Level 1: Beginning to read

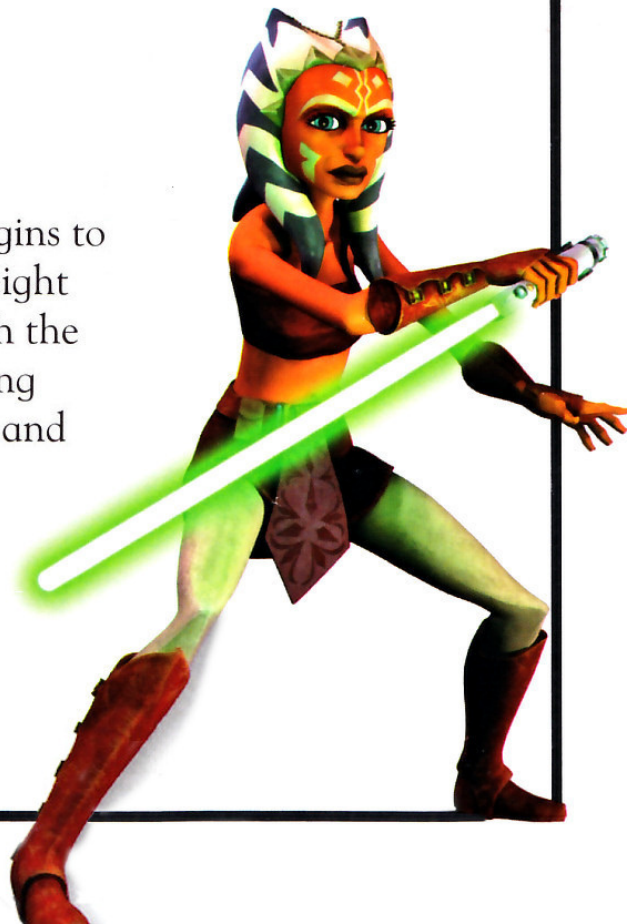
Level 2: Beginning to read alone

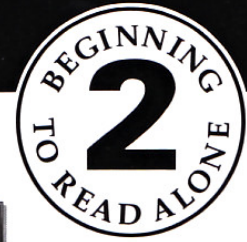

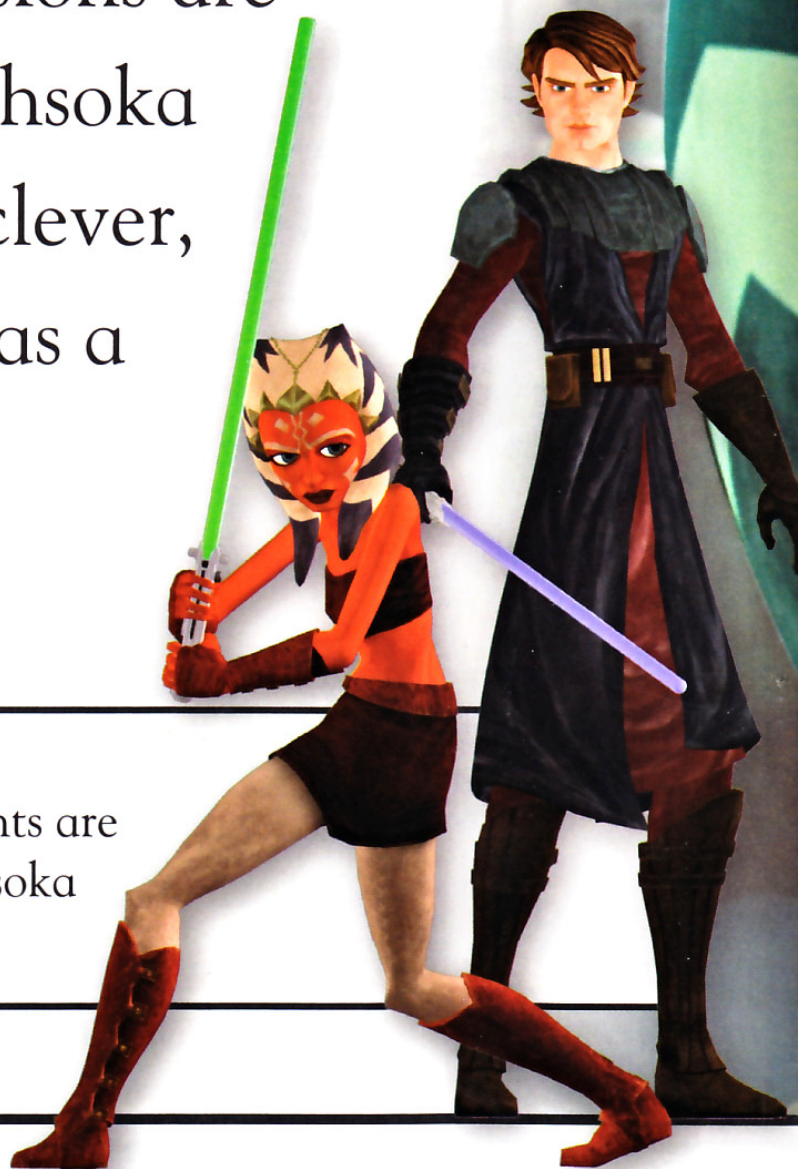

Anakin's missions are dangerous. Ahsoka is brave and clever, but she still has a lot to learn.

