

Do you think you could fly a Podracer?







This desert racetrack has lots of twists and turns.

are very dangerous.




The pilot who reaches the end of the race first is the winner.




Many people come to watch the Podraces.

They are excited to see the race. They want to find out which racer will win.





Podracing is very dangerous.

He also cheats in the race because he is not very nice.




Sebulba sometimes throws his tools at the other pilots.


He is a very dangerous racer.




To help you to read difficult words, try saying out loud the spelling in BIG TYPE. Sebulba is SAY-BULL-BAH.



Pilots prepare their machines for the race in a big garage called a hangar.






Today is one of the most exciting Podraces ever.

Anakin's family and friends are going to watch him race.






The pilots are on the starting line.
