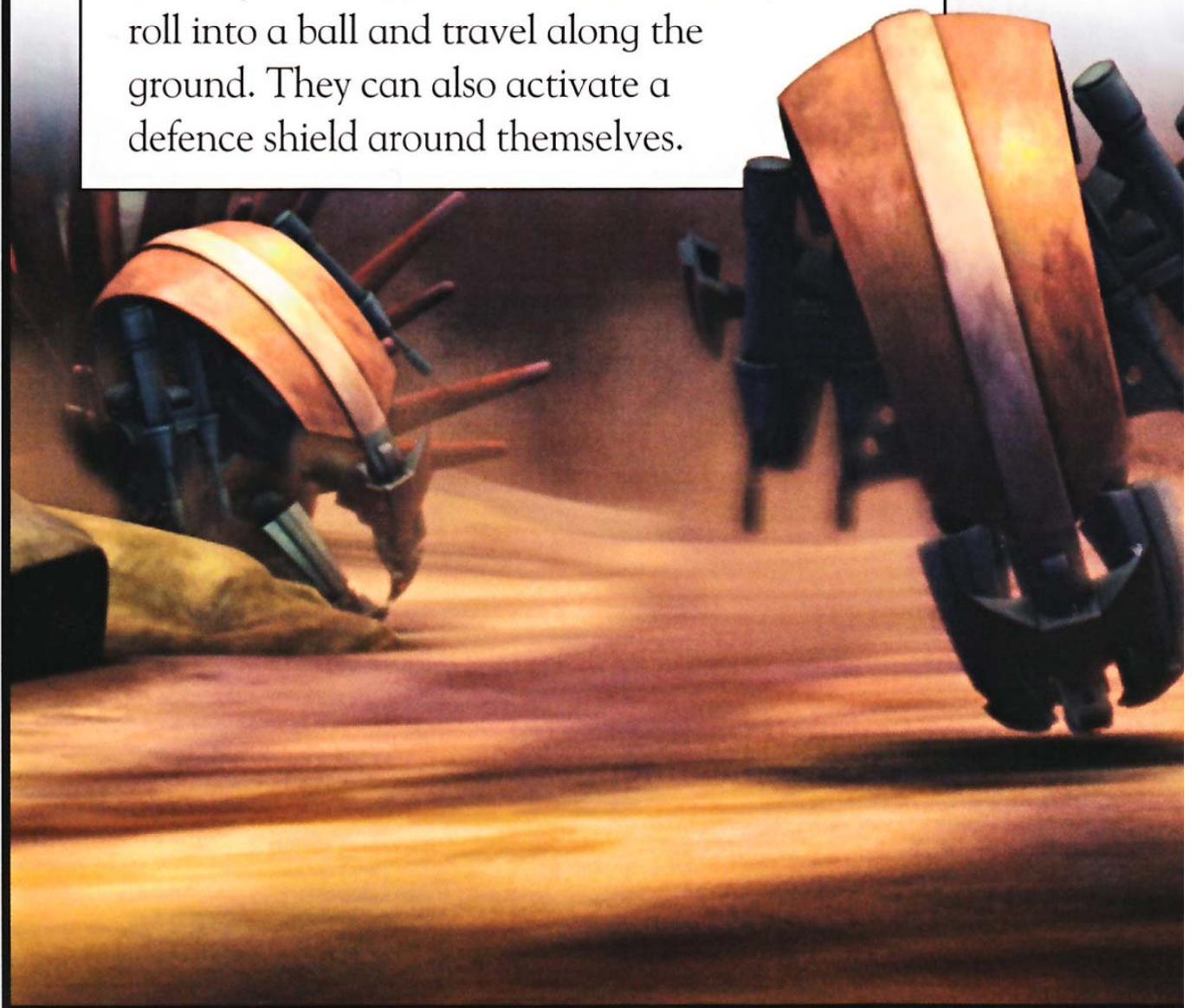
Yoda and the clones hear the sound of rolling metal.

“Rollies, inbound!”

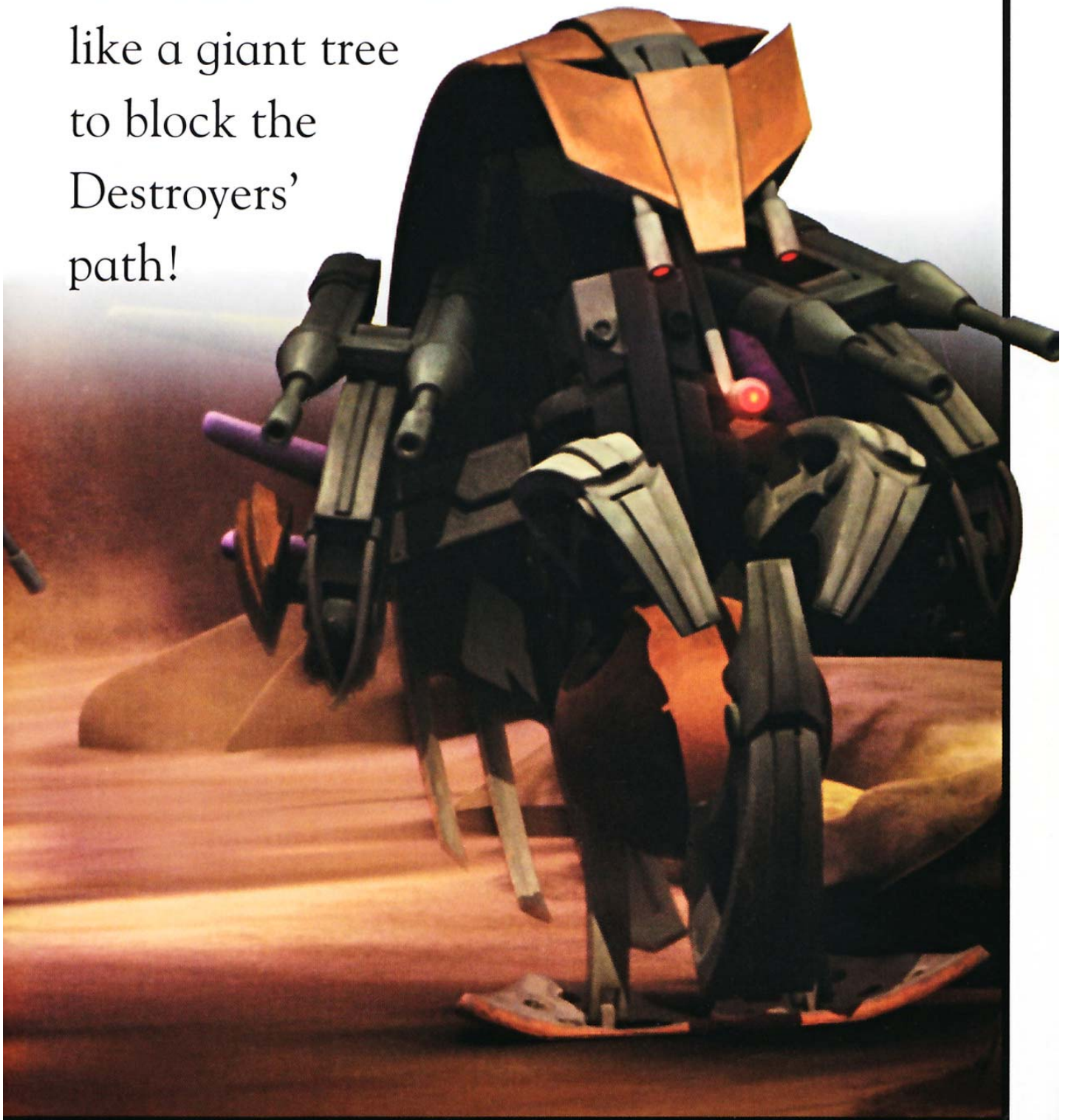
Three Destroyer Droids roll into view, unfold, and open fire on Yoda and the clone troopers.

