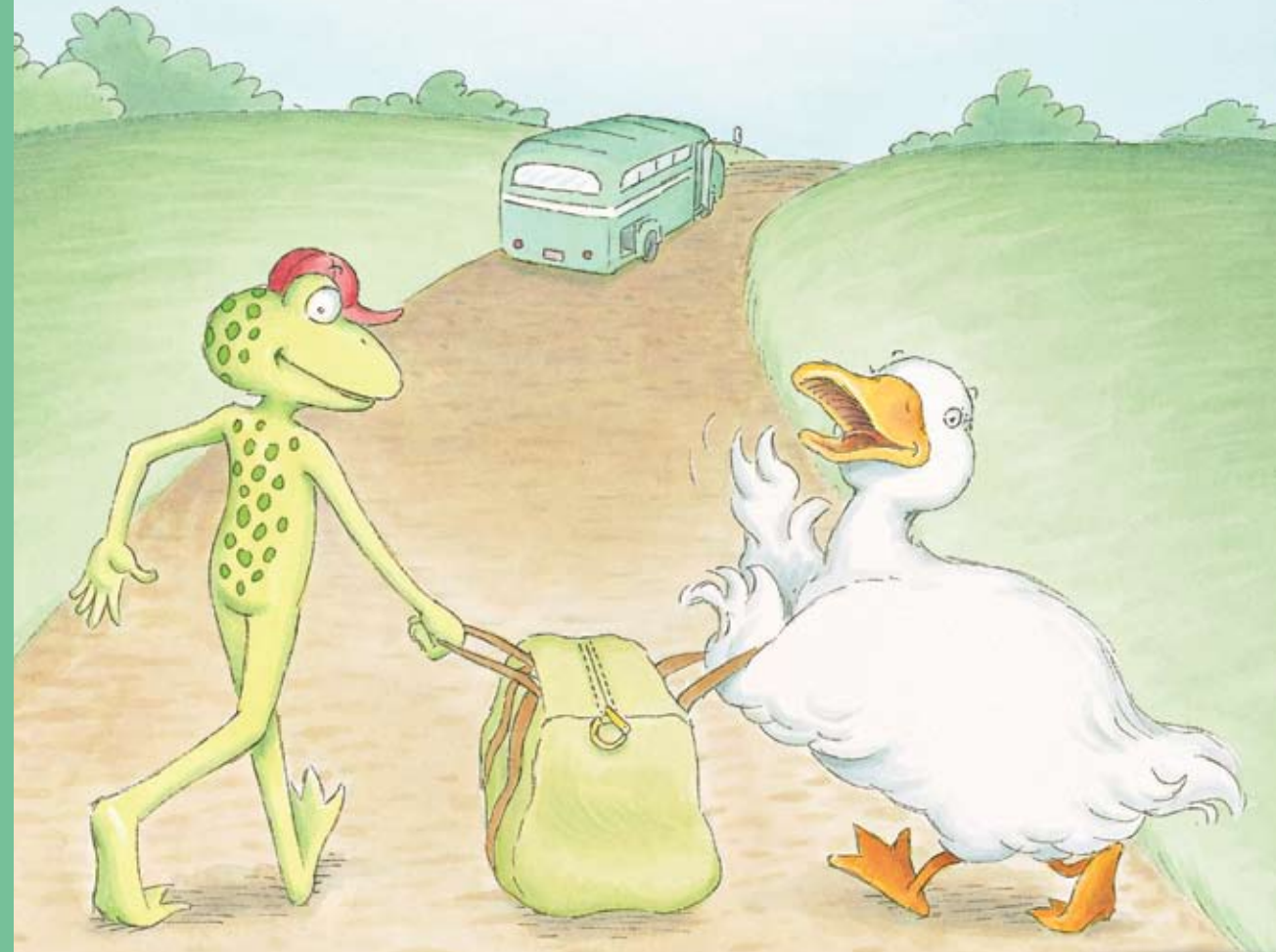

said Duck.

