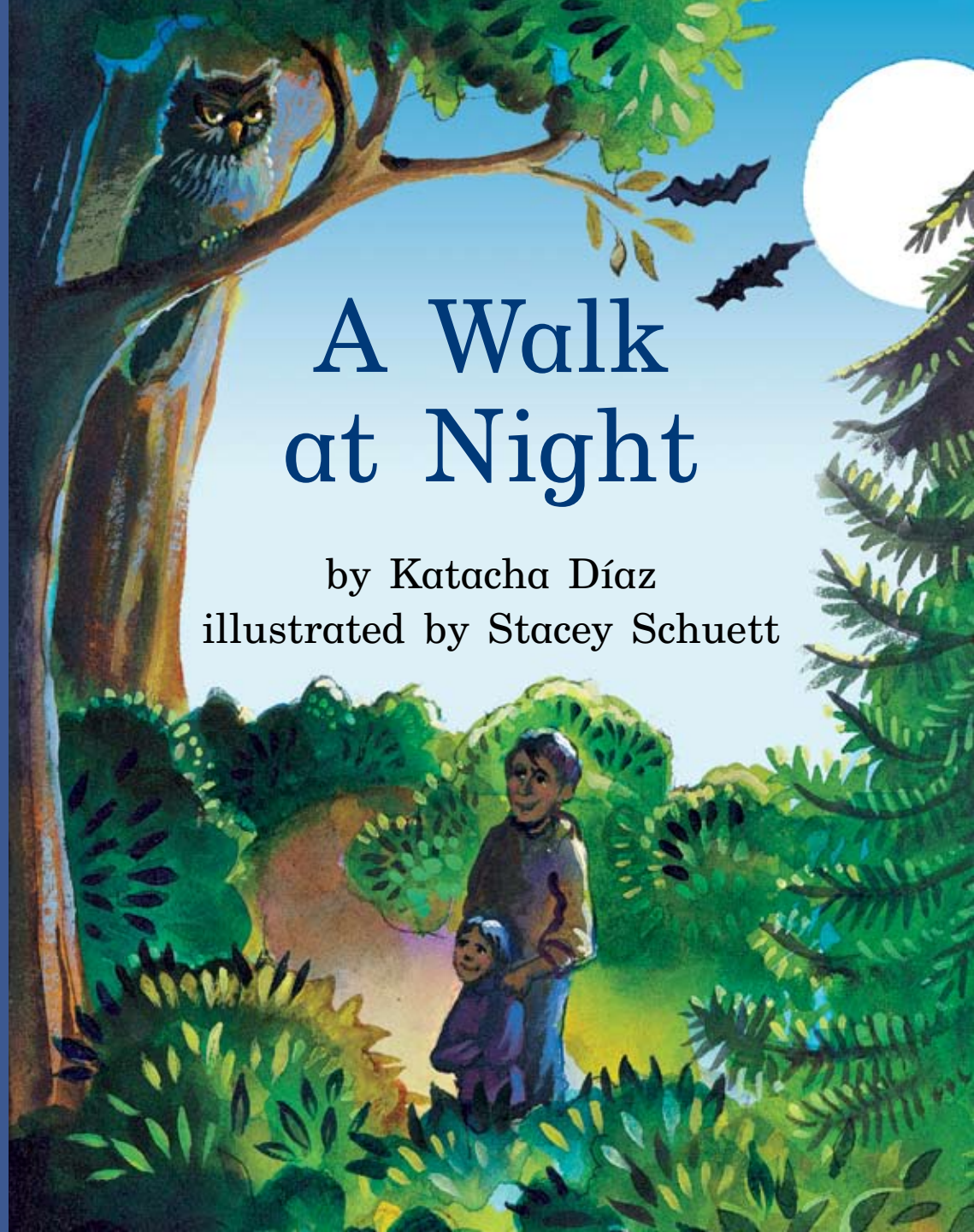