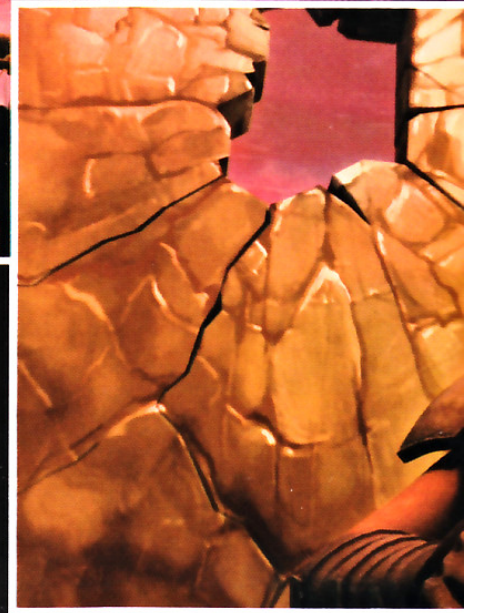
Padawan

his life.

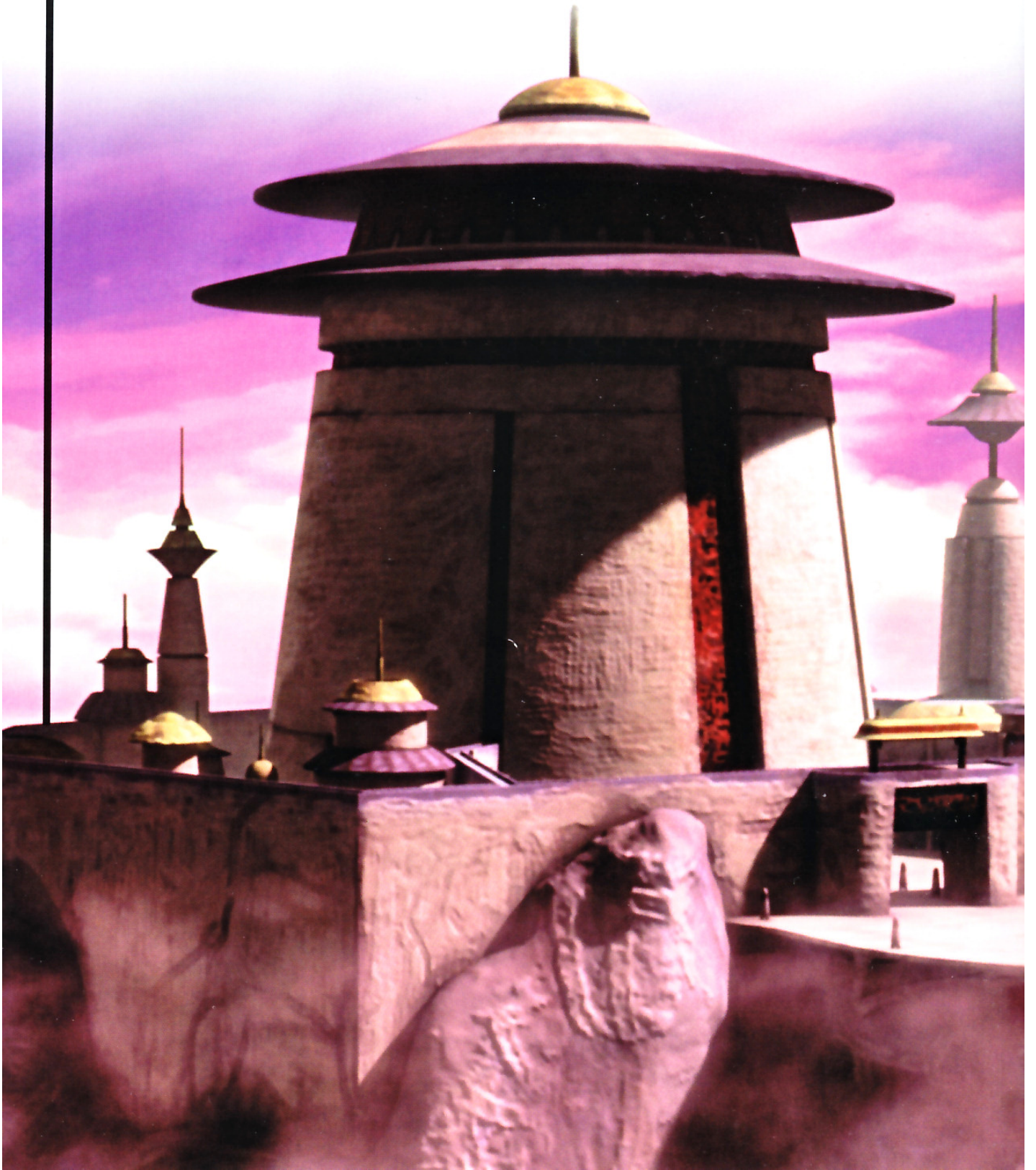


Anakin is surrounded

When Ahsoka and Anakin find Rotta, he is already sick and needs medicine.



Hutts

Jabba the Hutt is a greedy and powerful criminal. He controls an important part of space that the Jedi would like to fly in.





Someone else has arrived at the castle. It is Asajj (Ah-SARGE) Ventress, an enemy of the Jedi. Ahsoka must escape.



Ventress

Ventress works for the Separatists, the enemy of the Jedi. She is an assassin and her mission is to kill all Jedi.

Ahsoka has to defend herself against Ventress before Anakin comes to rescue her and Rotta on a flying creature.



Ahsoka and Anakin return to Jabba's planet with Rotta. Ahsoka has given Rotta some medicine and he is feeling better.

Jabba is very pleased to see his son safe and well. He thanks Ahsoka and Anakin for their help.



Ahsoka and Anakin receive a message that Jedi Plo Koon is in trouble. He has been attacked by the enemy and must defend himself against battle droids.