Destroyer Droids

Destroyer Droids, also called droidekas, can roll into a ball and travel along the ground. They can also activate a defence shield around themselves.



“Retreat! Cover you, I will!” shouts Yoda, jumping onto Rys’s back as the clones run as quickly as they can. Yoda deflects a couple of blasts into a column of coral and it falls like a giant tree to block the Destroyers’ path!



“The Republic troops are injured. The Jedi is in full retreat, Supreme Leader,” reports a droid commander to Ventress.

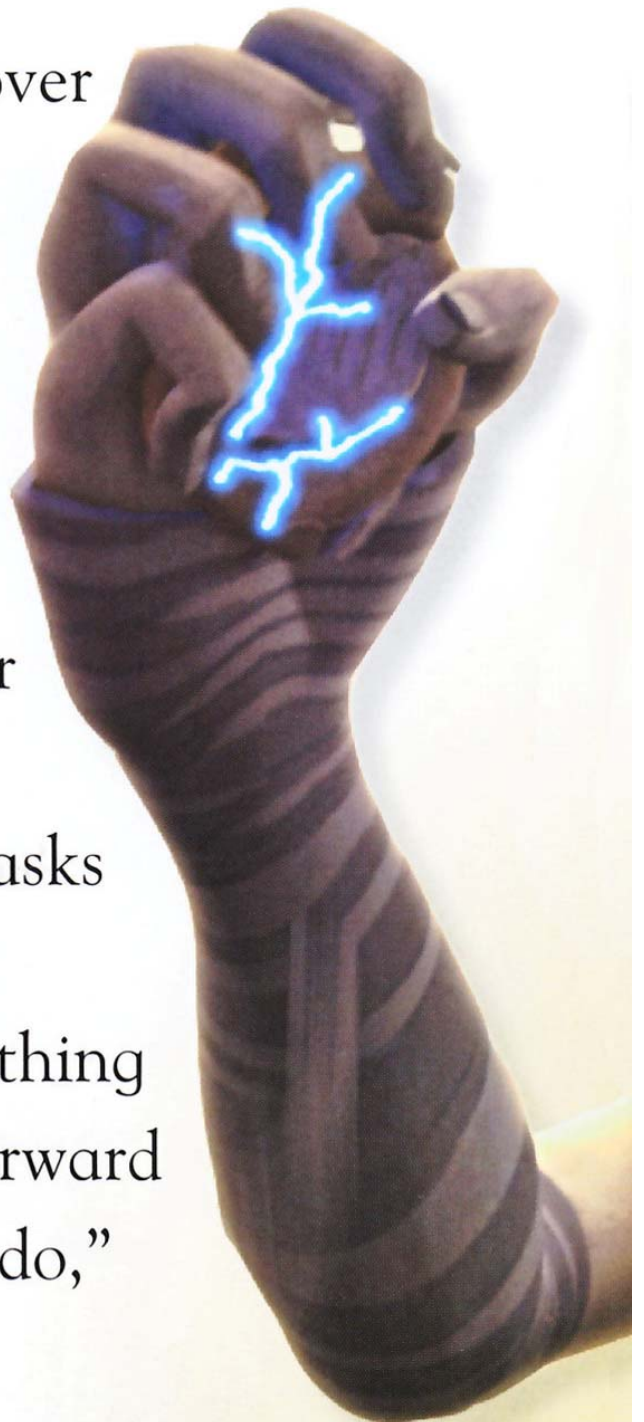
“Good, pursue them without delay,” replies Ventress.

“The contest is not over yet,” says King Katuunko.

The King contacts Yoda on his holoprojector.

