




My name is Luke Skywalker.

It is also more dangerous.


An evil Emperor rules the

a powerful weapon that can destroy a whole planet. It is called the Death Star.



Being a Rebel hero is not easy.


The Imperial stormtroopers are firing at us from all directions.

and everyone was so happy.


I felt like a hero.


Now I am learning that being a Rebel is hard work. Imperial spies are everywhere and we must always be on the look out for them.

The stormtroopers have giant AT-AT walkers and are trying to



Endor's forest moon is home to creatures called Ewoks. They may look cute but they are tough! The Ewoks help the Rebels to destroy the new Death Star.




The Death Star's shield generator is located on the moon of Endor.