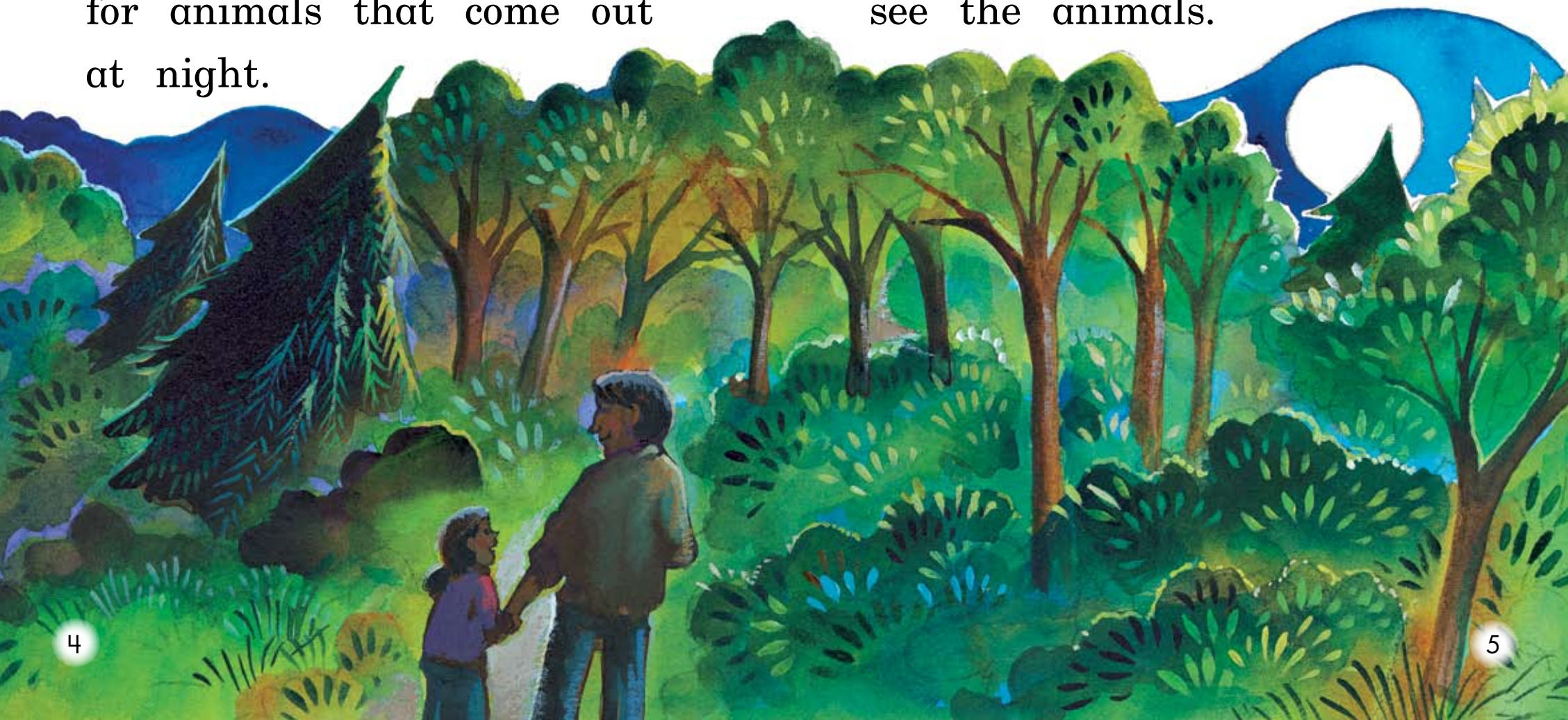


It is night

see the animals.