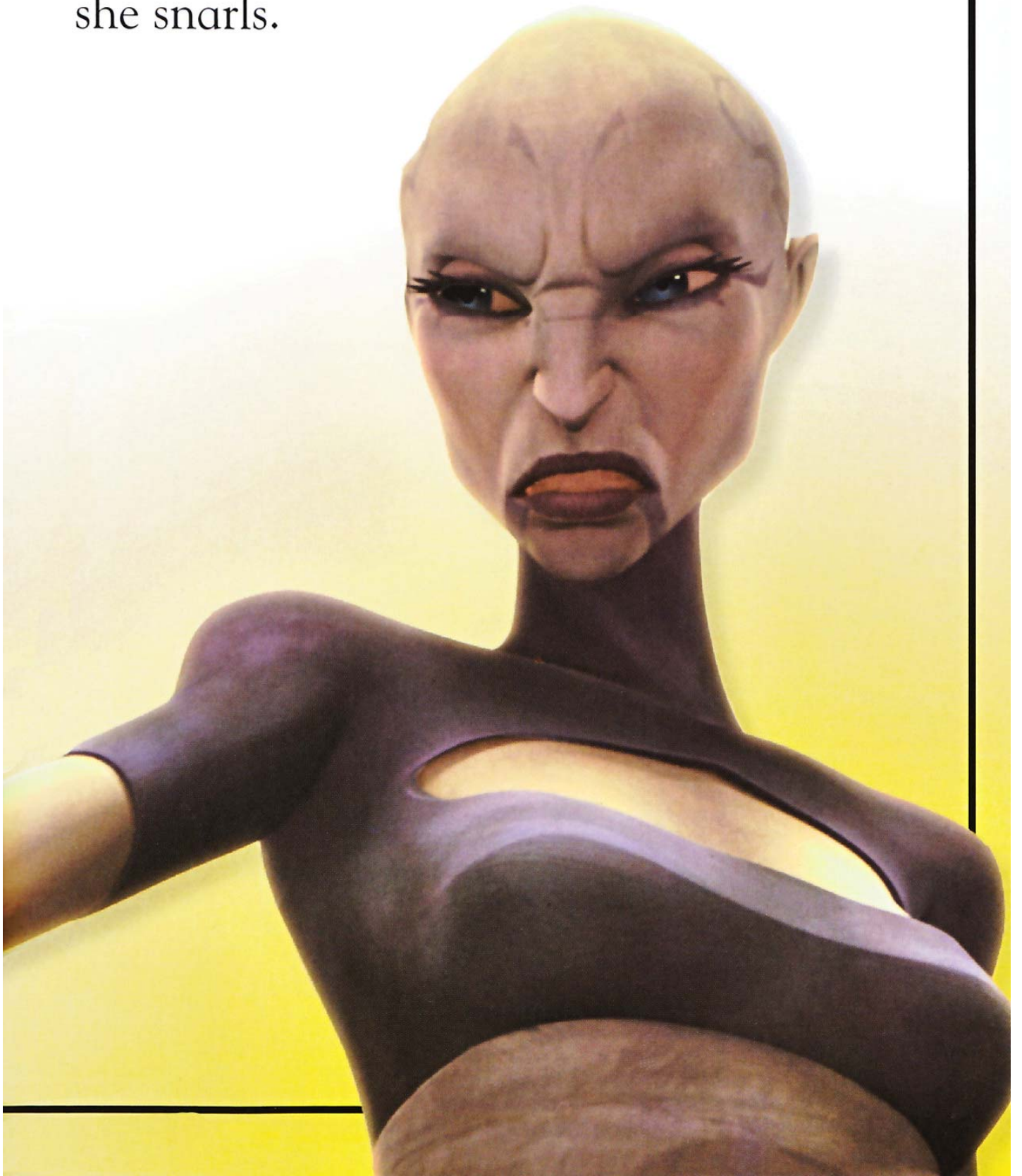
“Master Yoda! I hear you’re having trouble with the droid army?” asks the King.

“Trouble? I know nothing of this trouble. Look forward to our meeting soon, I do,” replies Yoda.



The King's holoprojector flies from his hand into Ventress's grasp. She furiously crushes it.

"The Jedi won't elude me for long," she snarls.



Yoda leads the clone troopers into a cave in a narrow canyon to rest. The droid tanks batter down the forest as they pursue Yoda. The clones are tired. They spread out their few remaining weapons on the floor.

Yoda takes the two damaged rifles and puts one on top of the other to make a crutch for Thire.

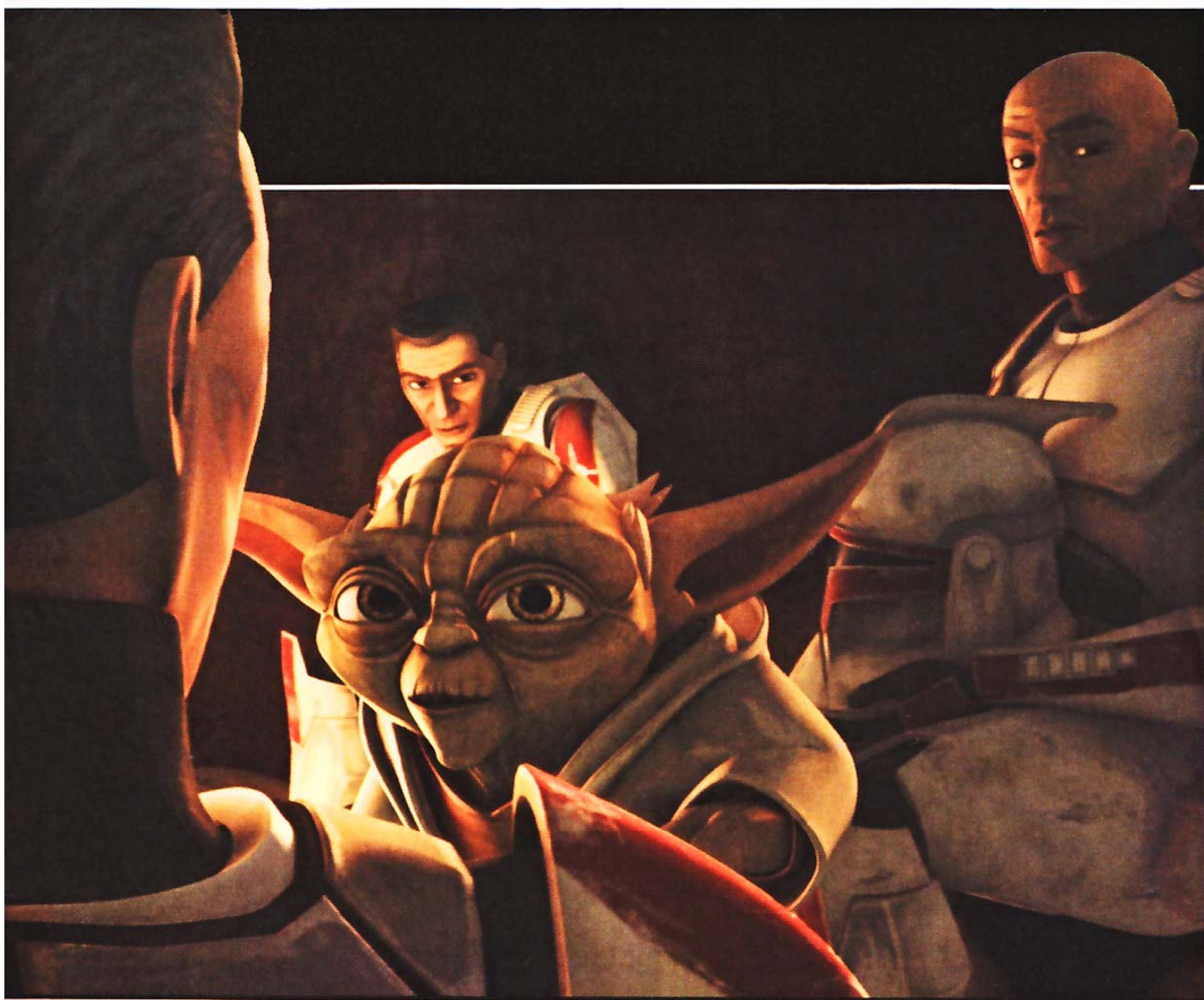
“So certain of defeat are you, mmm?” asks Yoda, welding the two rifles together with his lightsaber.