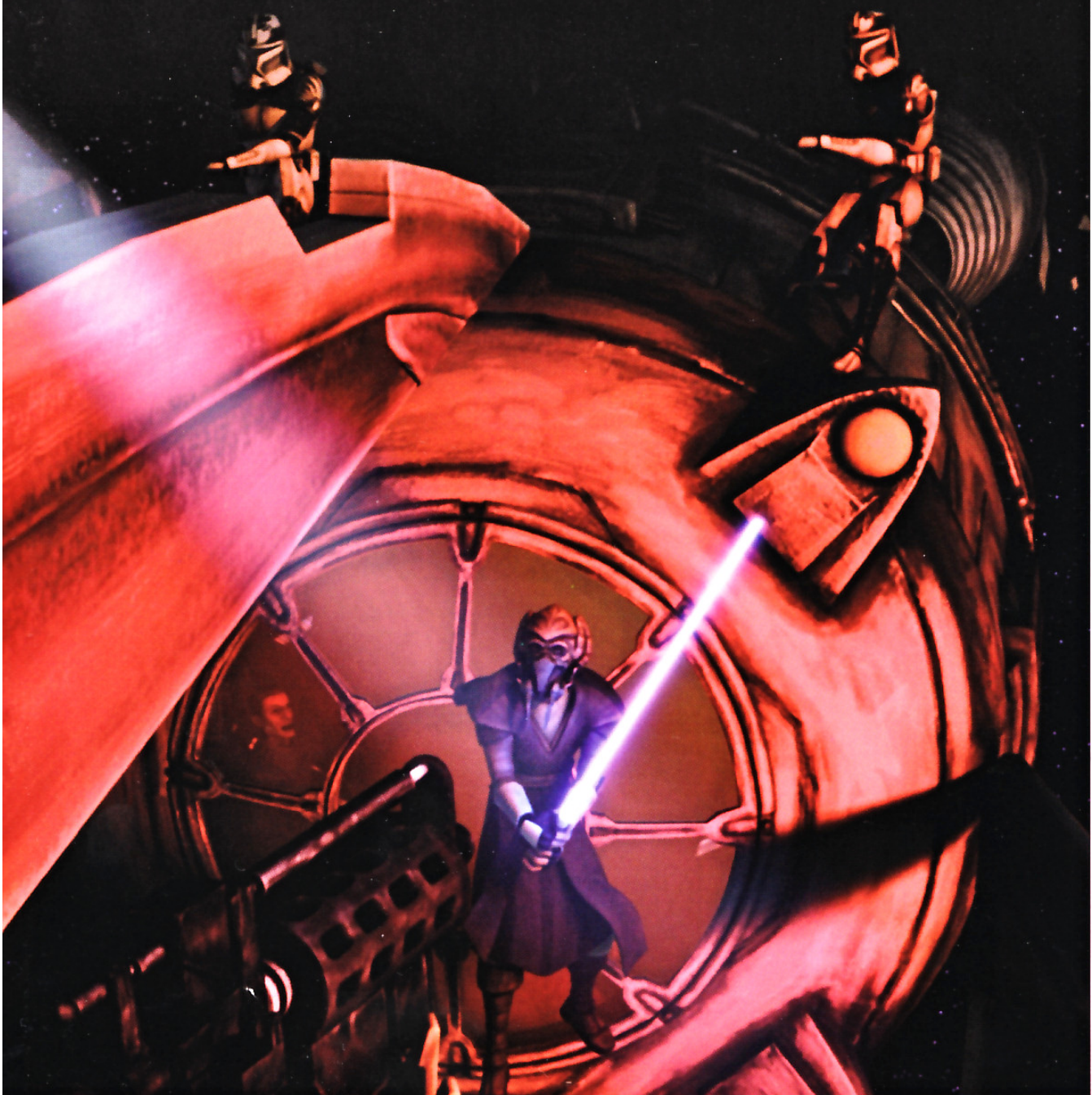


Plo Koon

Plo Koon is a Jedi Master. He is from the planet Dorin. He is a very brave and clever Jedi.



The Jedi leaders tell Anakin and Ahsoka they cannot go to the rescue. Ahsoka's Jedi instincts tell her she must go to help him.



