SEE HOW I GO!

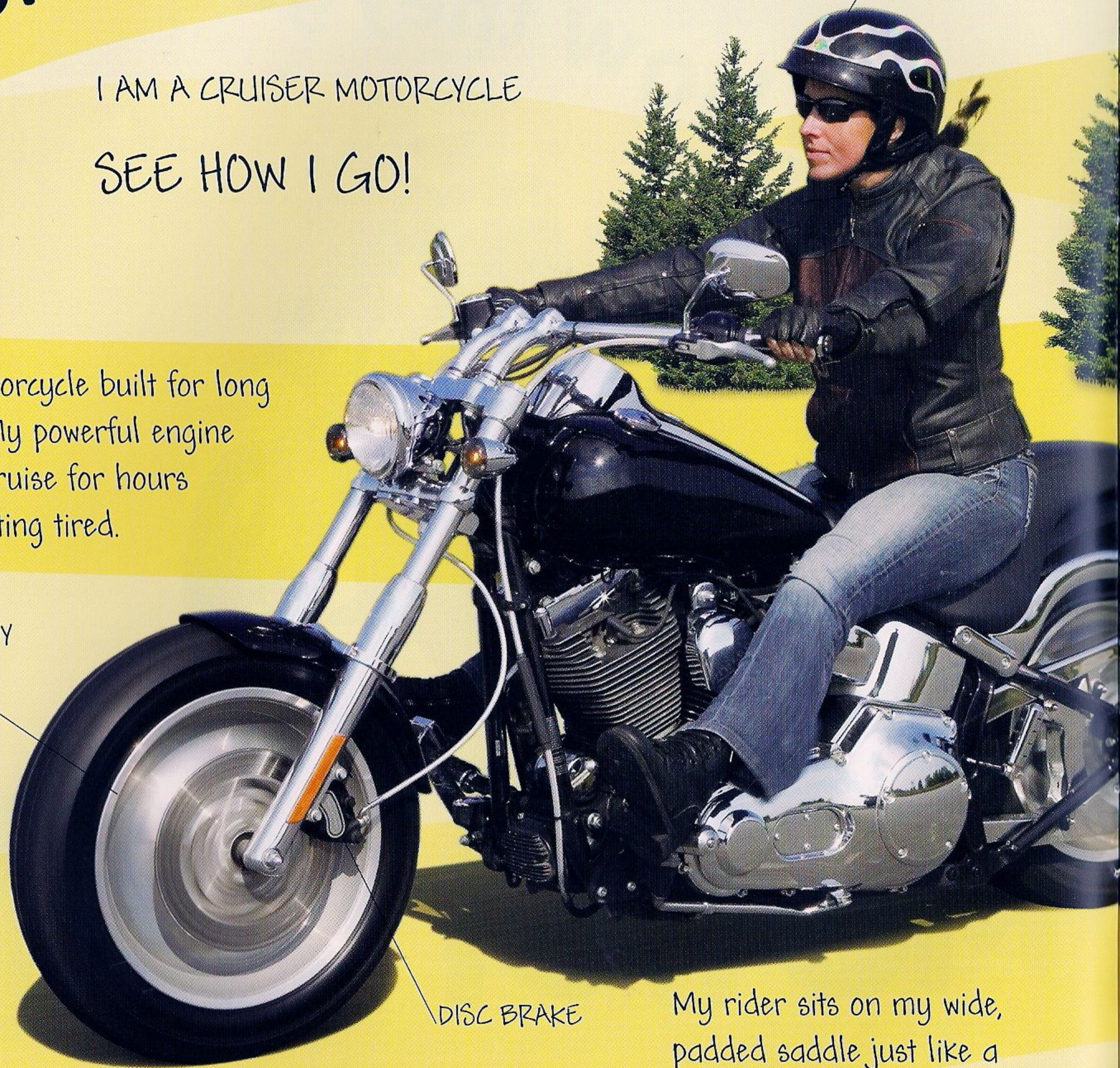
I am a motorcycle built for long journeys. My powerful engine helps me cruise for hours without getting tired.