“Come, sit. Your helmets. Remove them. Your faces I wish to see,” says Yoda.

Clone Army

The Republic's army is made up of soldiers called clone troopers who all look the same.





Yoda tells the clones they are all different, even though they share the same face.

“Clones you may be, but the Force resides in all life-forms. Use it you can, to quiet your mind,” Yoda advises.

Three tanks roll into the narrow canyon. A squad of Battle Droids rides on the outside of each tank. Destroyer Droids roll alongside them.

“Greet them I will,” Yoda says.

“General, you don’t plan to take on the whole column by yourself?” Lieutenant Thire asks.

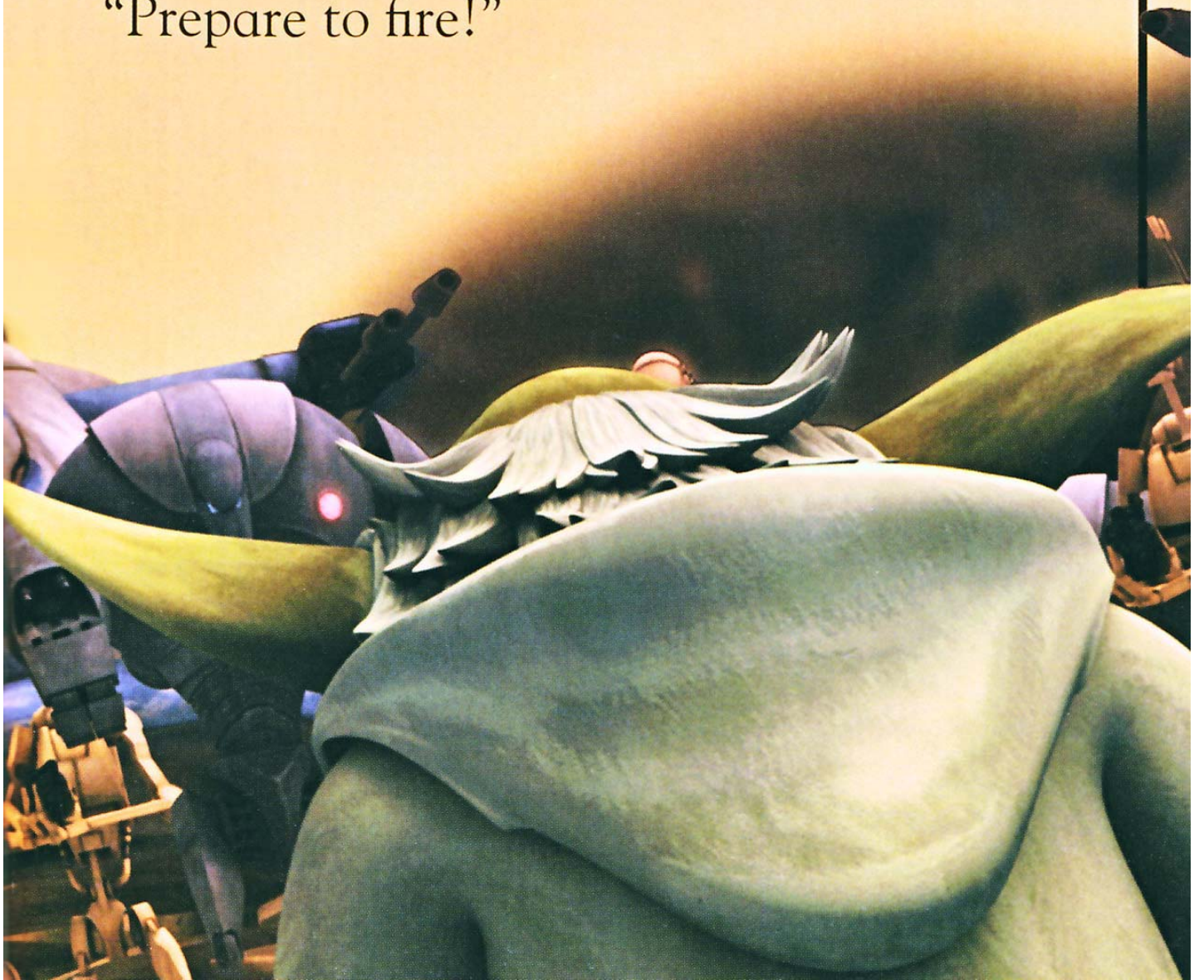


“Have you three, I do! Outnumbered are they. Know the time to help me, you will,” Yoda chuckles.

The droid tanks continue to roll into the canyon; the lead tank slows to a standstill. There’s something in the way. It’s Yoda!

“It’s the Jedi! Block his escape!” the droid commander instructs.

“Prepare to fire!”



Yoda darts under the first tank just in time to avoid its fire. When the smoke clears, he has vanished from the droids' sight. Yoda uses his lightsaber to cut a hole in the tank's belly. He climbs up inside the tank.


There is a sound of clanking and fighting from inside the tank.





The back of the tank opens and two droids come running out, trying to get away. Yoda Force-pulls the droids back into the tank. An annoyed Battle Droid commander peers down into the hatch and is sliced into several pieces by Yoda's quick blade. Yoda leaps from the top of the tank onto the droids' heads, slicing them up as he goes.





Yoda lands in front of the barrel of the second tank. The tank commander sees Yoda – he’s right in their line of fire.

“We’ve got him in our sights!”

Yoda leaps into the air just as the tank fires. The blast hits the first tank and destroys it.

Yoda comes down and scrambles up the barrel and onto the top of the tank. He cuts a hole in its top and Force-pulls the Battle Droid tank driver out and sends him flying into the air.

King Katuunko hovers at the edge of the tree, flanked by Royal Guards. Black smoke curls up into the sky from the battle.