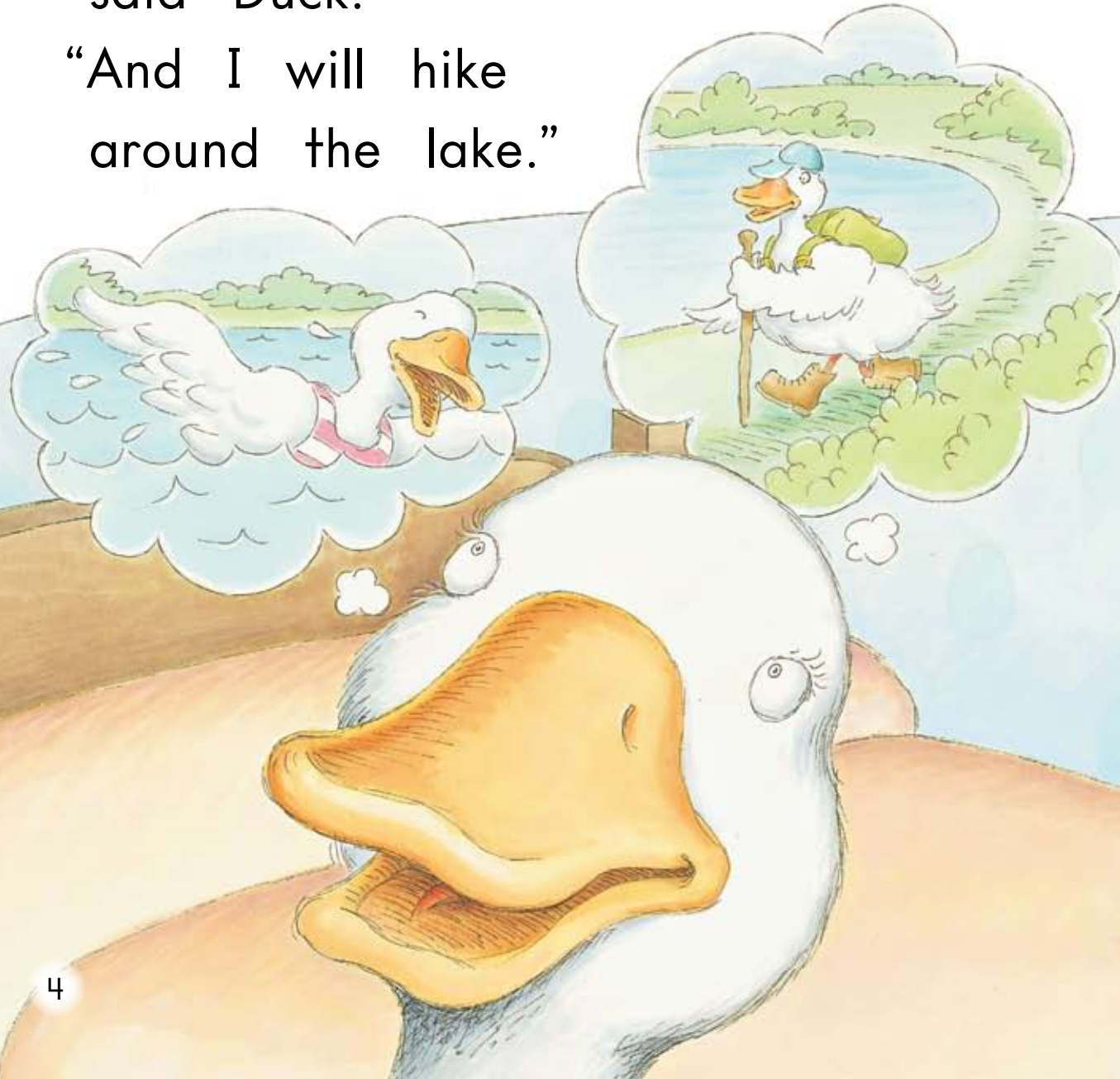
“I **love** lakes!” said Froggy.

said Duck.