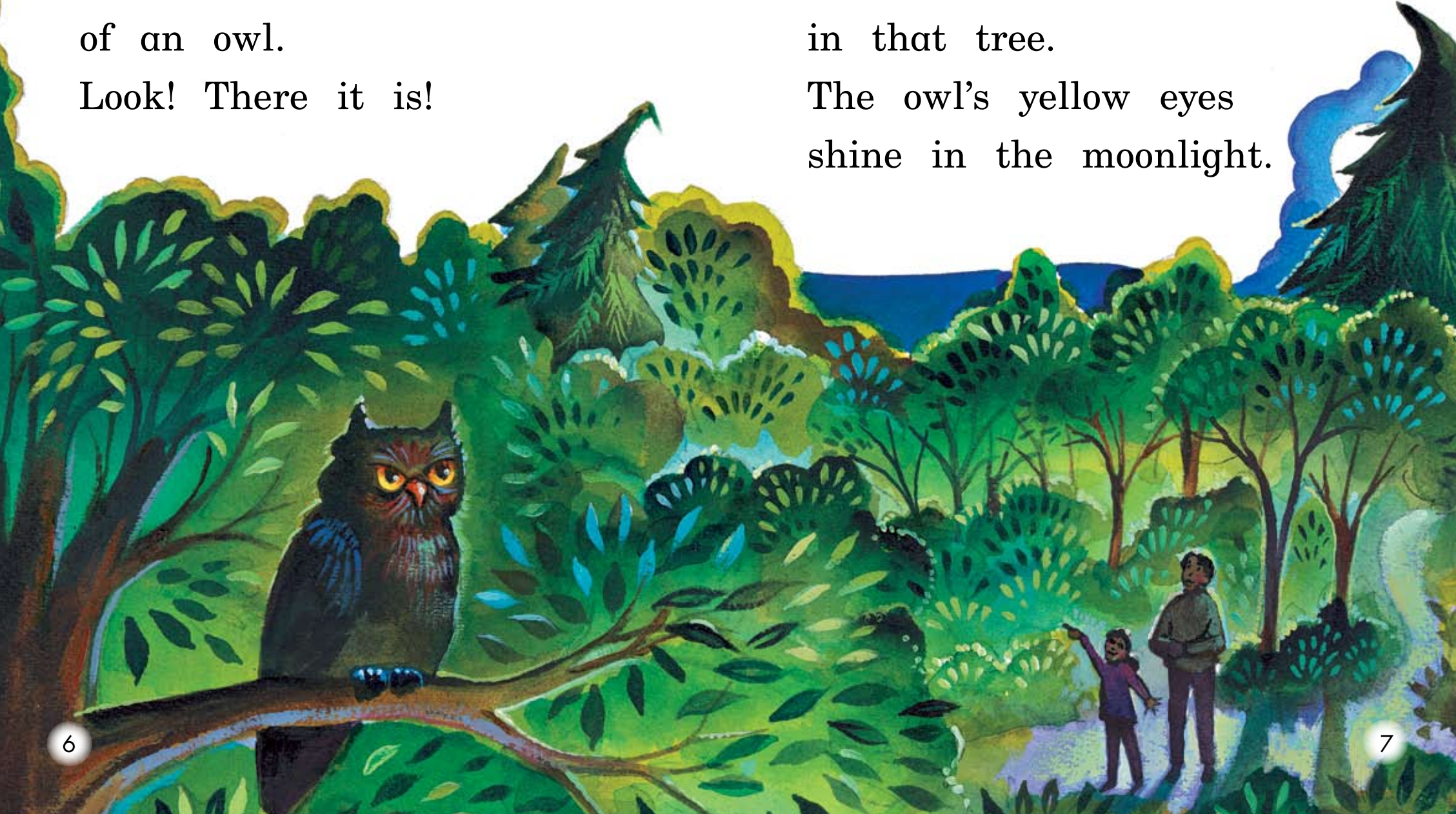
Listen to the “Hoot, Hoot”

Look! There it is!