“That’s a lot of smoke for a surrender...” the King chuckles.

Ventress turns away secretively and activates her holoprojector to speak to the droid commander.

“Where is two-two-four?” she demands.



“Destroyed, Supreme Leader. The Jedi has overrun our position, agAHH!” Yoda leaps into the hologram and slashes apart the Battle Droid. Ventress seethes with cold fury.

“I think all those stories about the Jedi are true,” says the King, looking over Ventress’s shoulder.

“The fight isn’t over yet, Majesty,” replies Ventress coolly, activating a control that sends another squad of Destroyer Droids rolling into the forest.





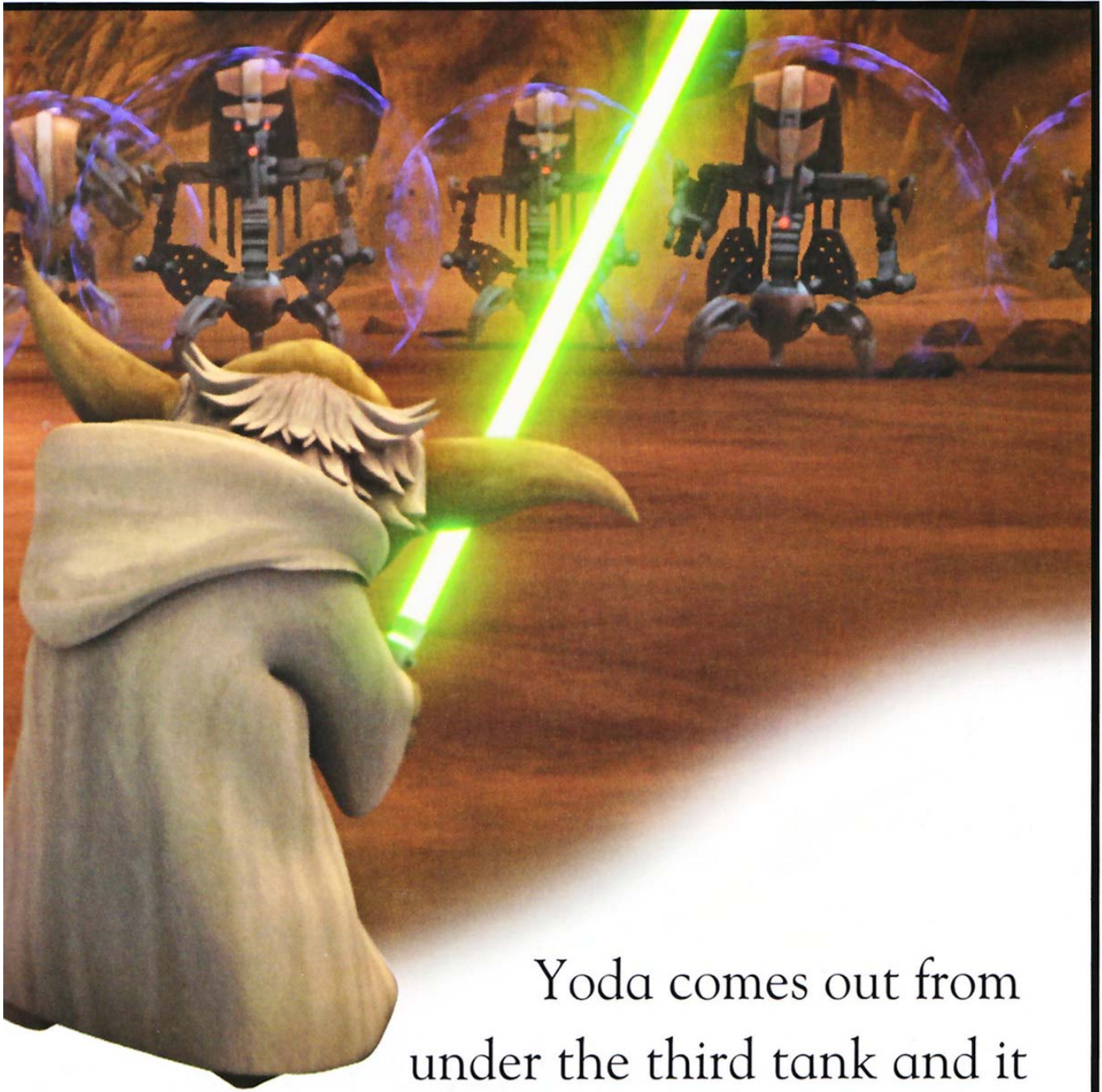
The last droid collapses into a heap, destroyed by Yoda. The clones watch, amazed at Yoda's victory.

Jjeck spots the Destroyer Droids – approaching the battle at high speed.

“We got trouble.”

“The clankers sent reinforcements,” says Thire grimly. “The General's too busy with that tank. He won't see 'em coming.”

“I think I know how to deal with them,” says Thire, hatching a plan.

