Scraps of bread.

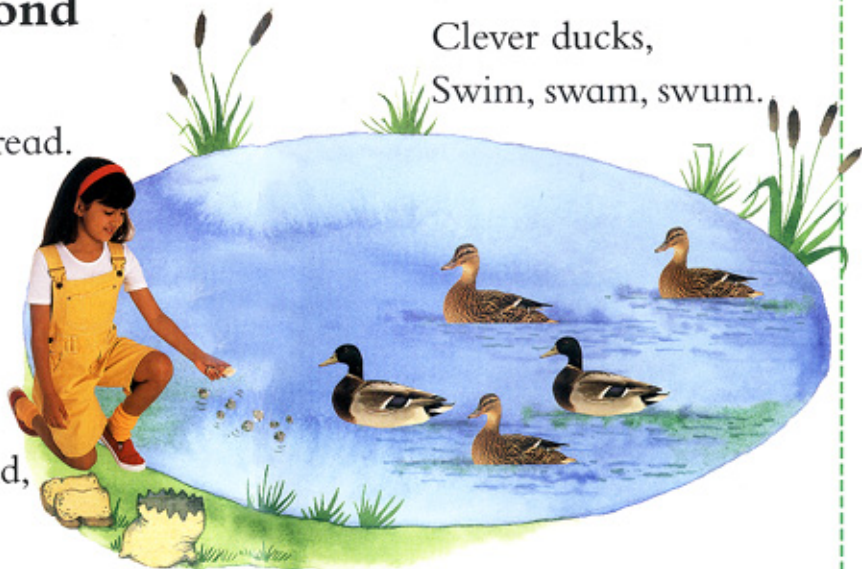
Beady eye,

Swim, swam, swum.

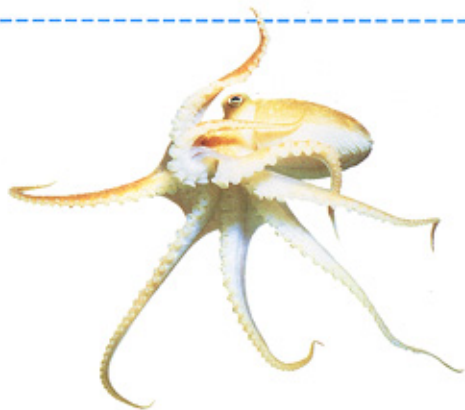
Gobbled up

NO EATING!

