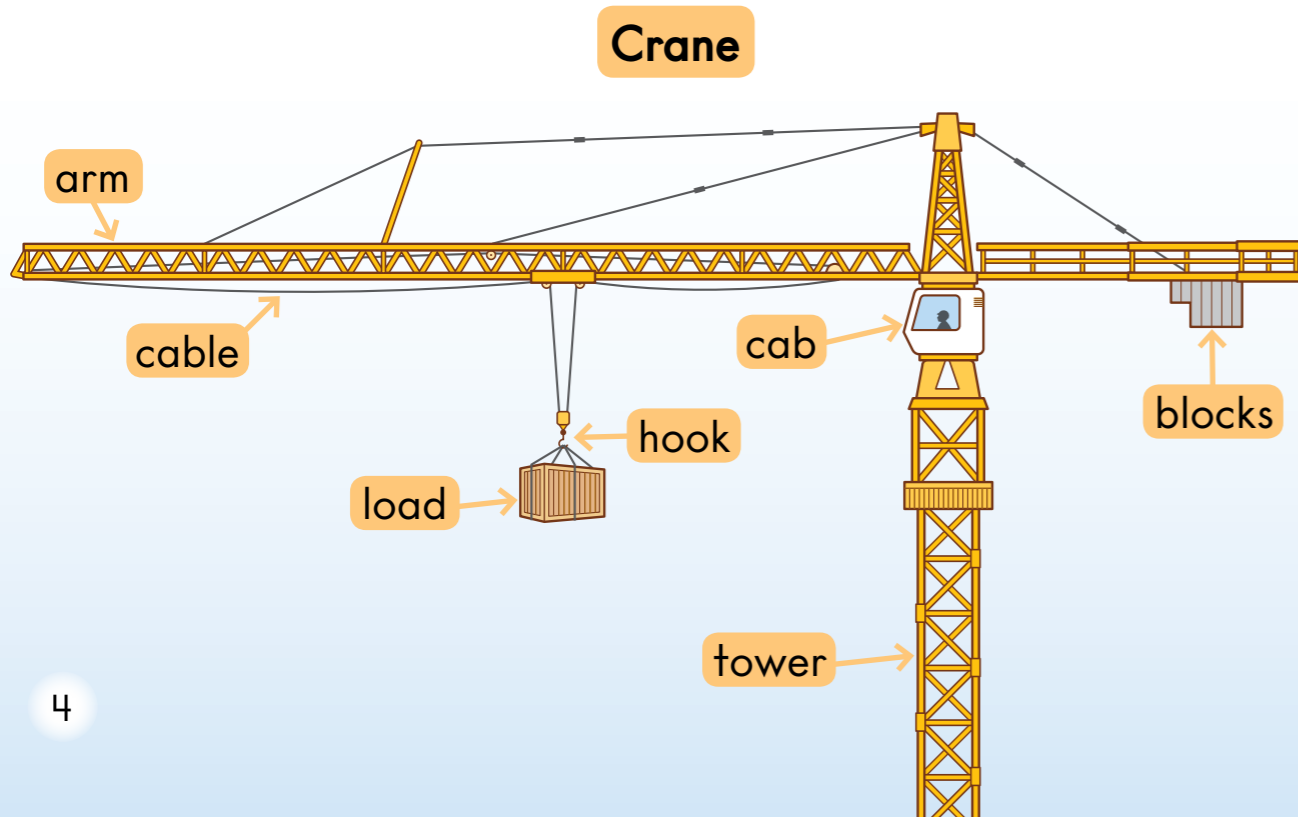

The **arm** on a crane can move up and down and left and right. The arm has big **blocks** at one end. The blocks keep the crane from tipping over as it lifts things.

A crane driver sits in the **cab**.
The cab is up on the crane's arm.
The driver can see the job well
from up there.