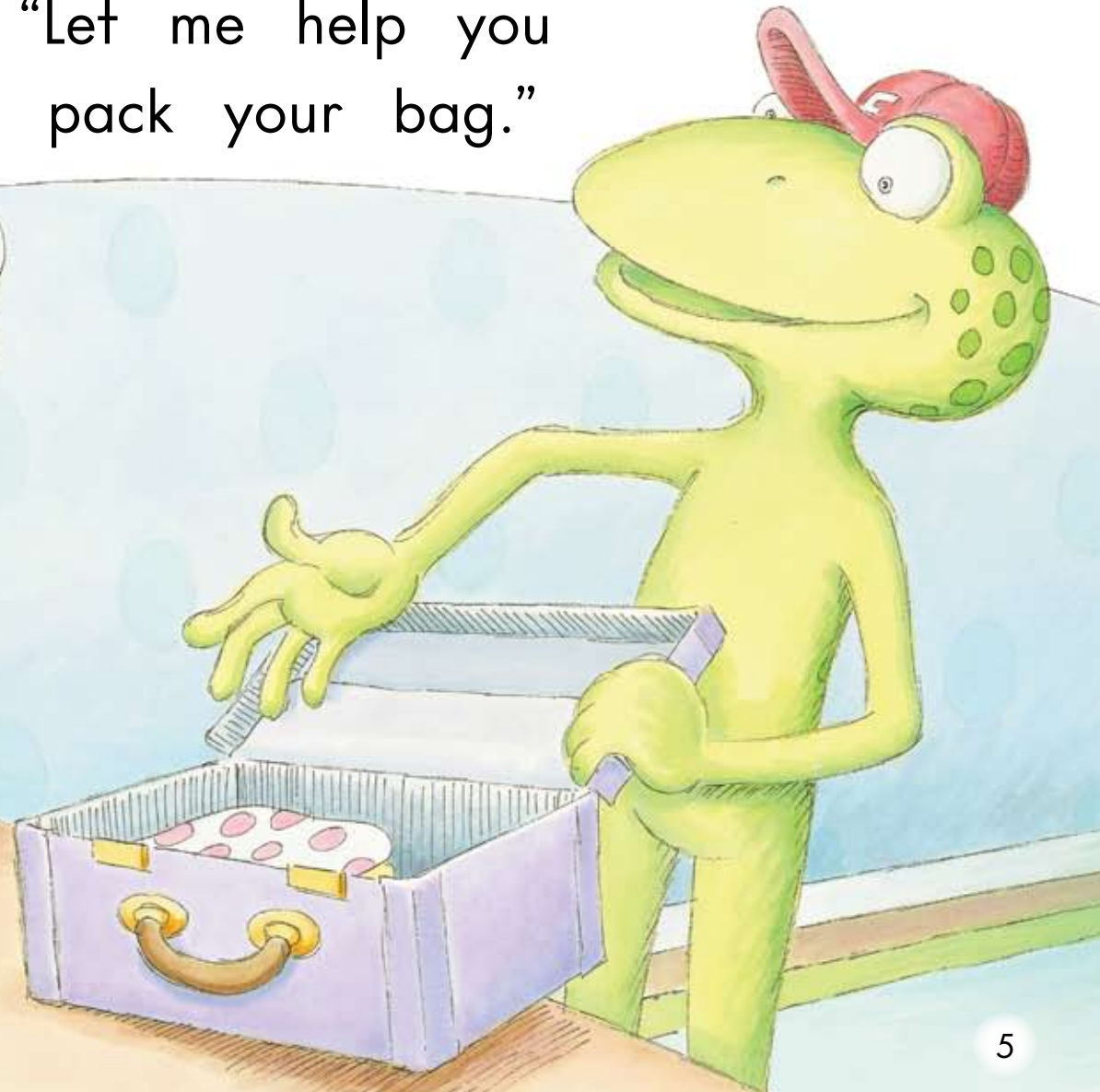
“And I will hike
around the lake.”