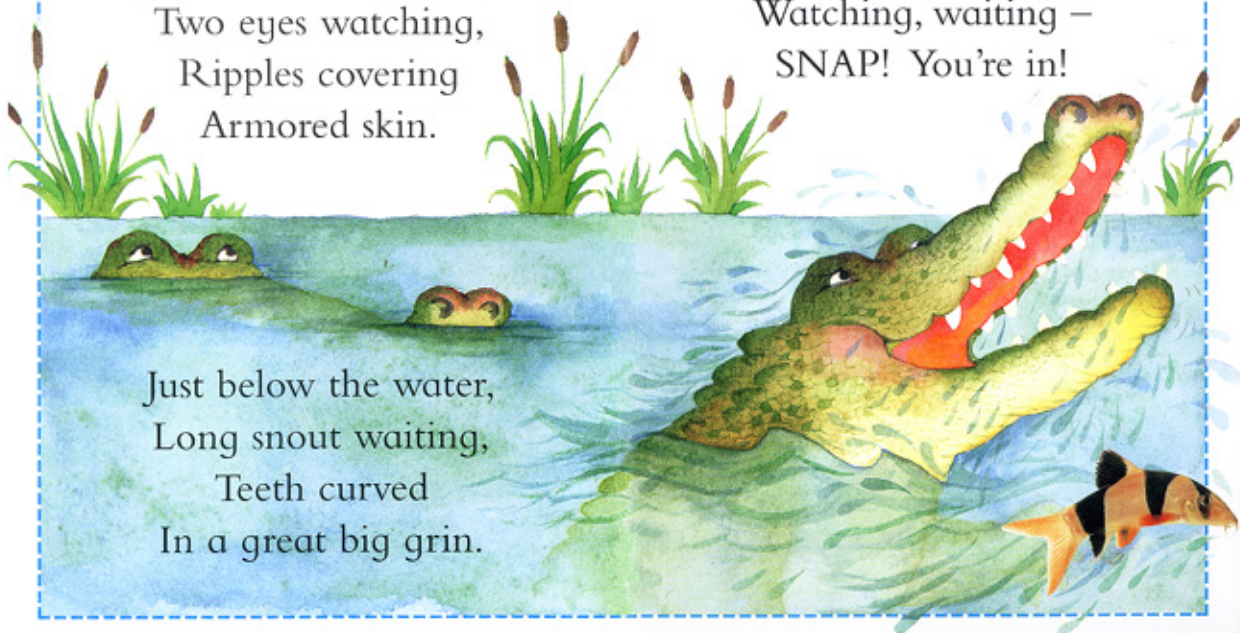


Crocodile

SNAP! You're in!

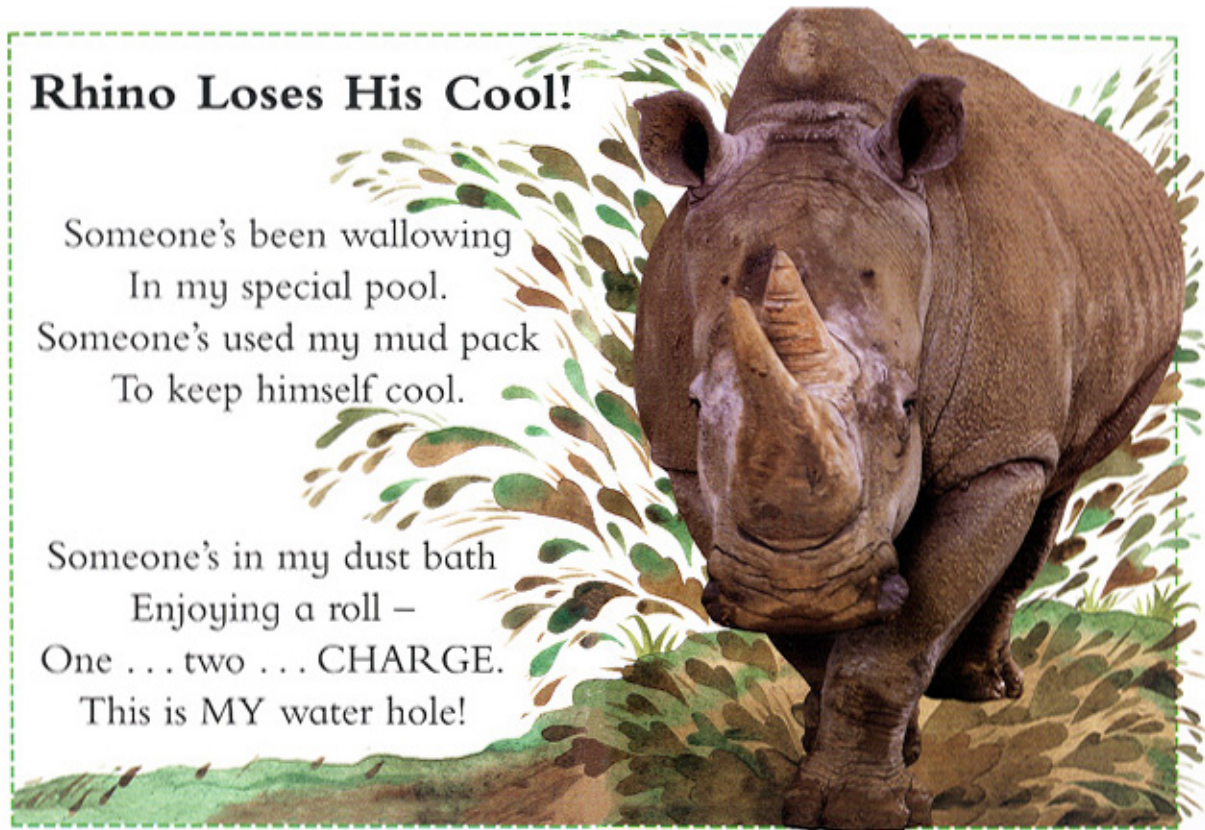
Just below the water,