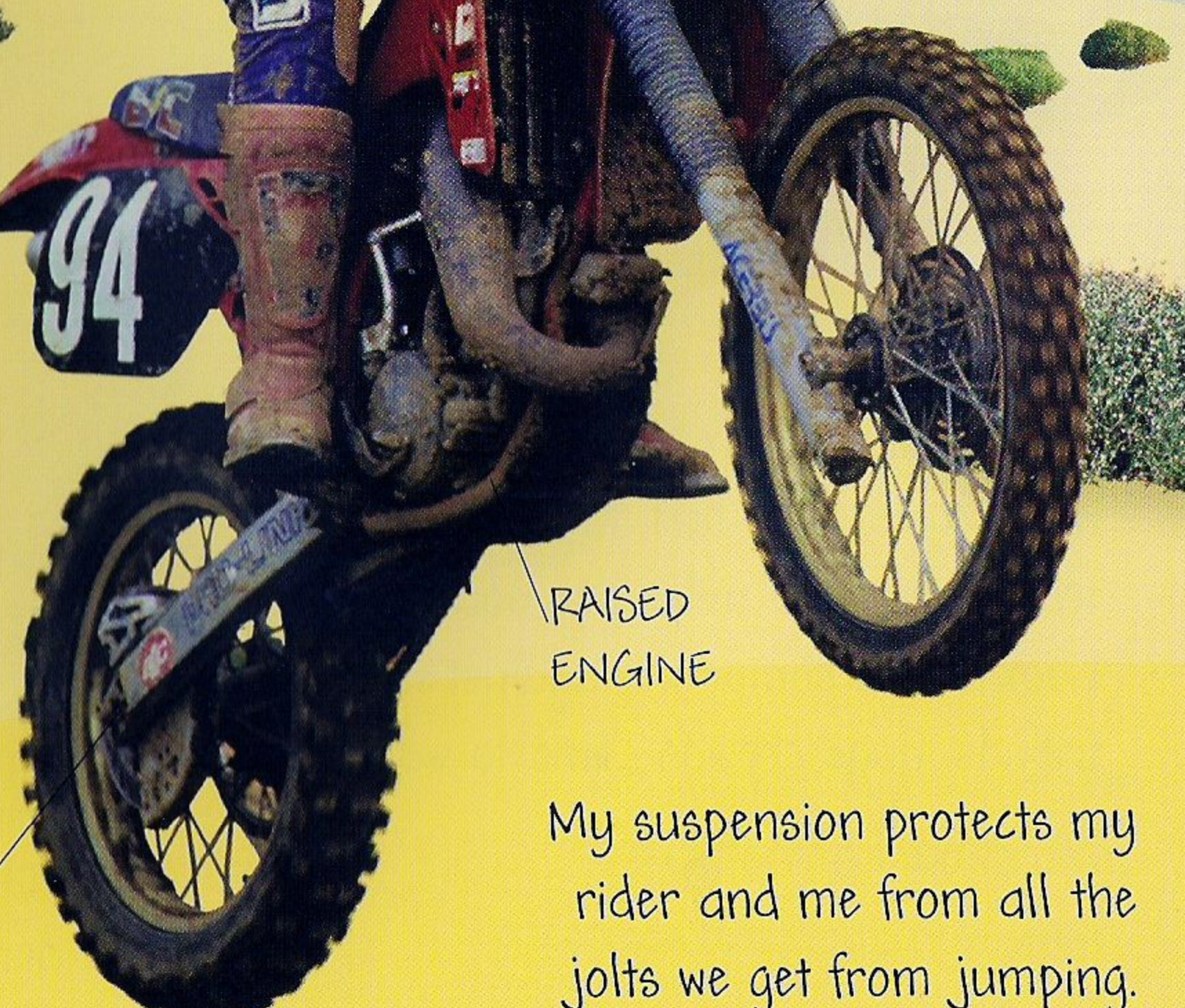

I AM A RACING MOTORCYCLE

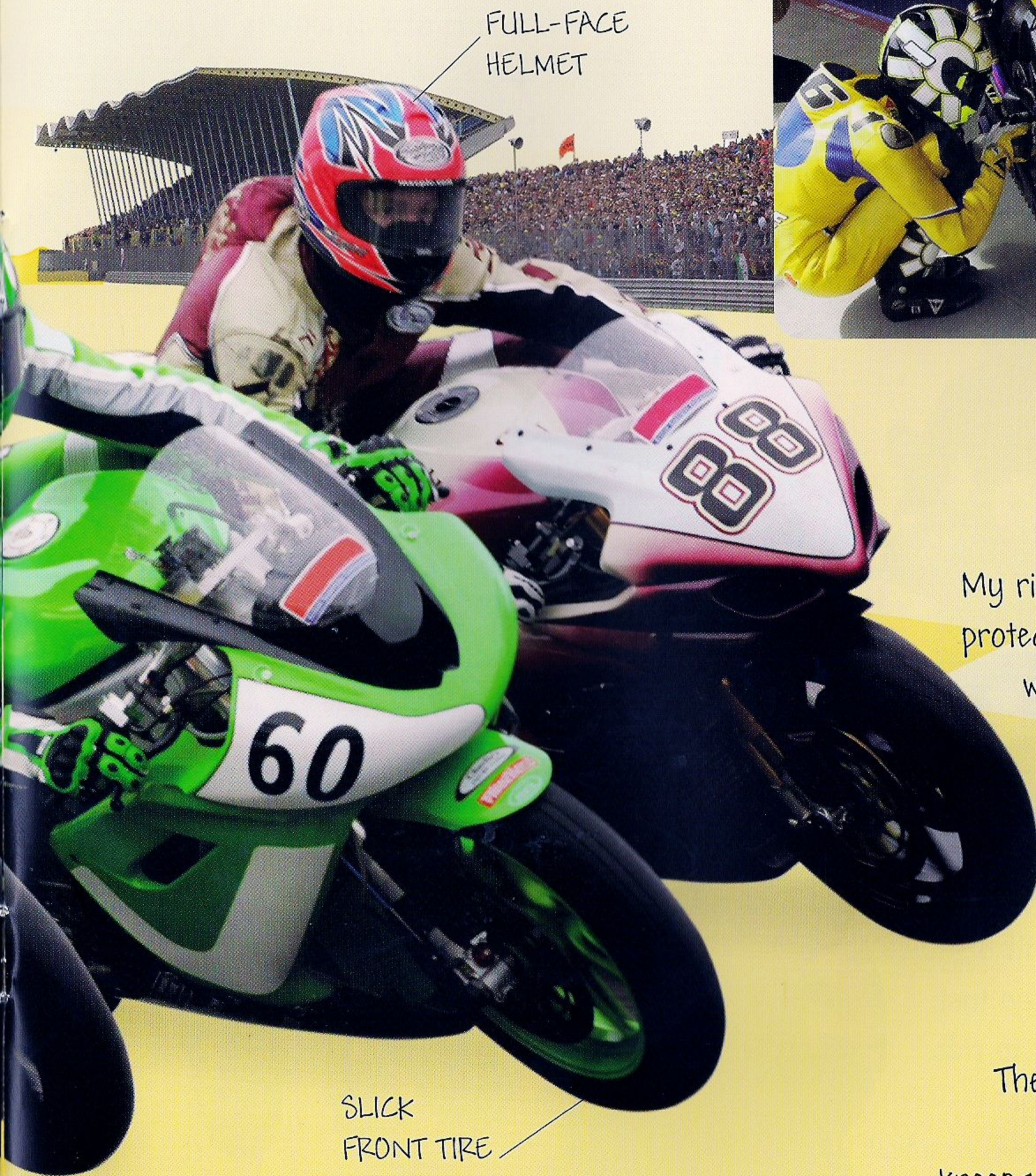

engine and handlebars.