Ahsoka and Anakin go to find Plo Koon and they are just in time! Ahsoka's Jedi instincts were right and Plo Koon is still alive.



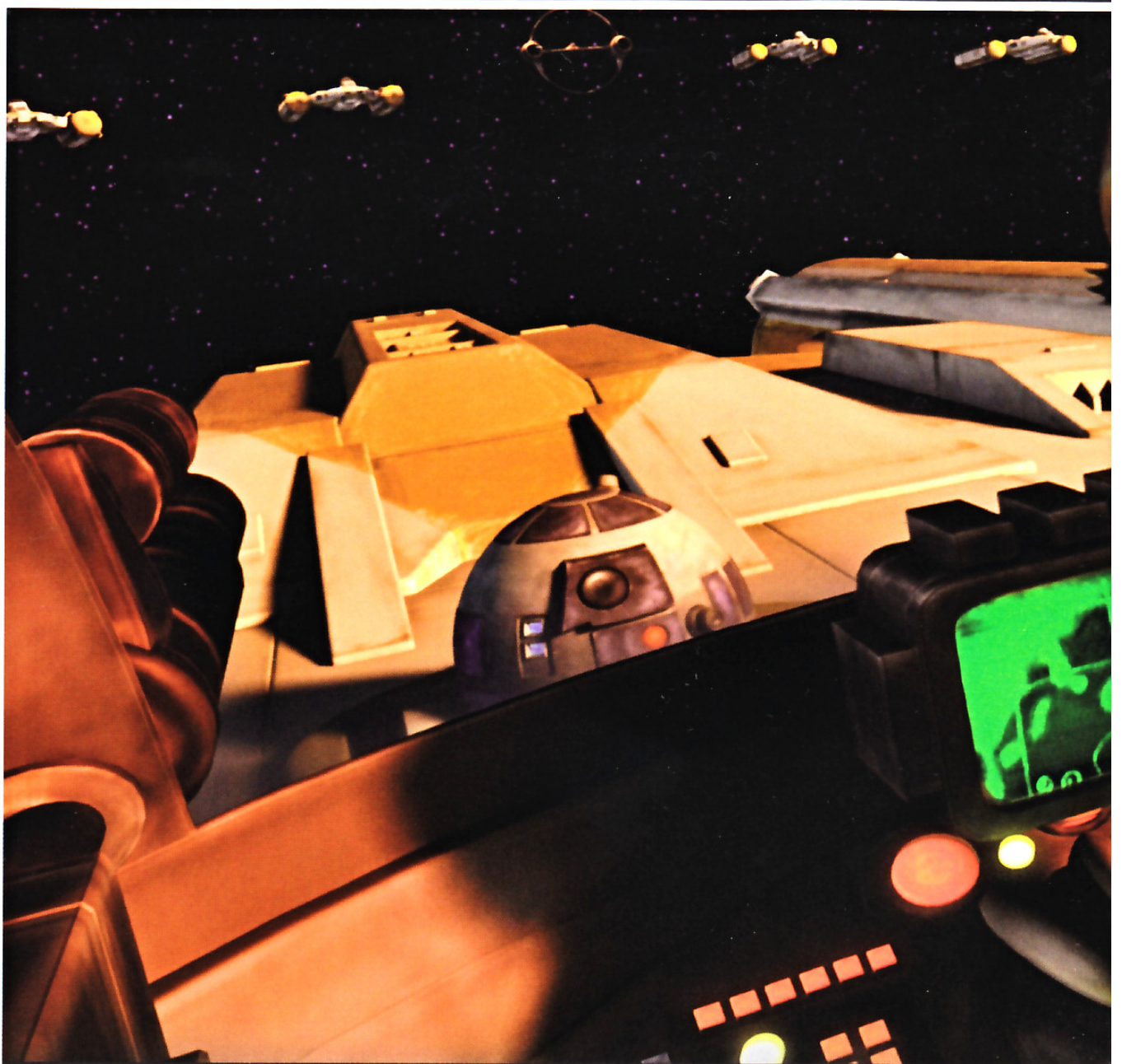
Ahsoka is very happy to see her old friend. She is glad she trusted her Jedi instincts and disobeyed the Jedi leaders.



