

all the time.




A great white shark has 5,000 teeth.

Its teeth are long and sharp. This shark can eat and eat and eat!






A great white shark is big But a whale shark is bigger. The whale shark is as long as a bus!





Not all sharks are big. This shark is very small. It is as long as a pencil!










Here are some baby sharks. They are called pups. Shark pups can swim very well.