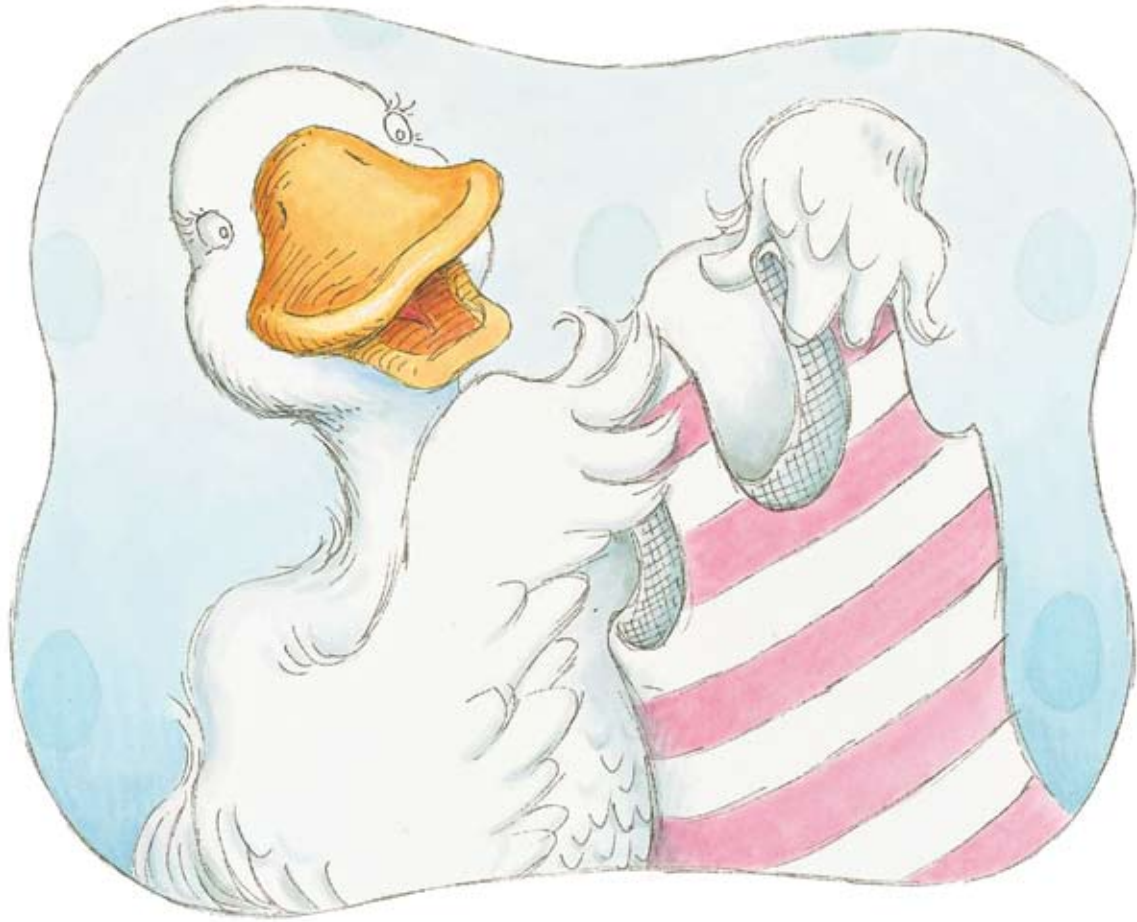


“I **love** to swim and hike,”

pack your bag.”



