
At full stretch they are as tall as 135 feet (41 meters).

STABILIZER EXTENDED


From the platform, they can put out the fire with powerful jets of water or foam.

I fill my massive water tank from a lake or a river using my snorkel. It's like a big straw that can suck up 2,000 gallons of water in just 45 seconds.




Today, I have some friends to help me. They carry giant "Bambi" buckets that they fill from a lake, too.




SNORKEL