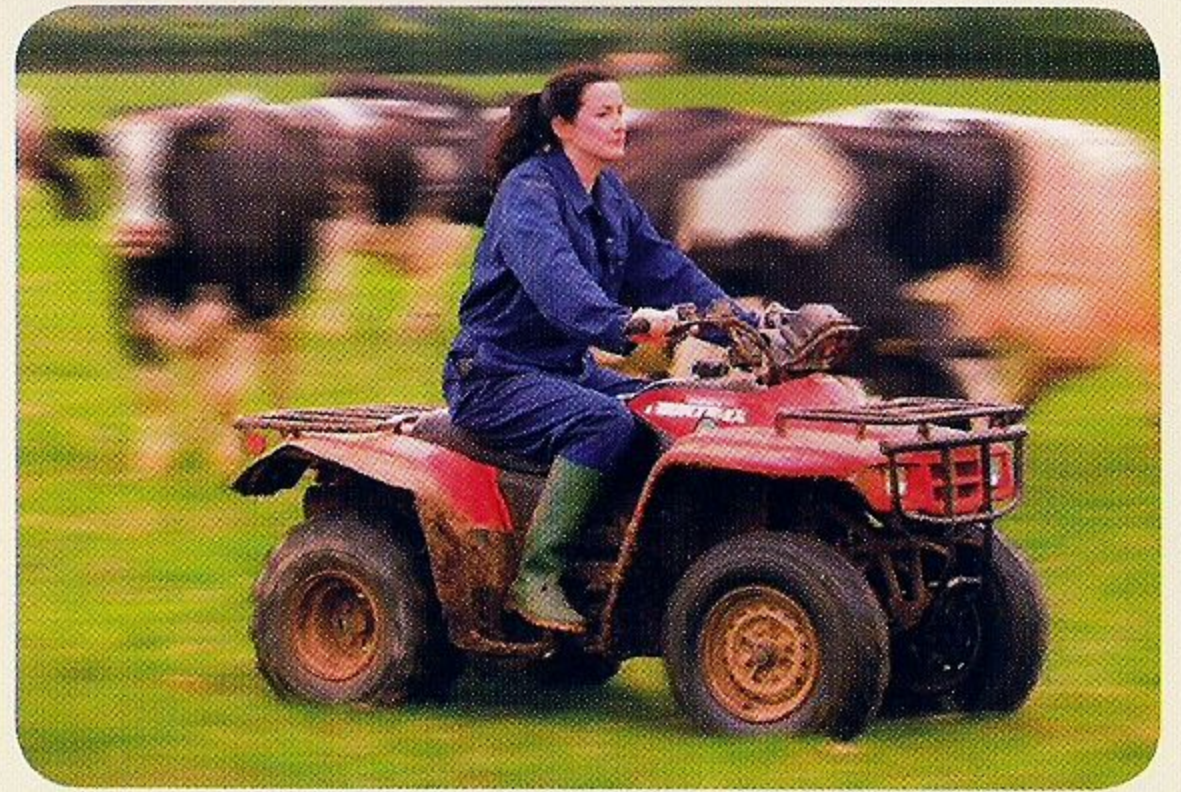

My rider stops motorists who are driving too fast or dangerously.