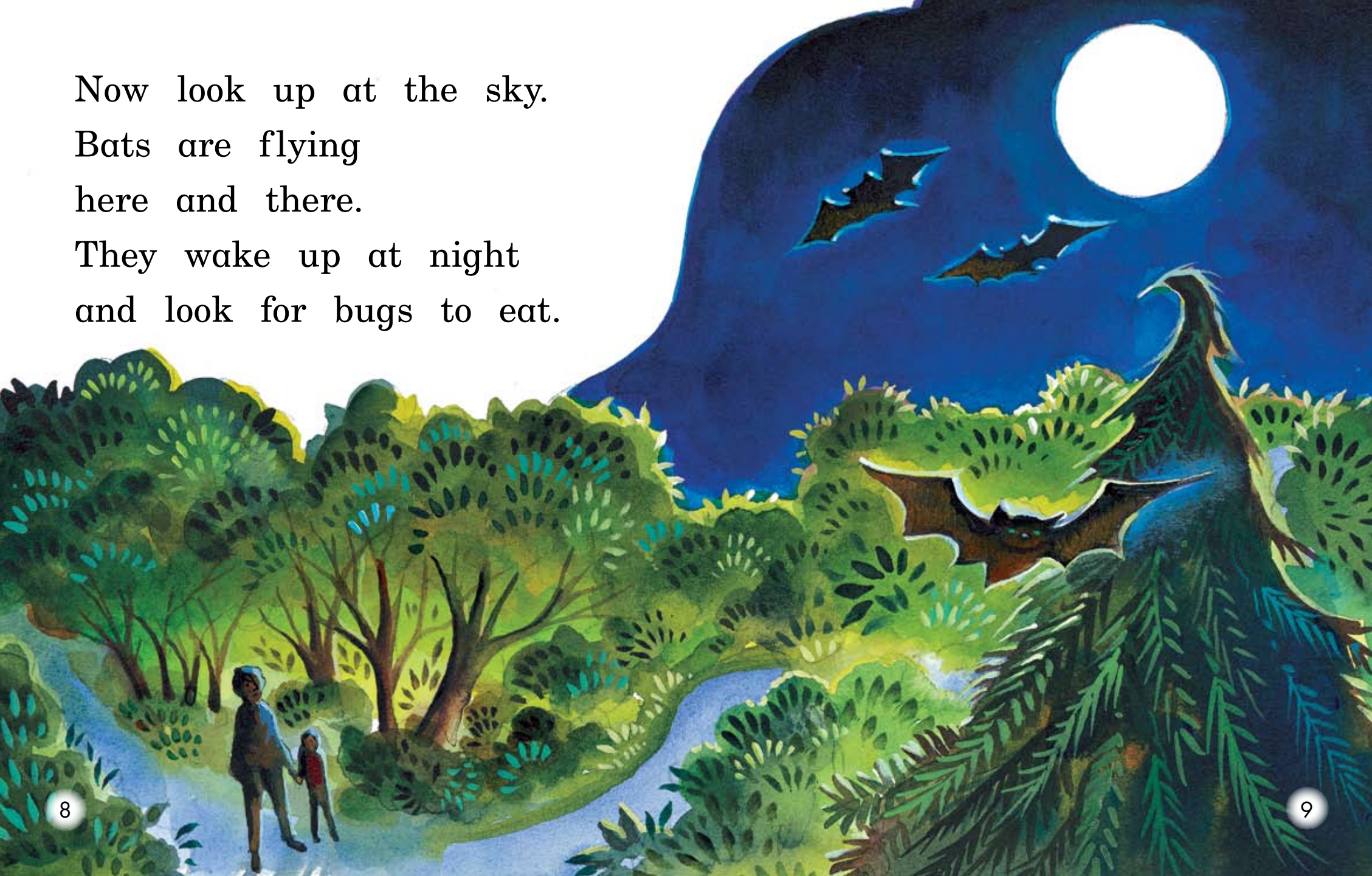
The owl is up

in that tree.