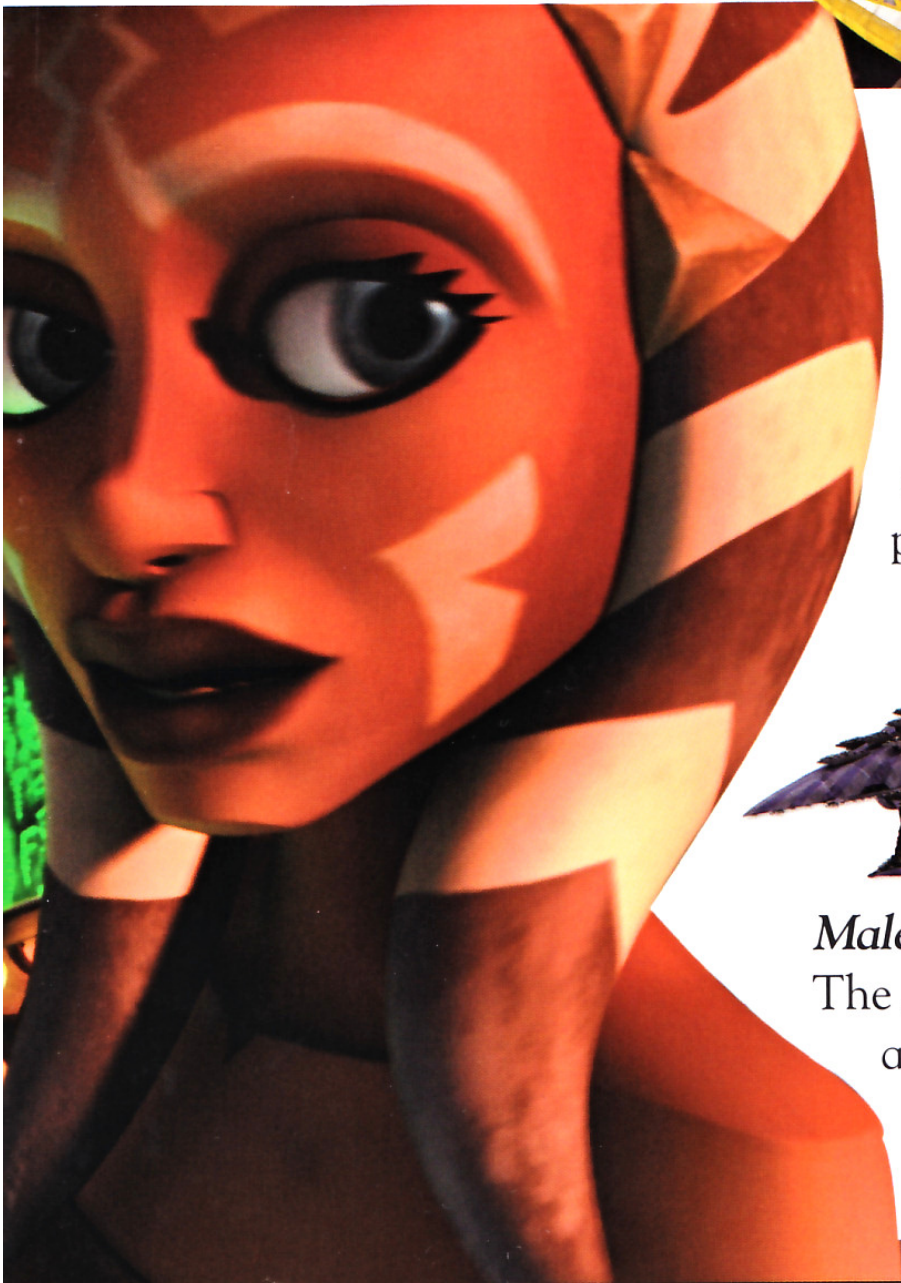
Jedi instincts

Jedi feel strongly if something is right or wrong, or safe or not safe. Their feelings are connected to the Force.





Now Ahsoka and Anakin must destroy the *Malevolence*, the enemy ship that attacked Plo Koon. Anakin has a risky plan to attack the ship's bridge.