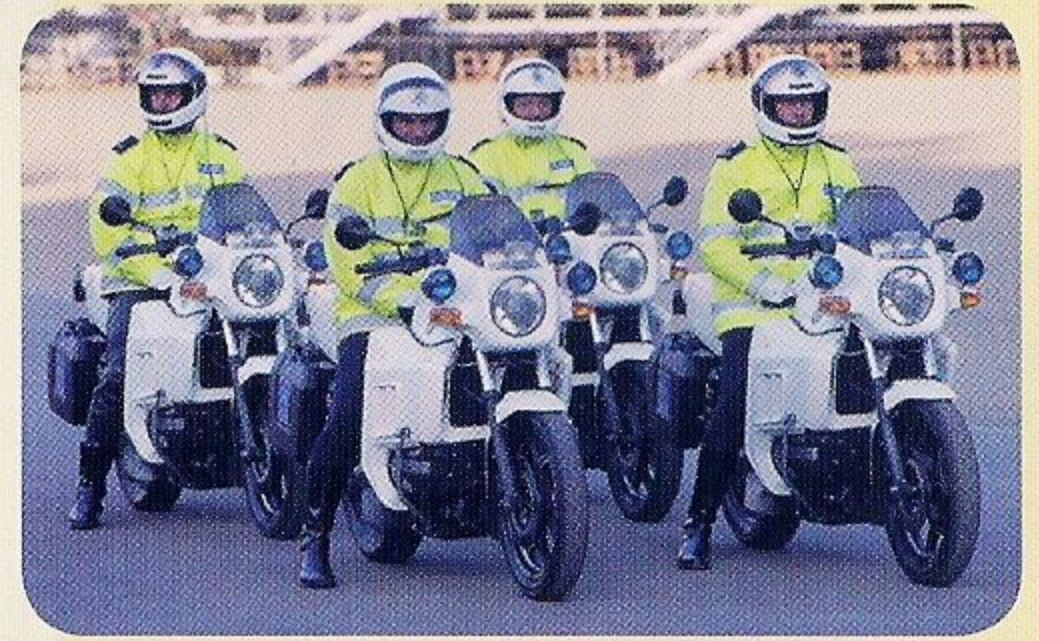
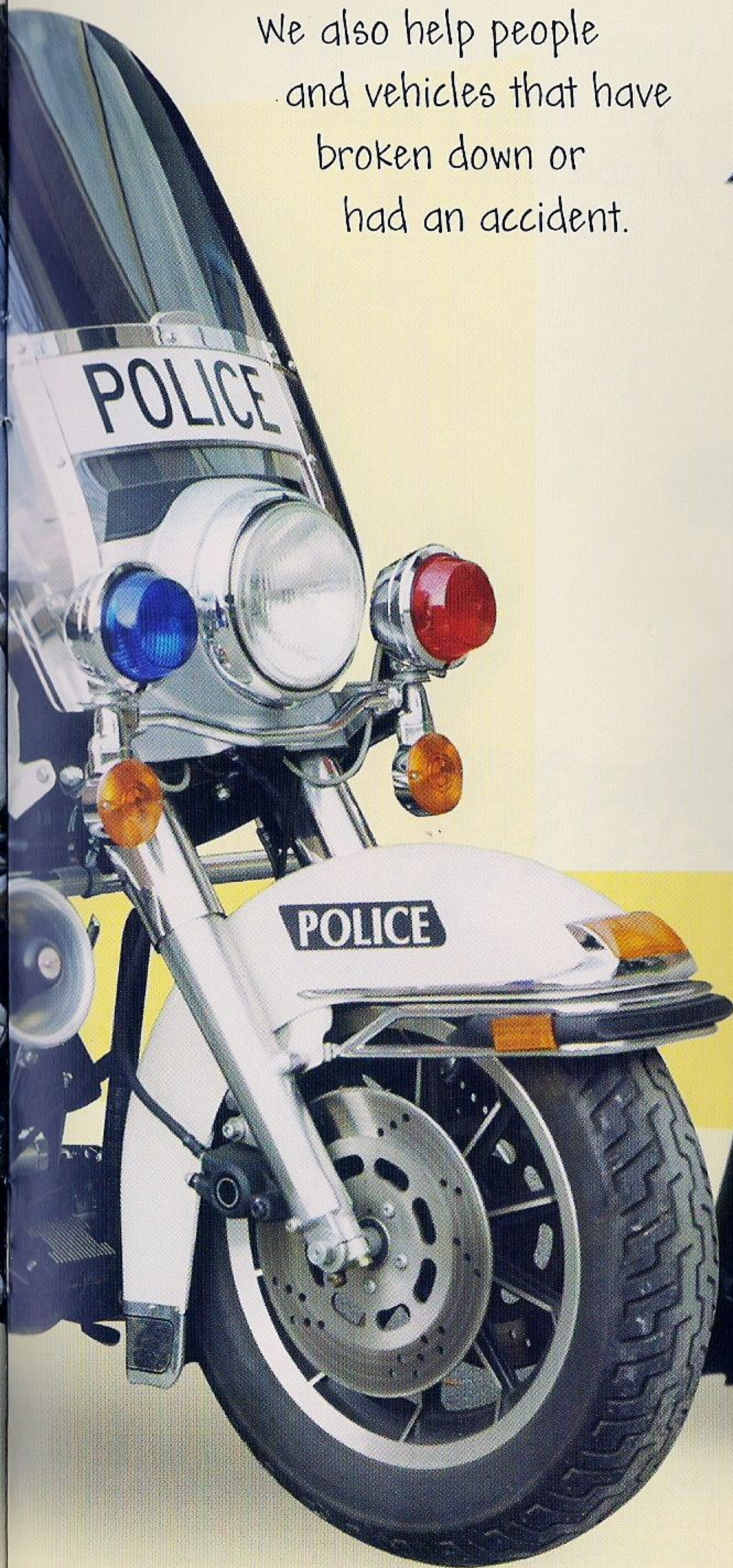