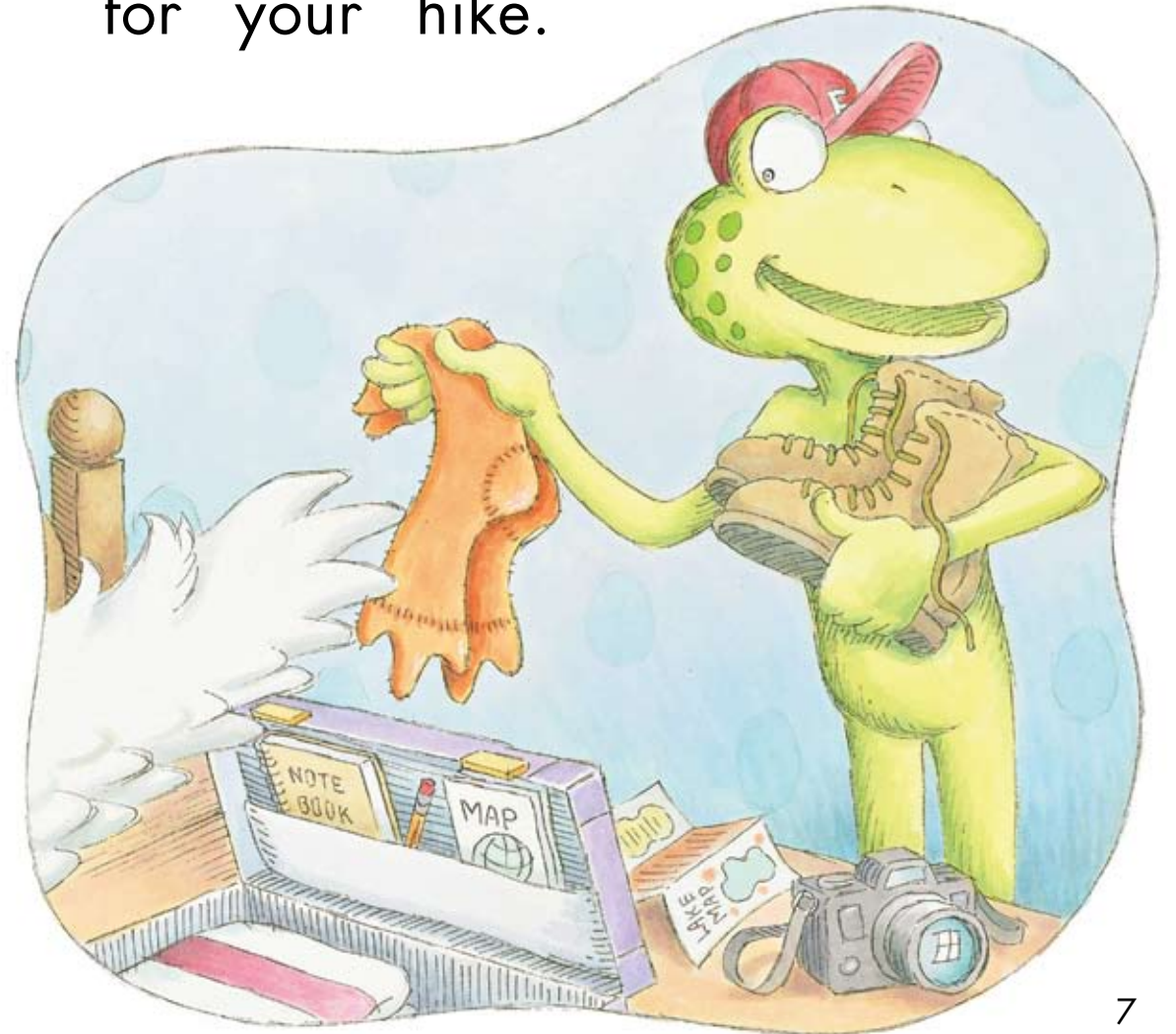


“Here is my bathing suit,”

“You will have so much fun on this trip!” said Froggy.

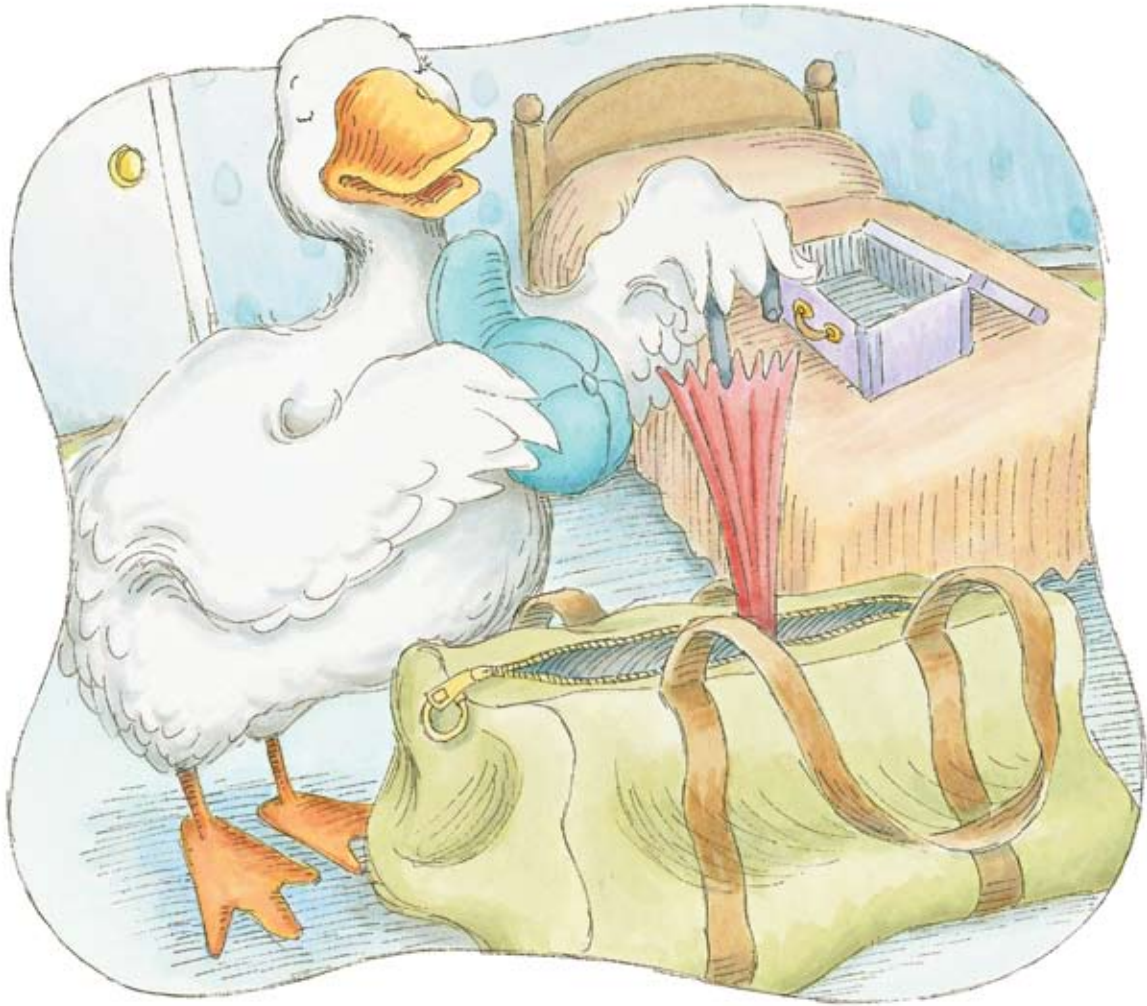
“I wish I could go with you.”