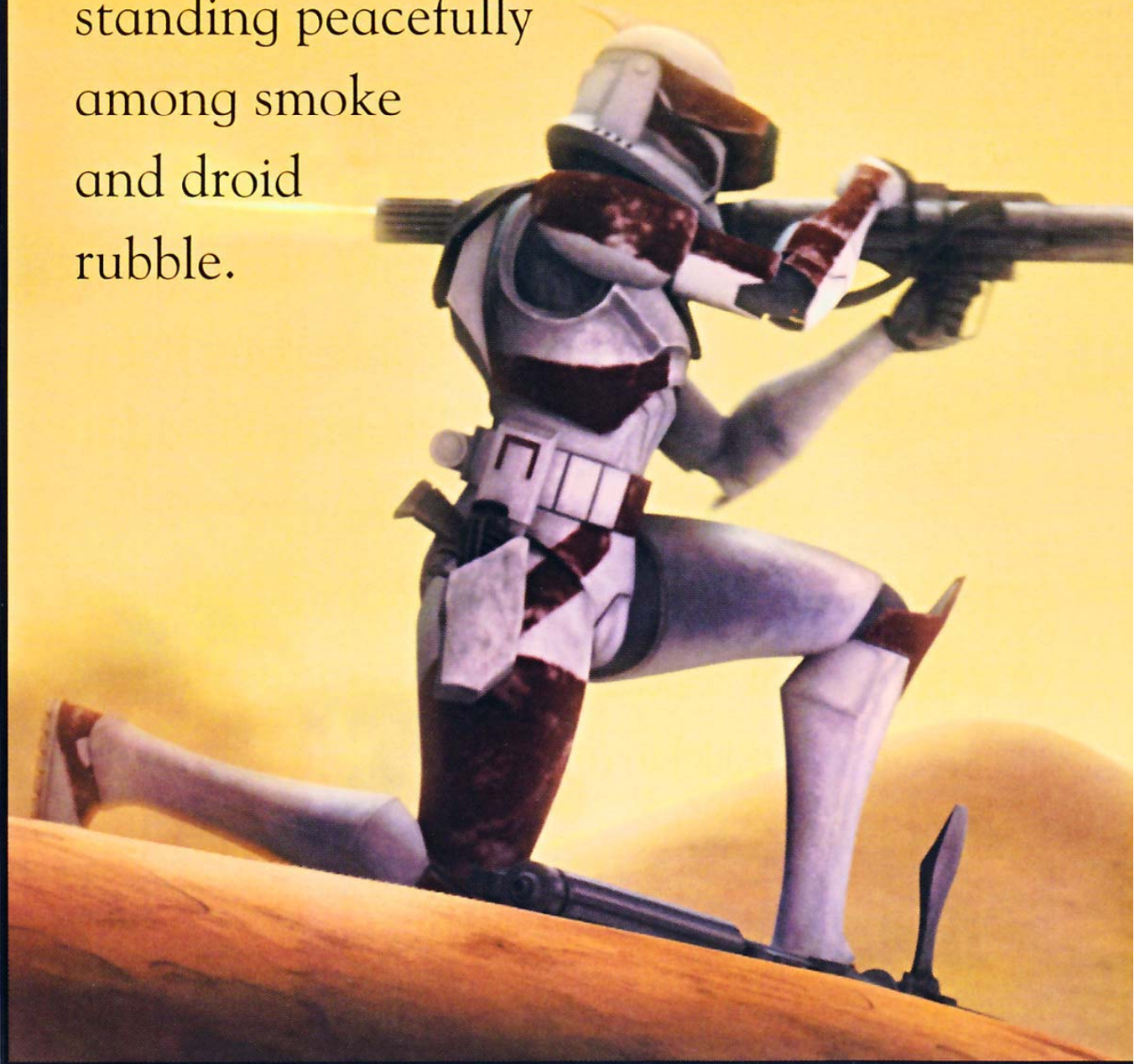


Yoda comes out from under the third tank and it collapses behind him, exploding. The tanks and Battle Droids are defeated. Yoda looks up and sees the Destroyer Droids roll up and unfold before him. They start to fire as Yoda tries to defend himself.

Thire fires his rocket at a huge piece of coral that hangs over the Destroyer Droids. The coral breaks and a large chunk tumbles down onto the Destroyer Droids below, crushing them.

Yoda is saved!

The three clones limp out to join Yoda, standing peacefully among smoke and droid rubble.



Yoda holds out his finger as a baby nebray flutters down to perch on it.

“Hmmm. Learned something today have you, Lieutenant? Hmm?” Yoda asks.

“I think we all did, General,” replies Thire.

“Come, behind schedule are we. Not polite to be late,” says Yoda as he hurries off.



“You were right, Count Dooku, one Jedi is not worth a hundred Battle Droids. More like a thousand! I’m sorry, but I will be joining the Republic,” says King Katuunko to a hologram of Count Dooku.

“I urge you to reconsider, wise King. I promise you won’t regret it,” replies Dooku.

“Your agent also promised me Yoda would get a fair fight. I will not deal with those who break their words.”

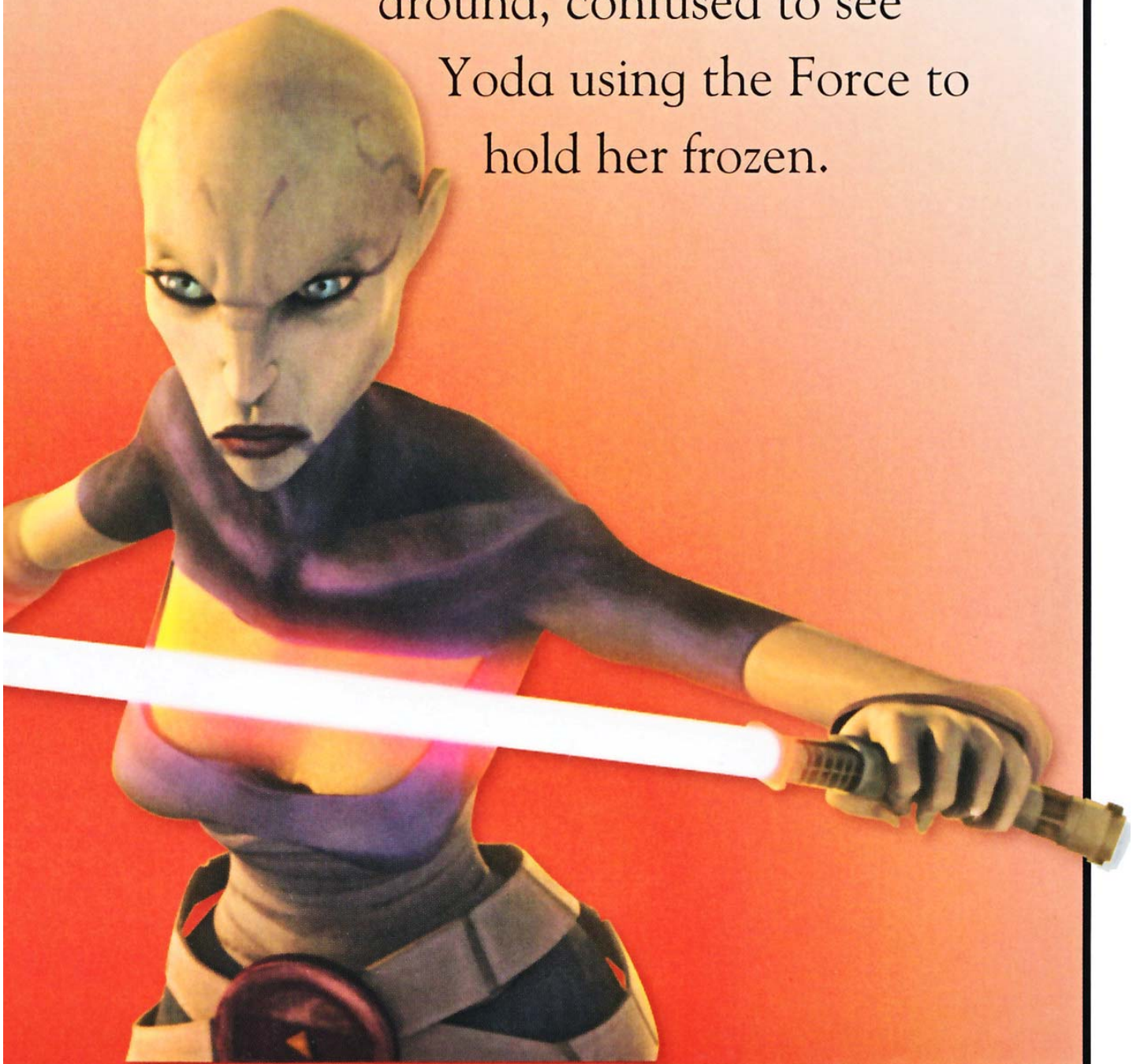
“So be it. Perhaps our negotiations will be more fruitful with your successor.

