



Aliens are not human.


There are lots of different aliens.

a human.




This is my friend R2-D2. He is a droid too.






R2-D2 is a clever little machine.

He can fix anything!








He is the best friend of Han Solo, who is a human.

Let's visit Watto's shop.


Watto is a blue alien.

He sells bits of old machines called junk.









This nasty alien races in a vehicle called a Podracer. He likes to go fast.

can carry heavy things.






Pit droids sometimes get into trouble.

Tap them on the nose


and they fold up.


Jabba the Hutt is a nasty alien. He has a fat body and a long tail. His body is covered in sticky slime.

Don't get too near him!






Let's visit Dexter Jettster's restaurant.

He cooks the food at Dexter's Diner.


Dexter knows lots of things. What shall we ask him?






These creatures are lizard keepers.

They live in big holes in the ground.




Sometimes, the lizard keepers ride around on giant lizards. The lizards are good at jumping and climbing.

These little aliens find droids and bits of machines to sell.


Once, they even sold R2-D2!

Yoda is very old and very wise. He has green skin and big, pointy ears.


No one knows what kind of creature he is or where he comes from.


