The painters are finished—there's paint on their clothes And a big drop of paint on the fat painter's nose!








































In the first car are the lions.

While they're eating dinner, they think about all the circus animals eating dinner.




After dinner, they get ready for bed.

Look at all the people rushing down the street! Where are they all going, rushing down the street?




Mothers and fathers with children and babies,

Look at all the people waiting on the street! Why are they all standing, waiting on the street?



















Huey, Dewey, and Louie go to buy tickets for the circus.




When it's Huey's turn, he buys three tickets.








Huey decides to buy some popcorn.






Louie decides to buy a balloon.

What's wrong with this picture?



































Look at the hippo's bottom swing!

Two by two, they bow to you, And then they dance some more!




They turn together.
























Look! Everyone is dancing and having a good time!