“Let’s get your **big** bag,” said Froggy.

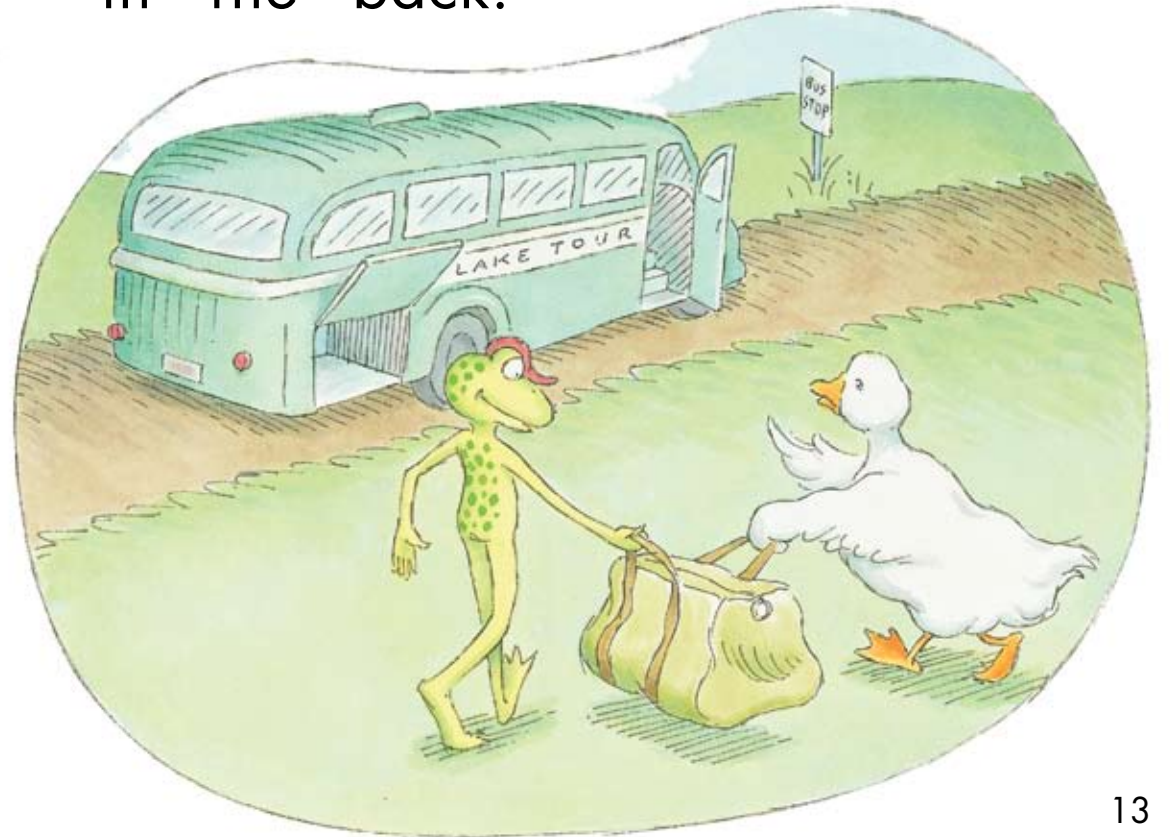
“You have a lot to pack.”