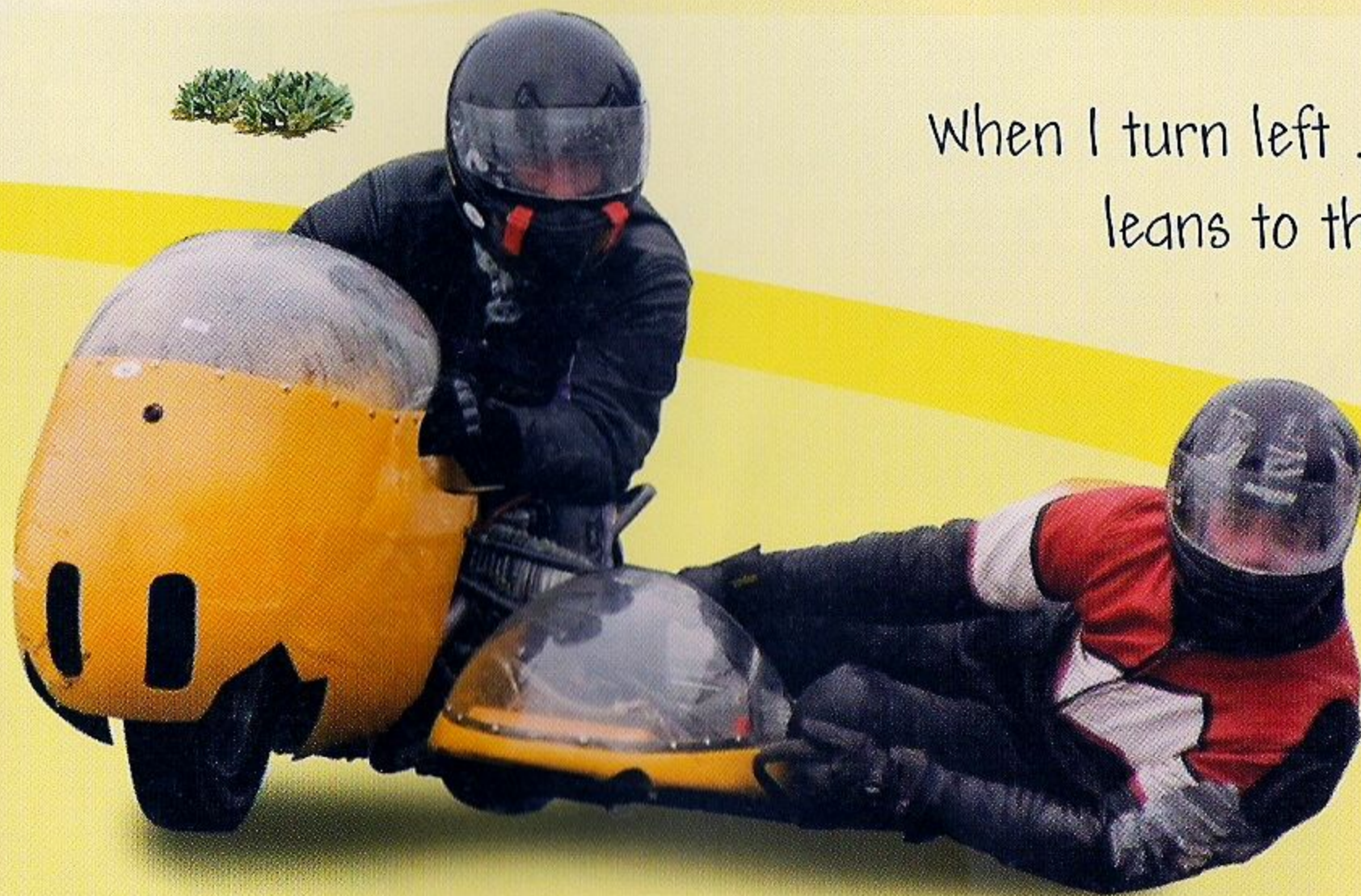
I carry two people, my driver, or pilot, and my passenger.

My driver sits over my engine and steers with my handlebars.