Y-Wing
Y-wings are spaceships that are fast and powerful.



Malevolence
The *Malevolence* is a deadly enemy ship with a secret weapon.

Anakin's team of Y-wings fly into battle but some are shot down. Ahsoka thinks they need a new plan. They attack the secret weapon instead. It is a success!

When Anakin's droid, R2-D2, goes missing after a space battle, Anakin is sent a new droid. Ahsoka welcomes the new droid, who is called R3-S6.



R2-D2

R2-D2 is an astromech droid. He helps Anakin to fly his spaceship and to do any repairs he needs.



Ahsoka tells Anakin that R3 droids are better than R2 droids, but Anakin wants to find R2-D2. They think R2-D2 is on an enemy base, so they go to investigate.





At the enemy base, another Jedi enemy called General Grievous (GREEVE-us) suddenly appears. He attacks Ahsoka, but she hides in the shadows.





R3-S6 shines a light on Ahsoka.
R3-S6 is a traitor and a spy for
Grievous! Luckily, Ahsoka gets
away. Anakin finds R2-D2 and
they all escape the enemy base.



Ahsoka goes on a mission with Jedi Master Luminara. They are taking a prisoner to stand trial. The prisoner's name is Nute Gunray. He knows a lot of enemy secrets, which the Jedi want to learn.





Ahsoka threatens Nute so he will tell them the secrets. Luminara doesn't like Ahsoka threatening Nute and tells her to stop. Ahsoka doesn't like being told what to do.



Ventress and the droid army
attack the Jedi ship.