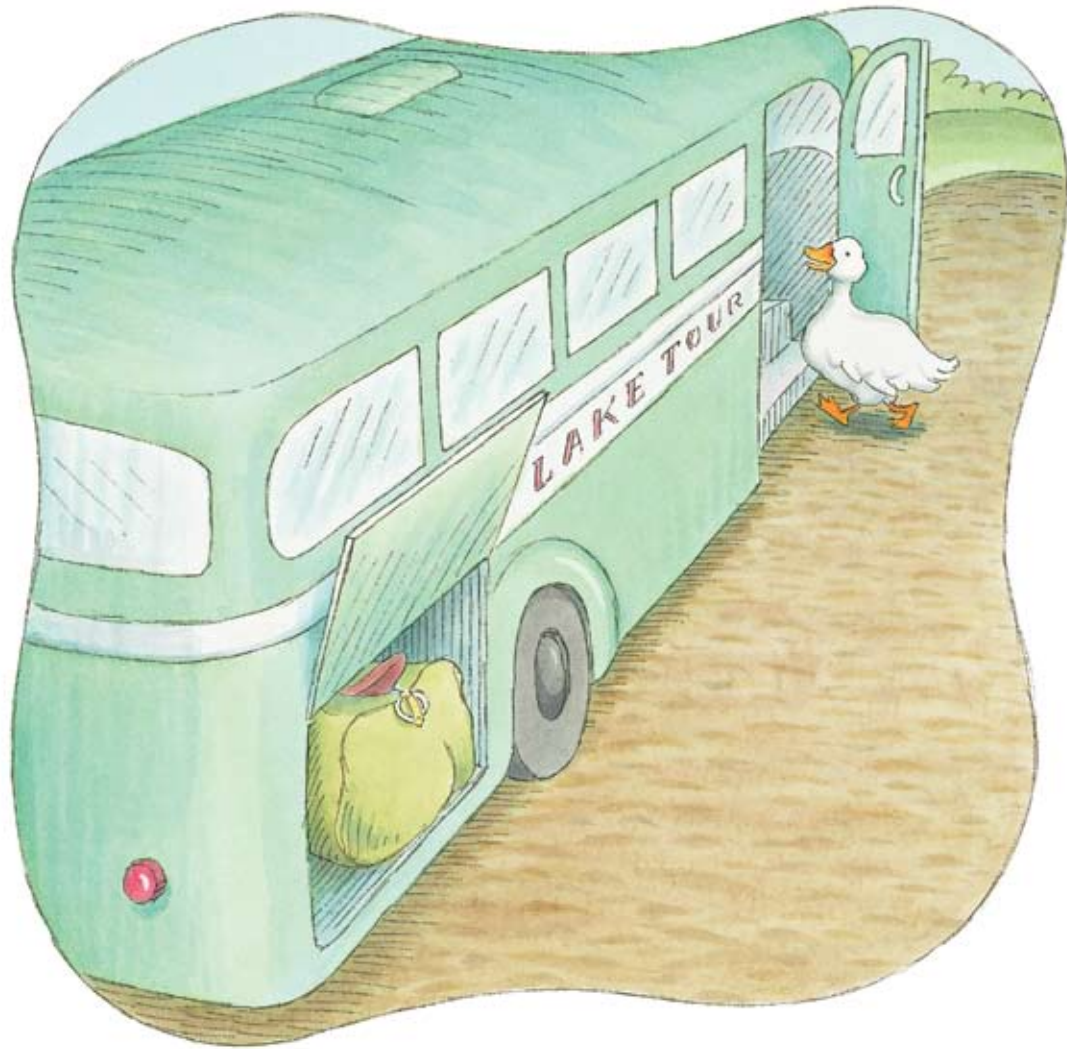




“Here is my hat,” said Duck.