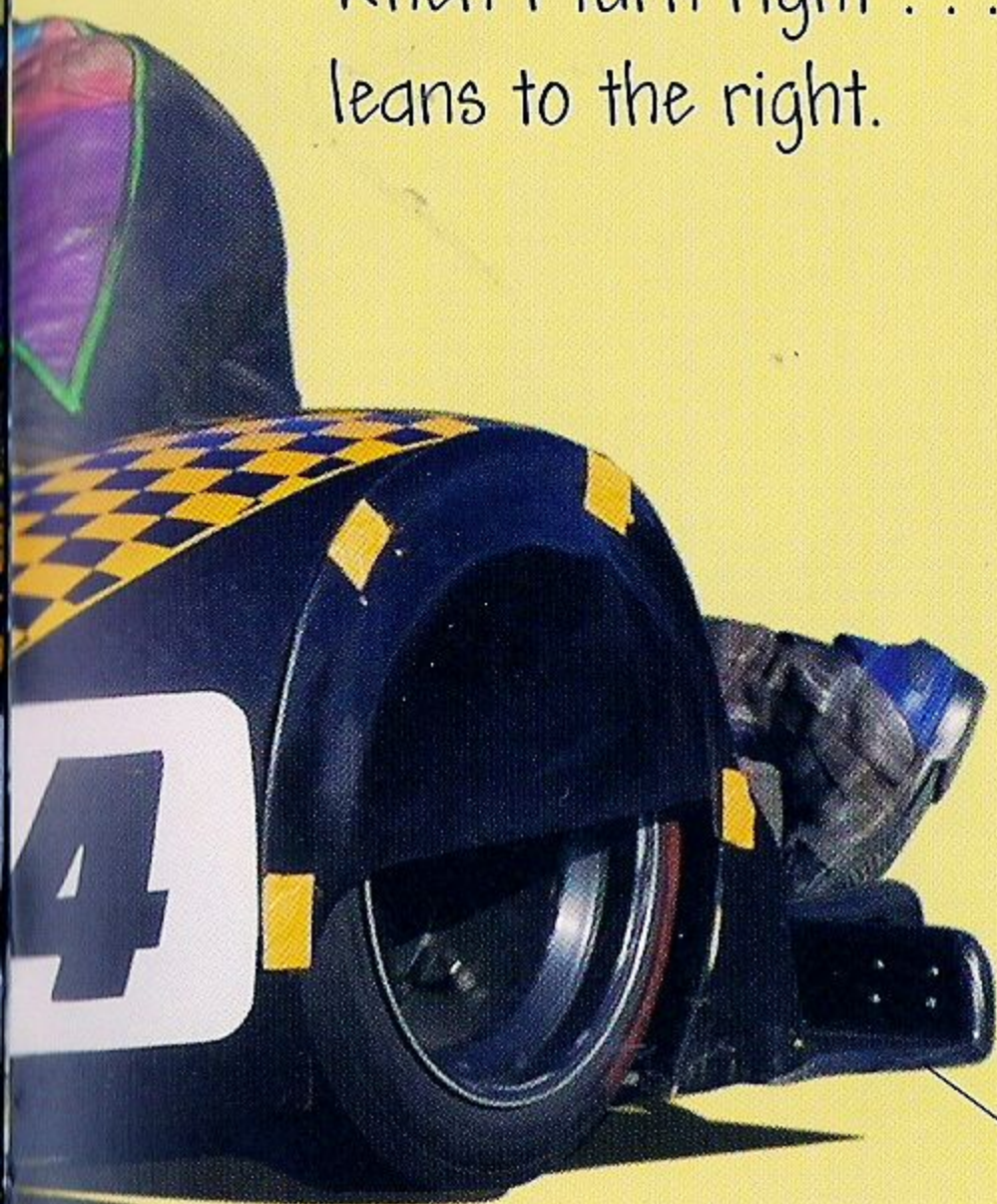
My passenger kneels on my sidecar platform and leans from side to side.

When I turn right . . . he leans to the right.