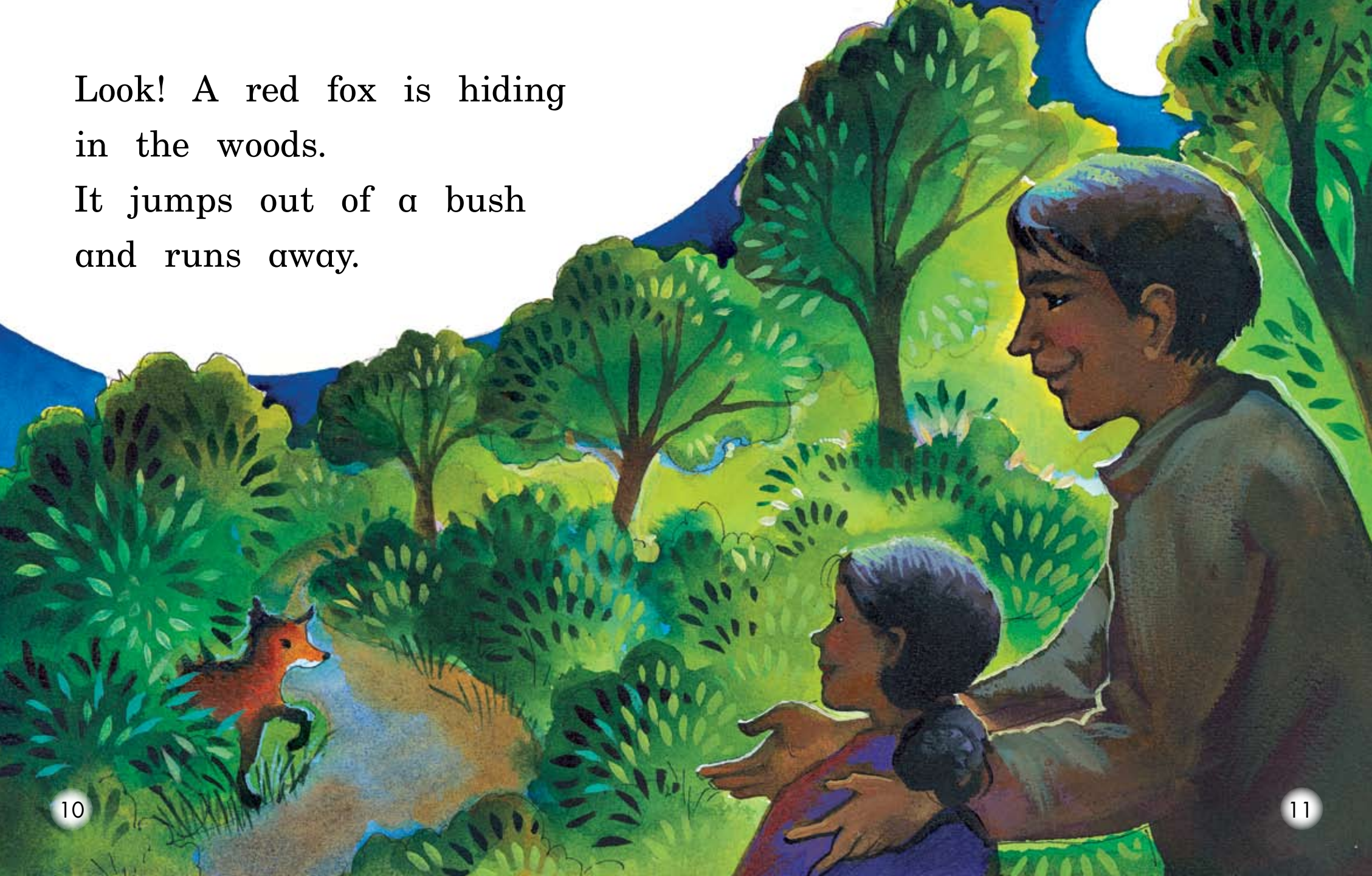
The owl’s yellow eyes

like a mask.