Ventress! Kill him!” orders Count Dooku.

On the cliff above, the King's ship explodes

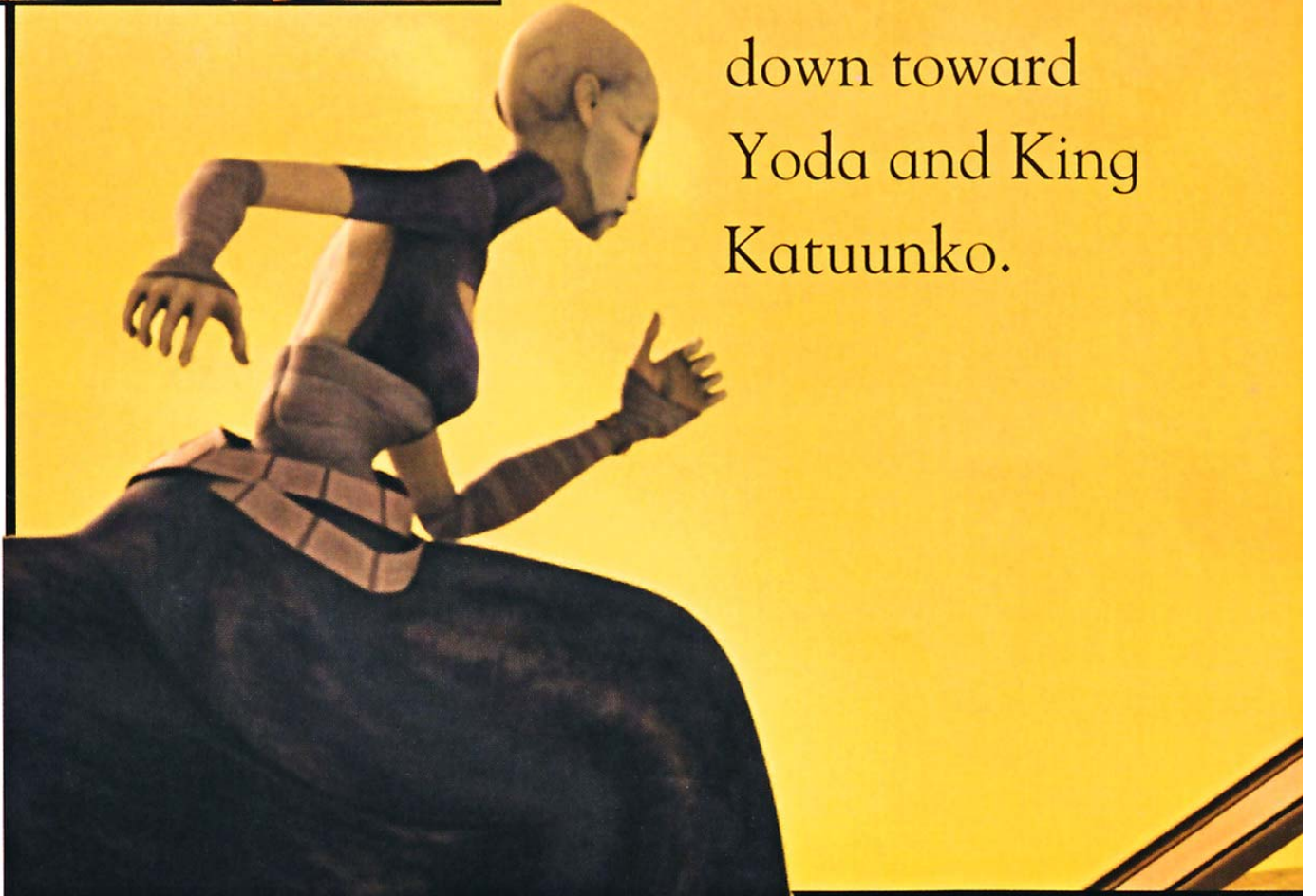
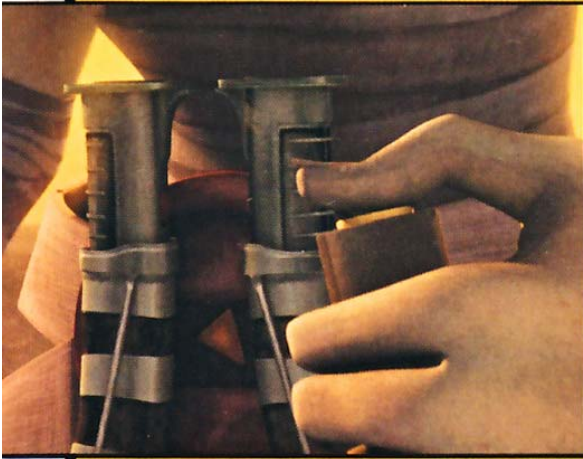
with a tremendous

Katuunko.