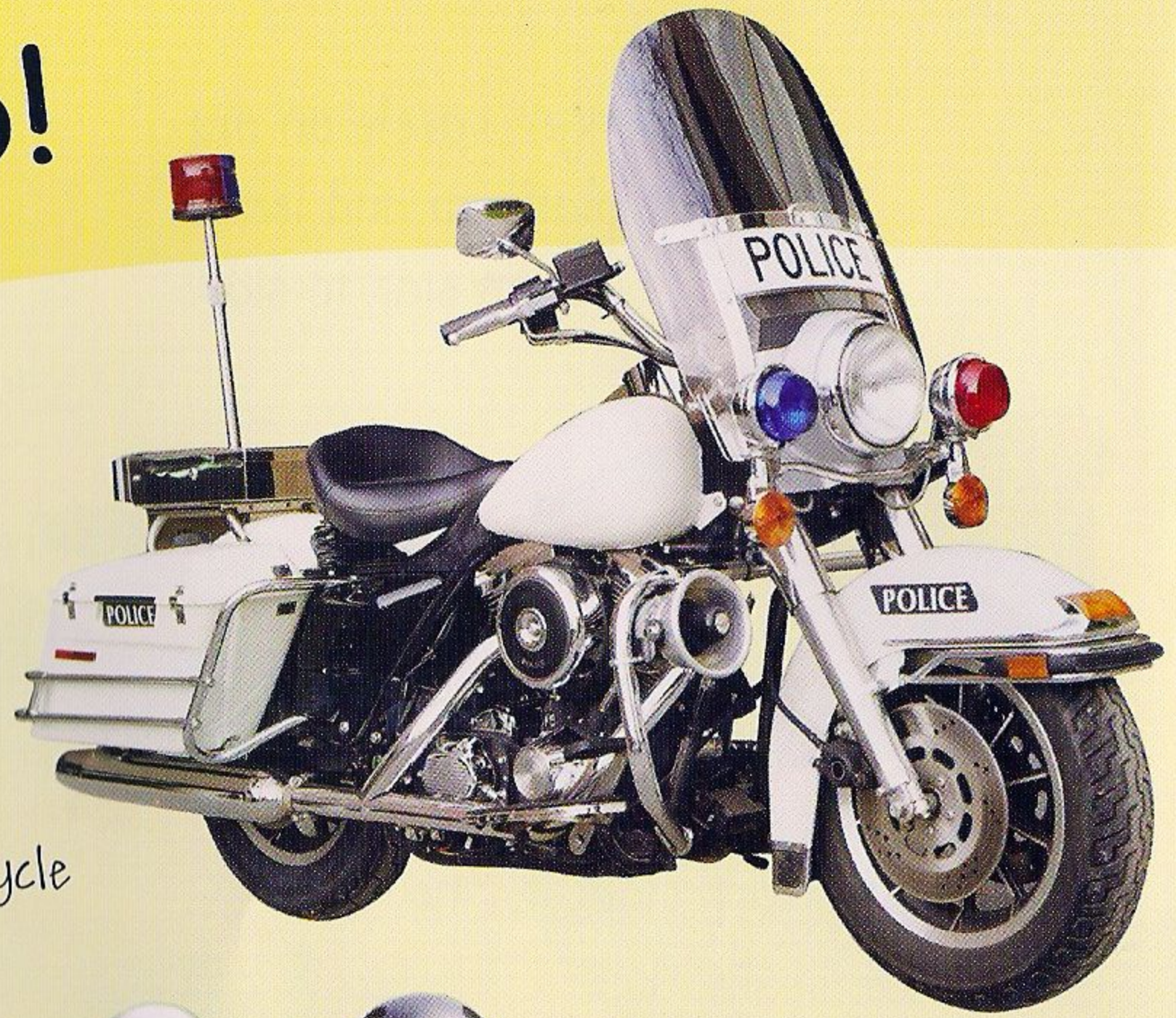
That's how I can fly around corners at 150 miles per hour!

SIDECAR PLATFORM

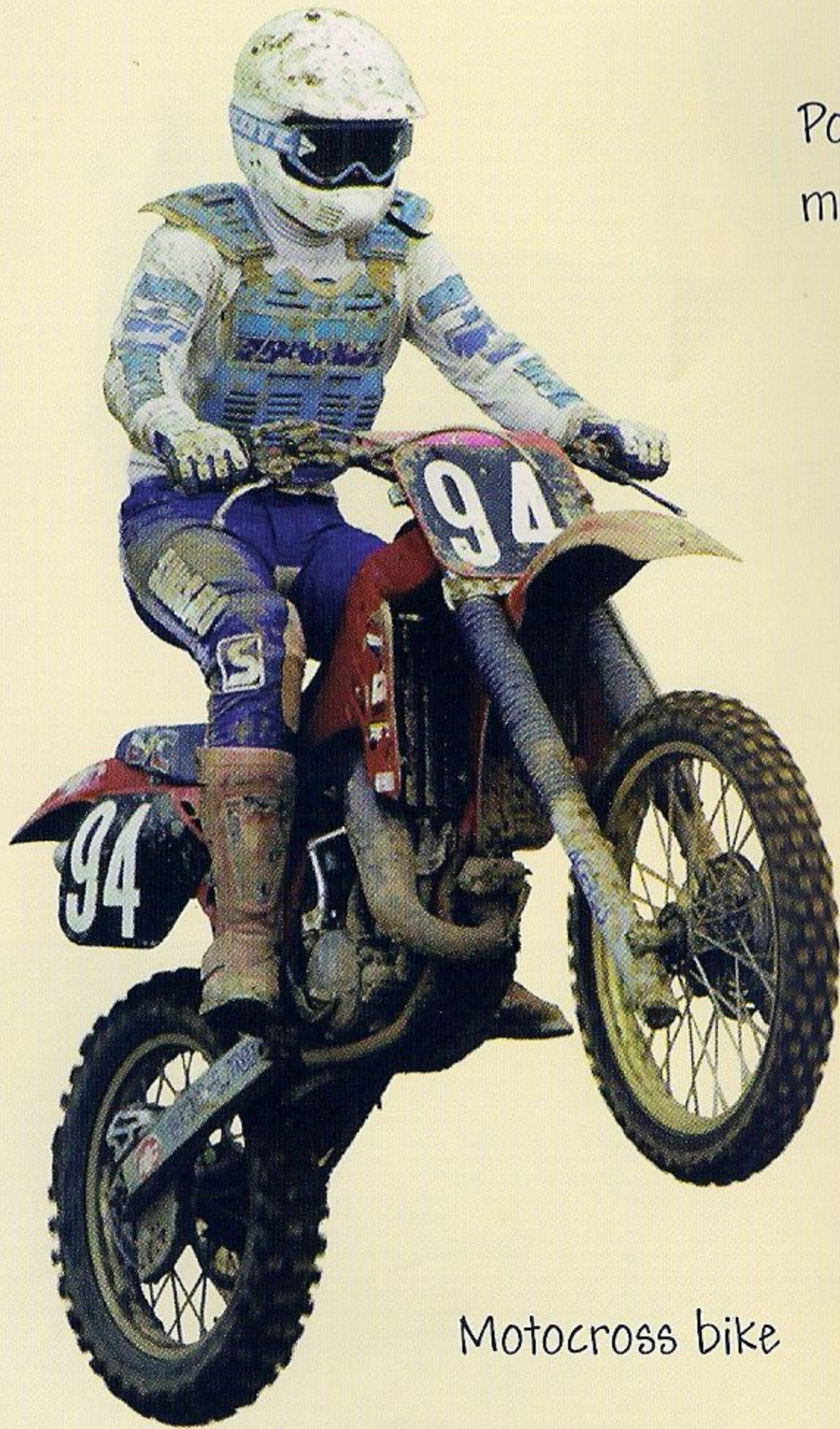
This road motorcycle and sidecar goes much slower than I do. Do you know why?