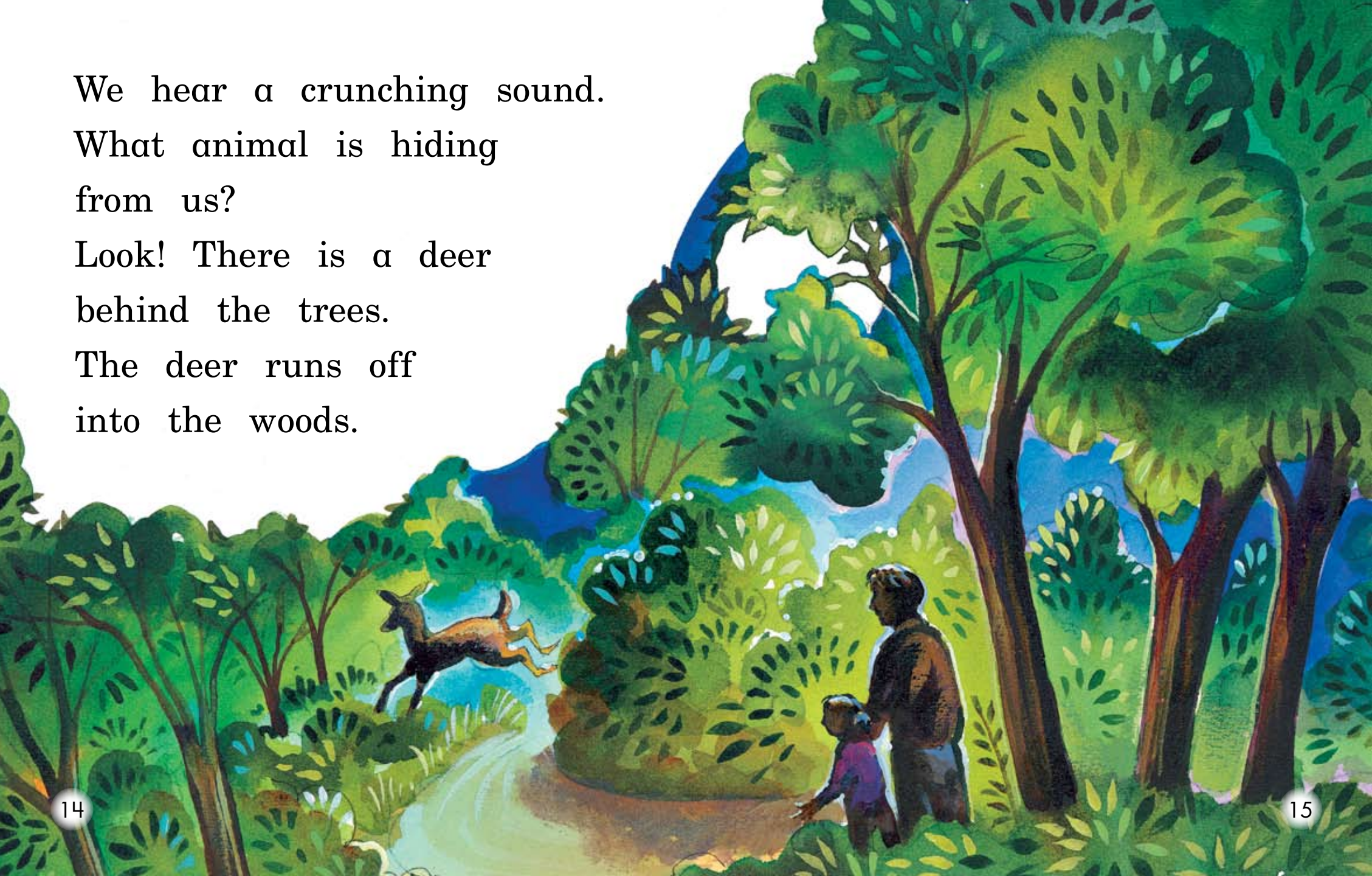


We hear a crunching sound.