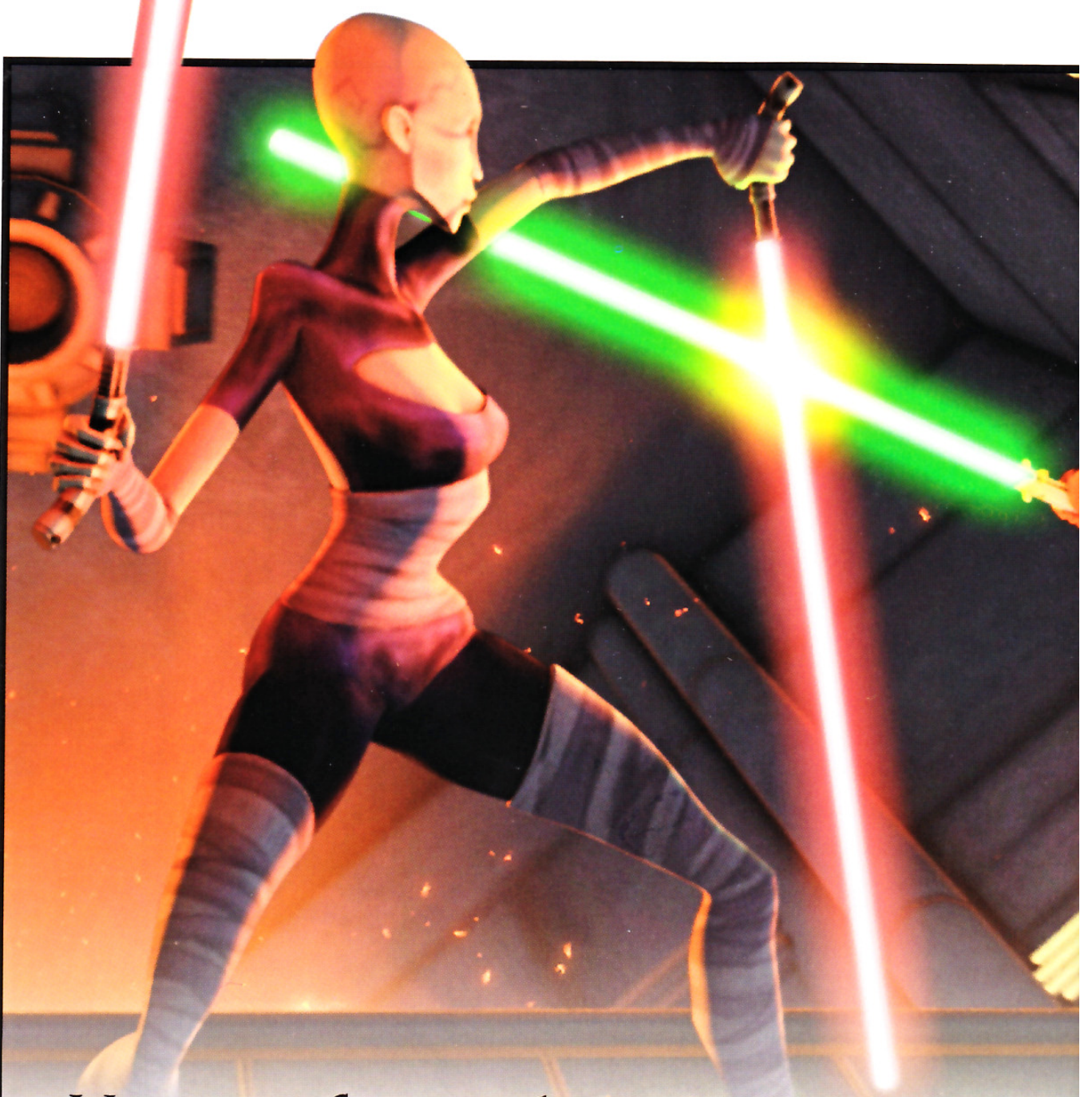


Ventress has come

Nute Gunray free.

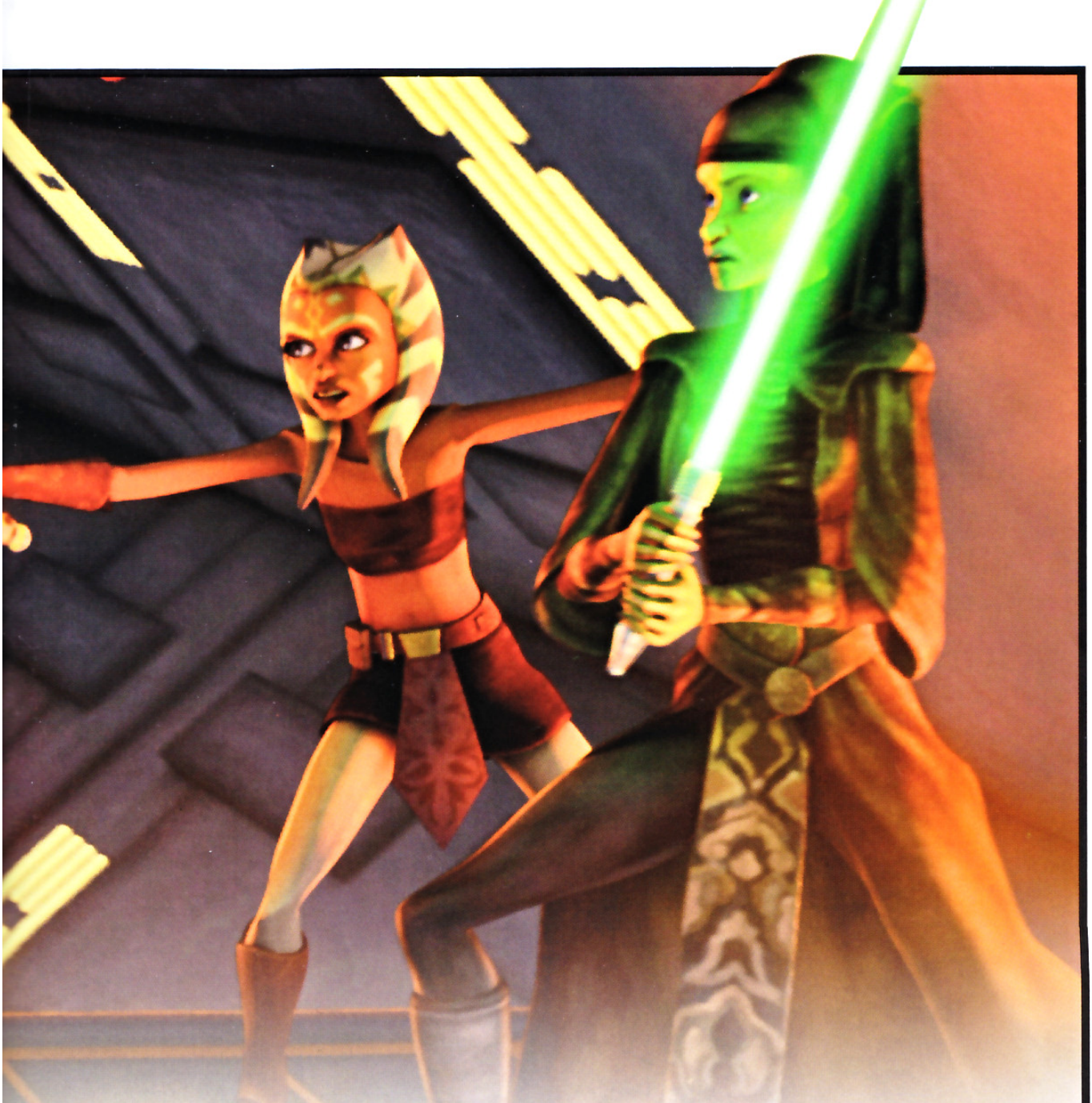


Ventress kicks Ahsoka into Gunray's cell. Gunray gloats as Ahsoka is now a prisoner and not him. Luminara's Jedi instincts tell her that Ahsoka is in danger and she races back to the cell block.



