The girls wanted to go skating.



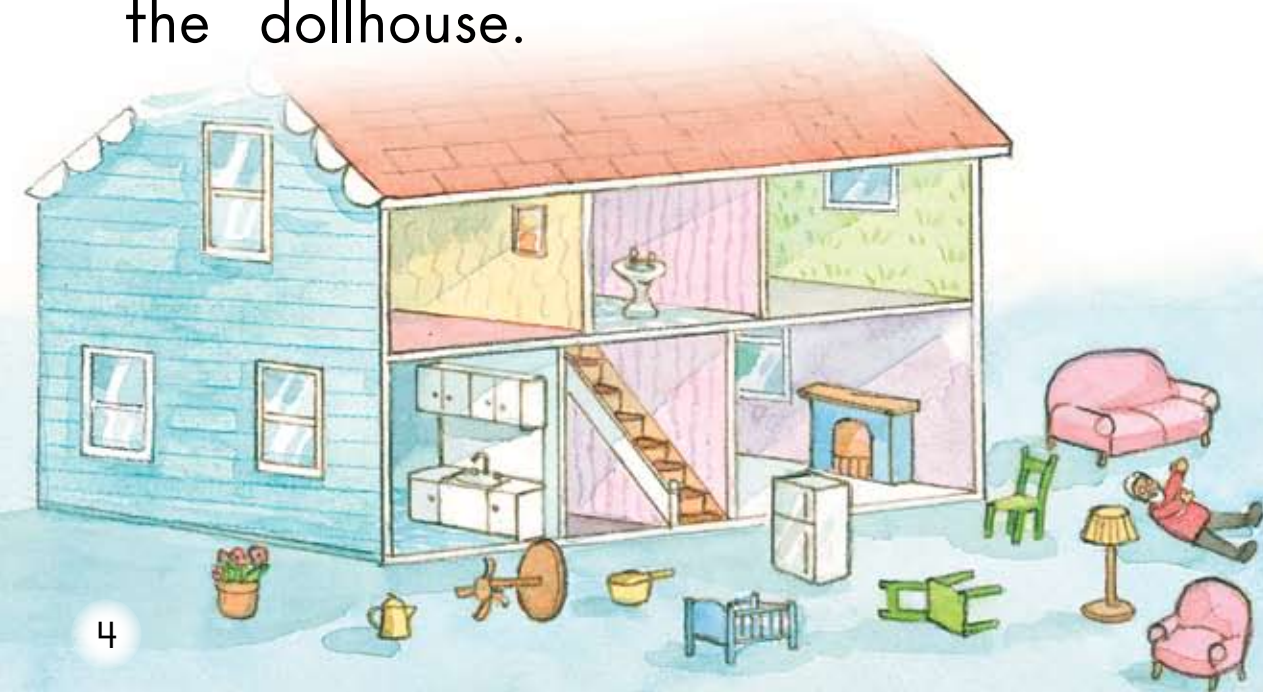
“Your room is a big mess,”

and clean up," said Kim.

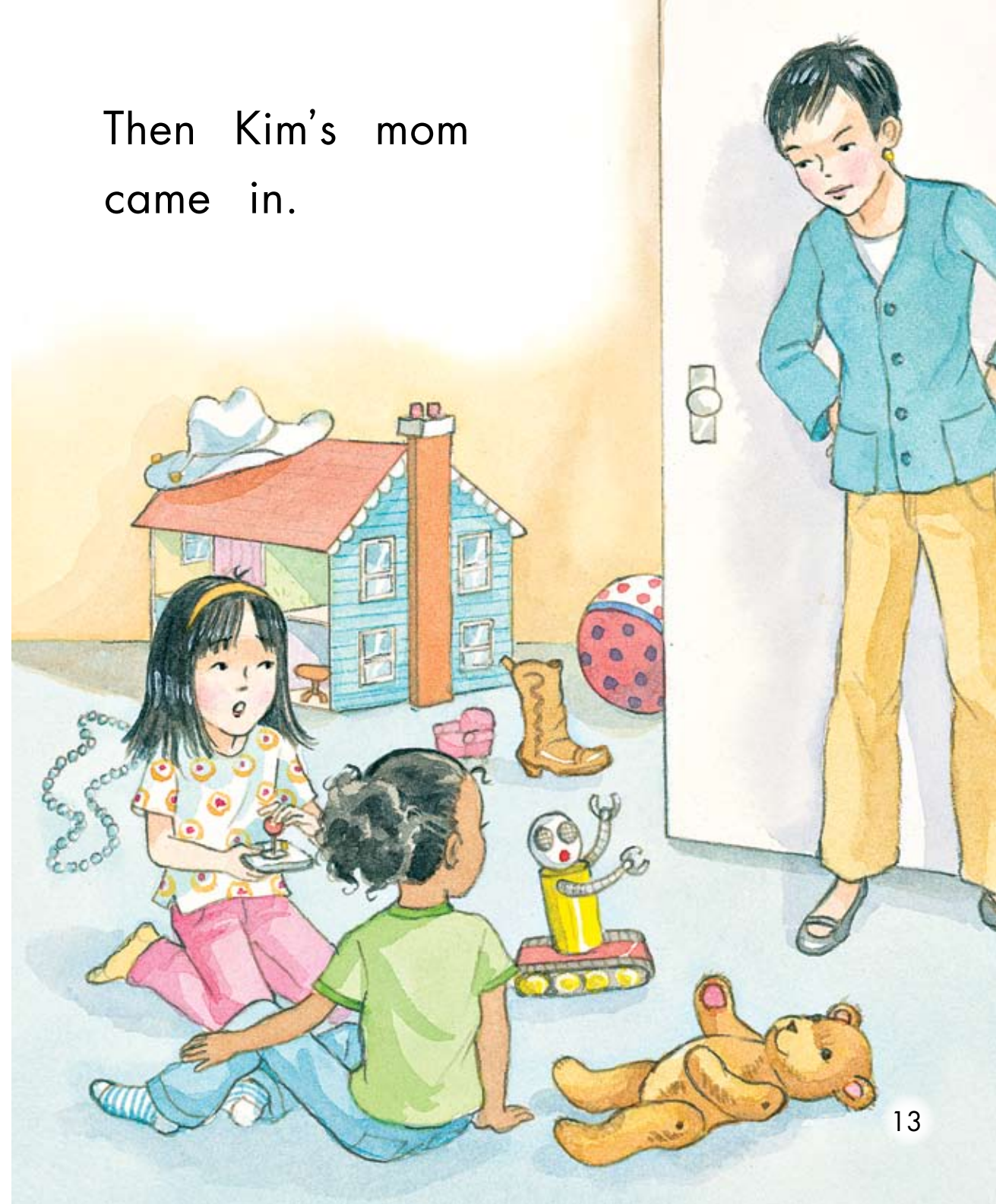


Lizzy picked up a little robot.
