




Frog was hot, too. He saw Mouse in the pool. "Is it cool in the pool?" said Frog.

"Yes," said Mouse.


"Jump in."




Then Dog saw

"Jump into the pool," said Frog.




"Jump in," said Pig. Goat looked at the pool. "I am hot," he said. "It looks cool in the pool."