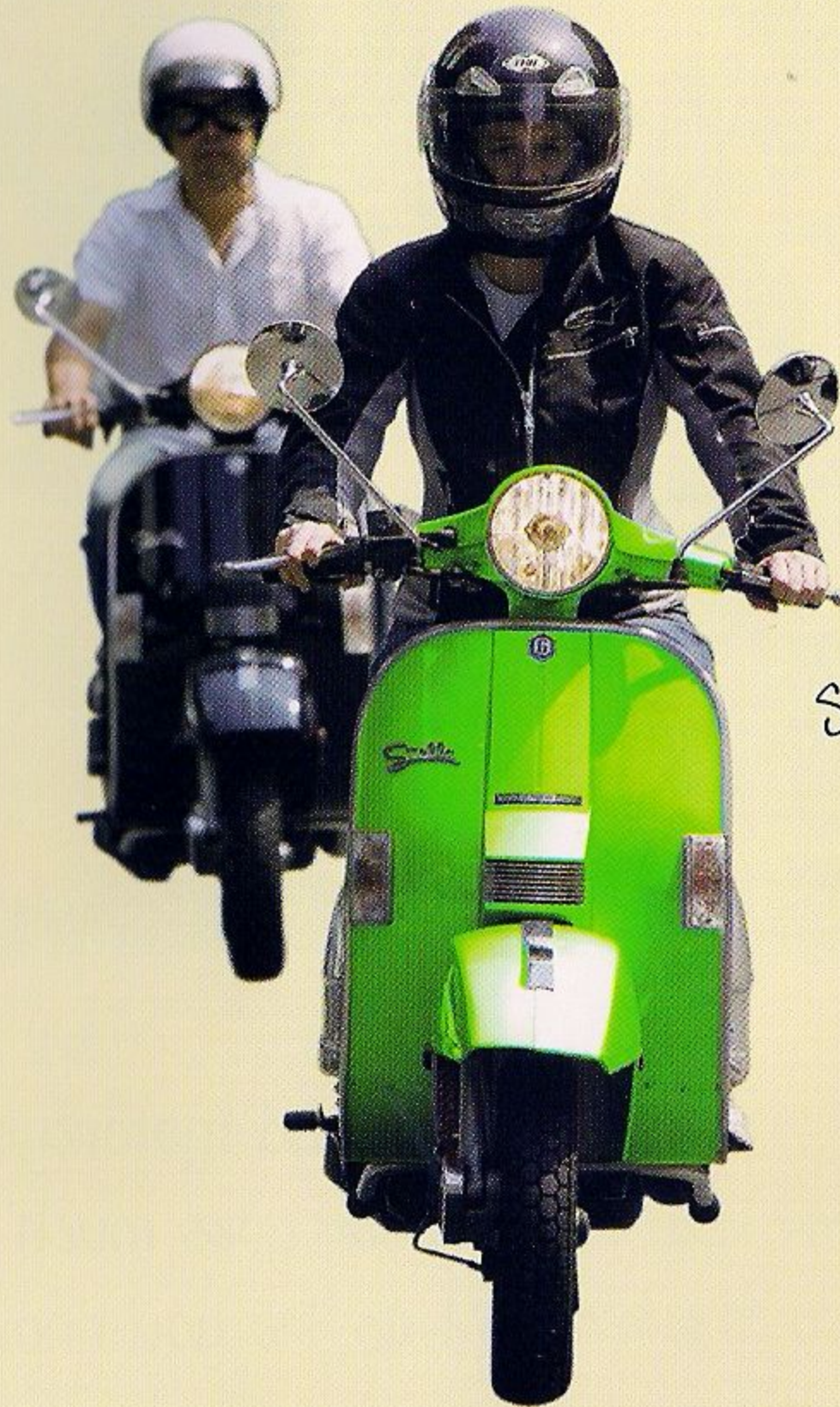
