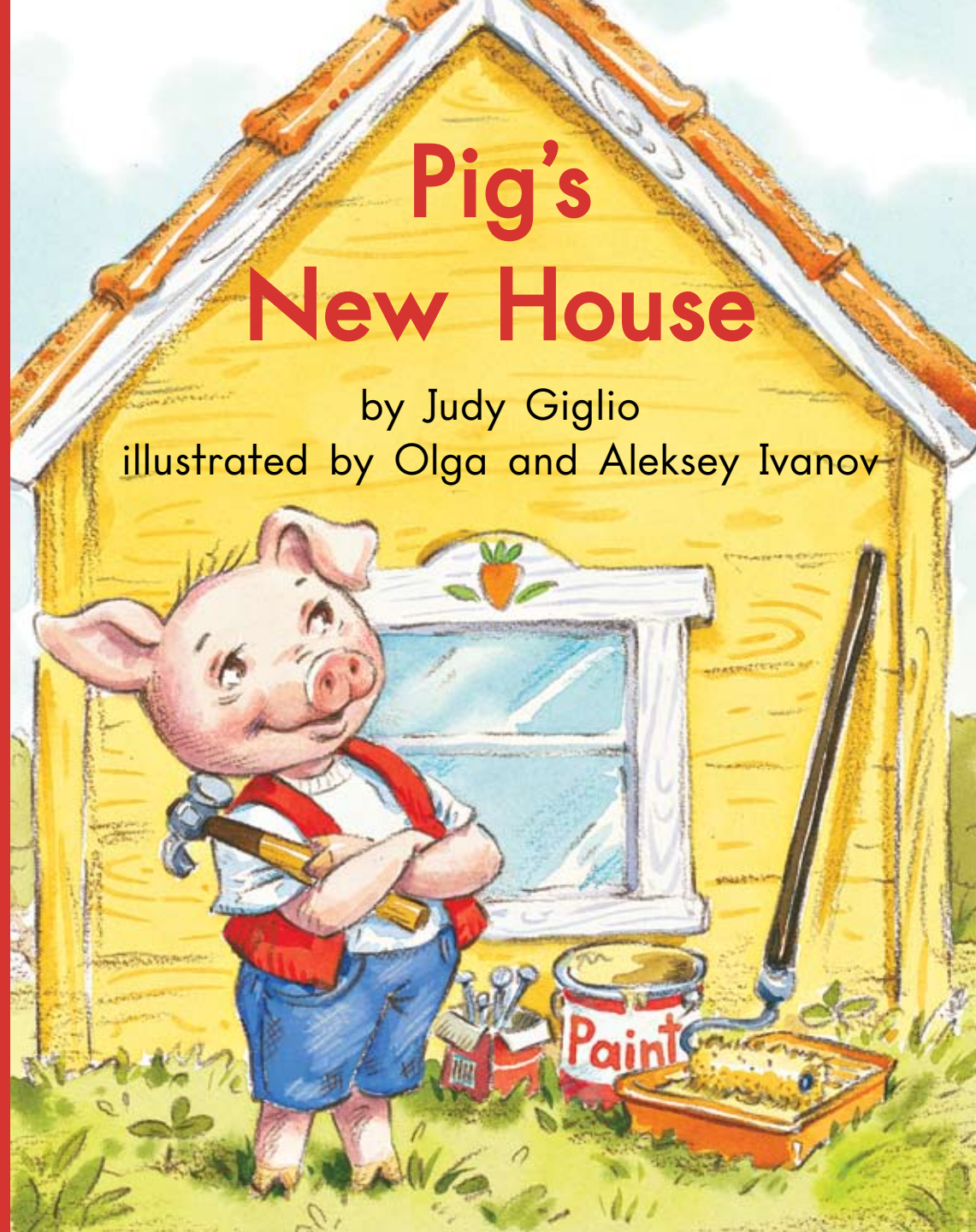

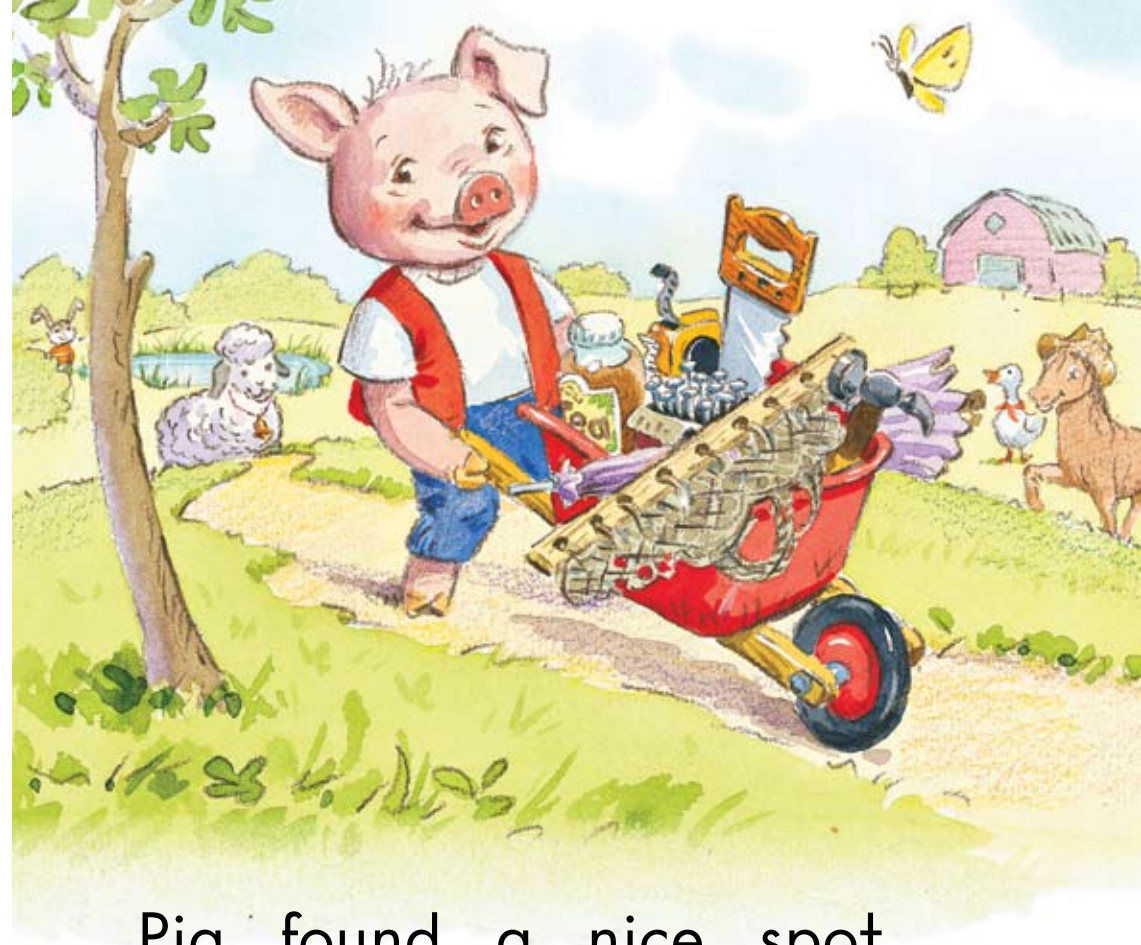