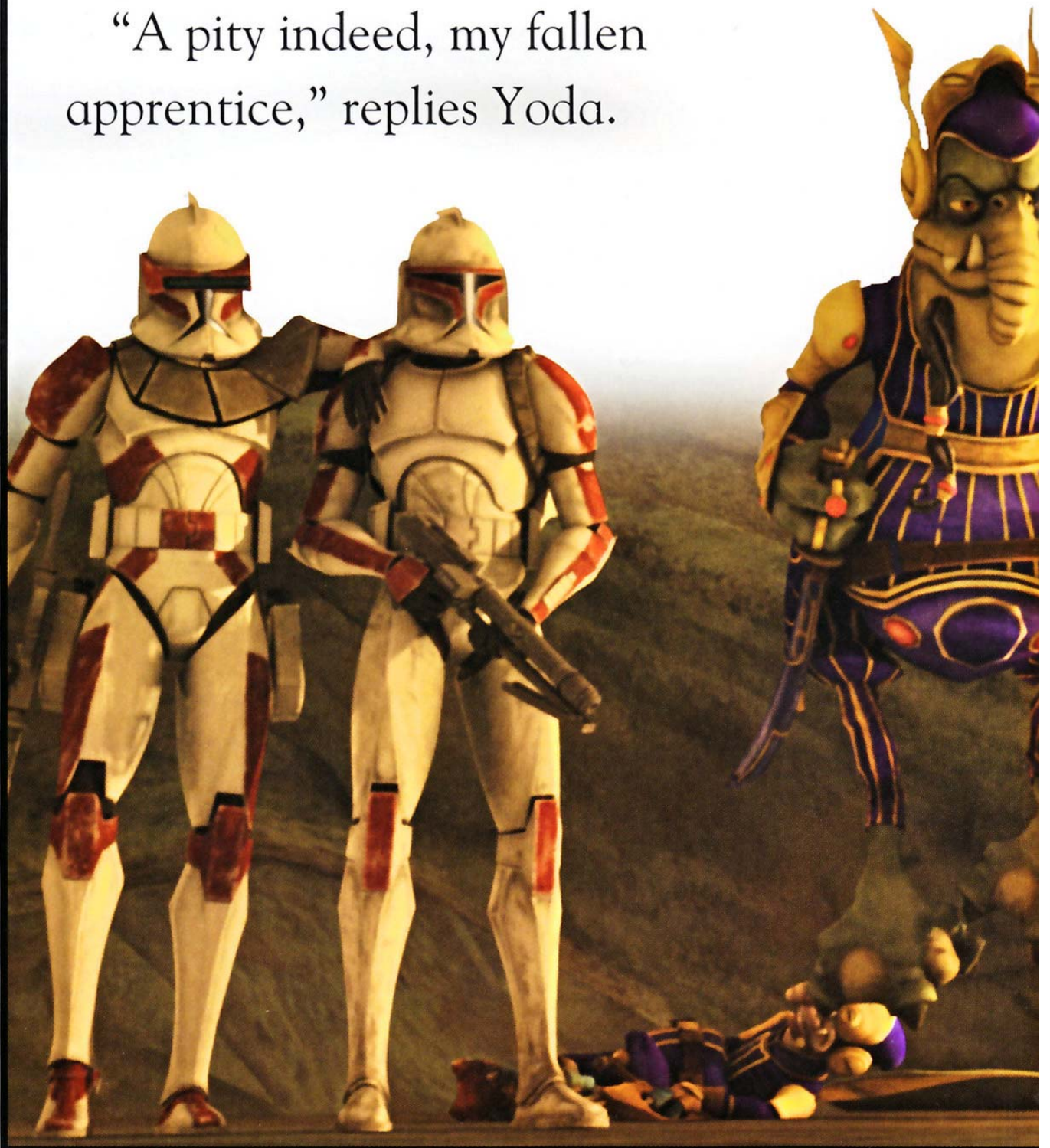
Yoda raises his hand and stops the rubble falling on them as Ventress takes her chance to escape. When Yoda looks up, Ventress is already in her ship and taking off.



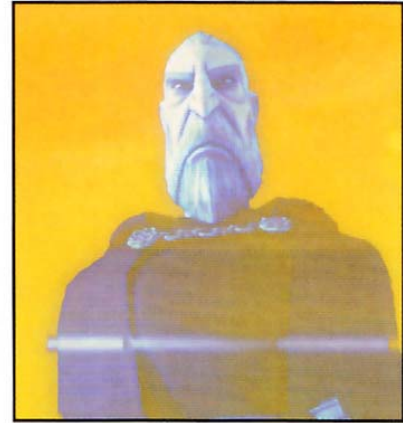
“Hmph. In the end, cowards are those who follow the dark side,” Yoda says.

The King presents a decorated sword to Yoda, a Toydarian sign of respect.

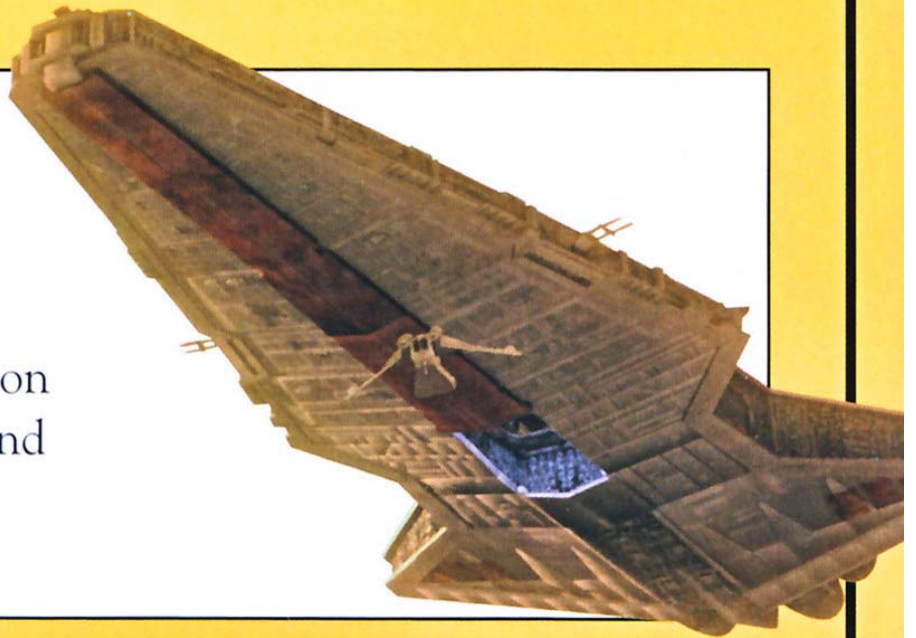
Yoda bows and takes the sword. Yoda looks to his clones to say thanks.

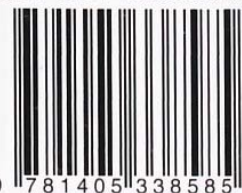