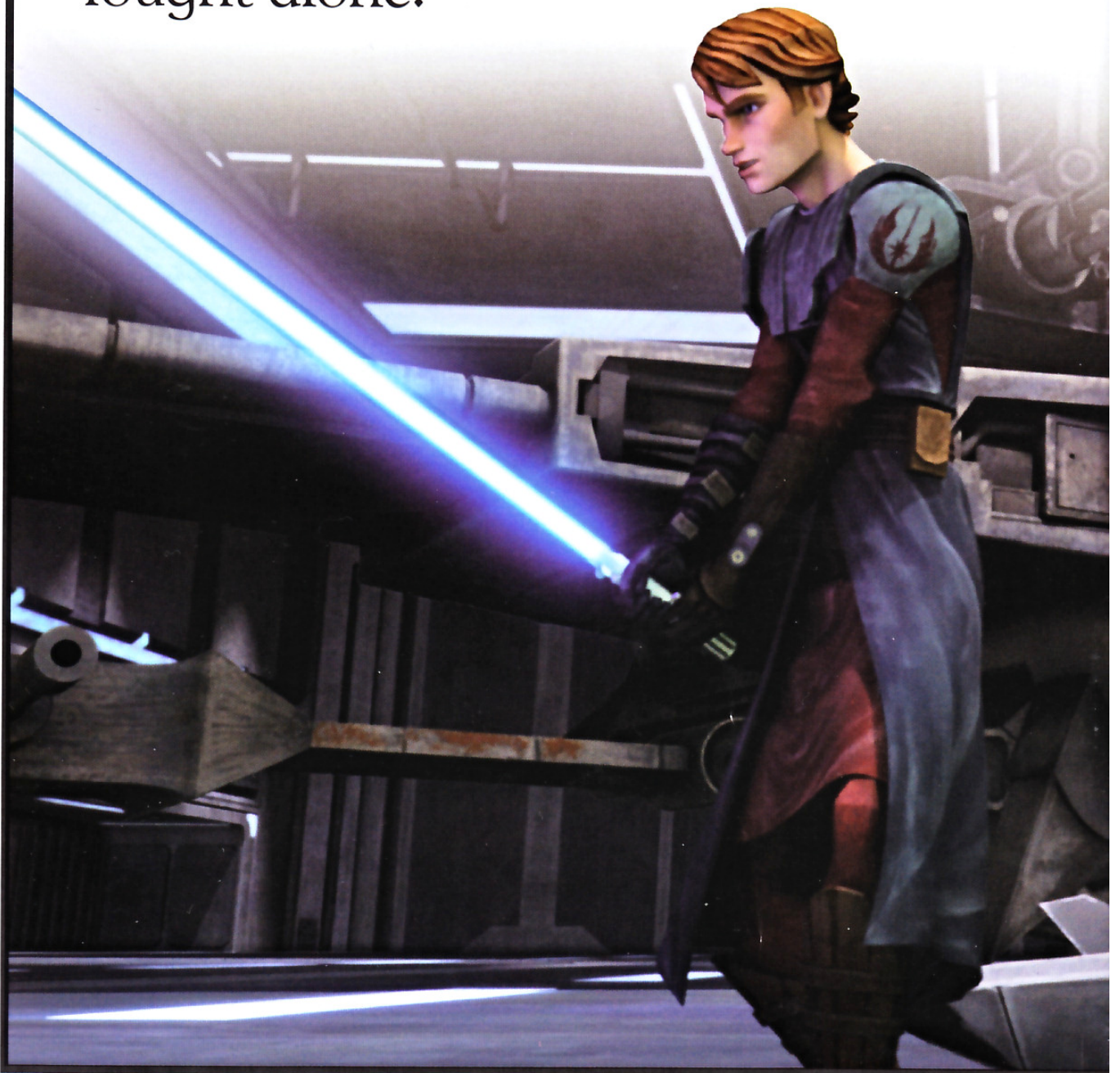


Ventress flees without Nute as Luminara returns. Luminara lets Ahsoka out of her cell and puts Nute back in prison. She tells Ahsoka to stay and guard Nute while she deals with Ventress alone.



Ahsoka wants to help Luminara, so she leaves her post. She arrives just in time to save Luminara! The attack Ventress together, but she escapes with Nute! Luminara thanks Ahsoka for saving her life.

Ahsoka has learned a lot.
She has learned to trust her
Jedi instincts. She has learned that
the Jedi's enemies are dangerous
and that they cannot be
fought alone.



She has learned to work as a team with the other Jedi. Most of all, she has learned that she has what it takes to become a great Jedi Knight!