Pig's New House

said Horse.

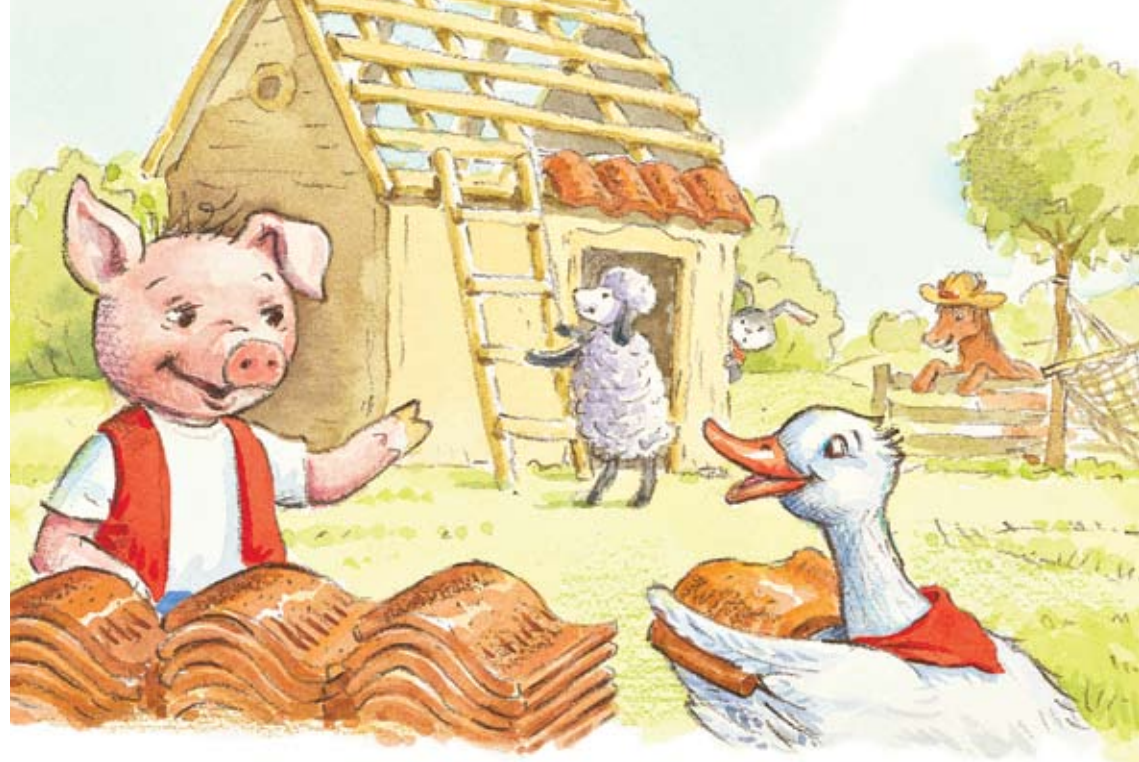
"I can build the walls."
