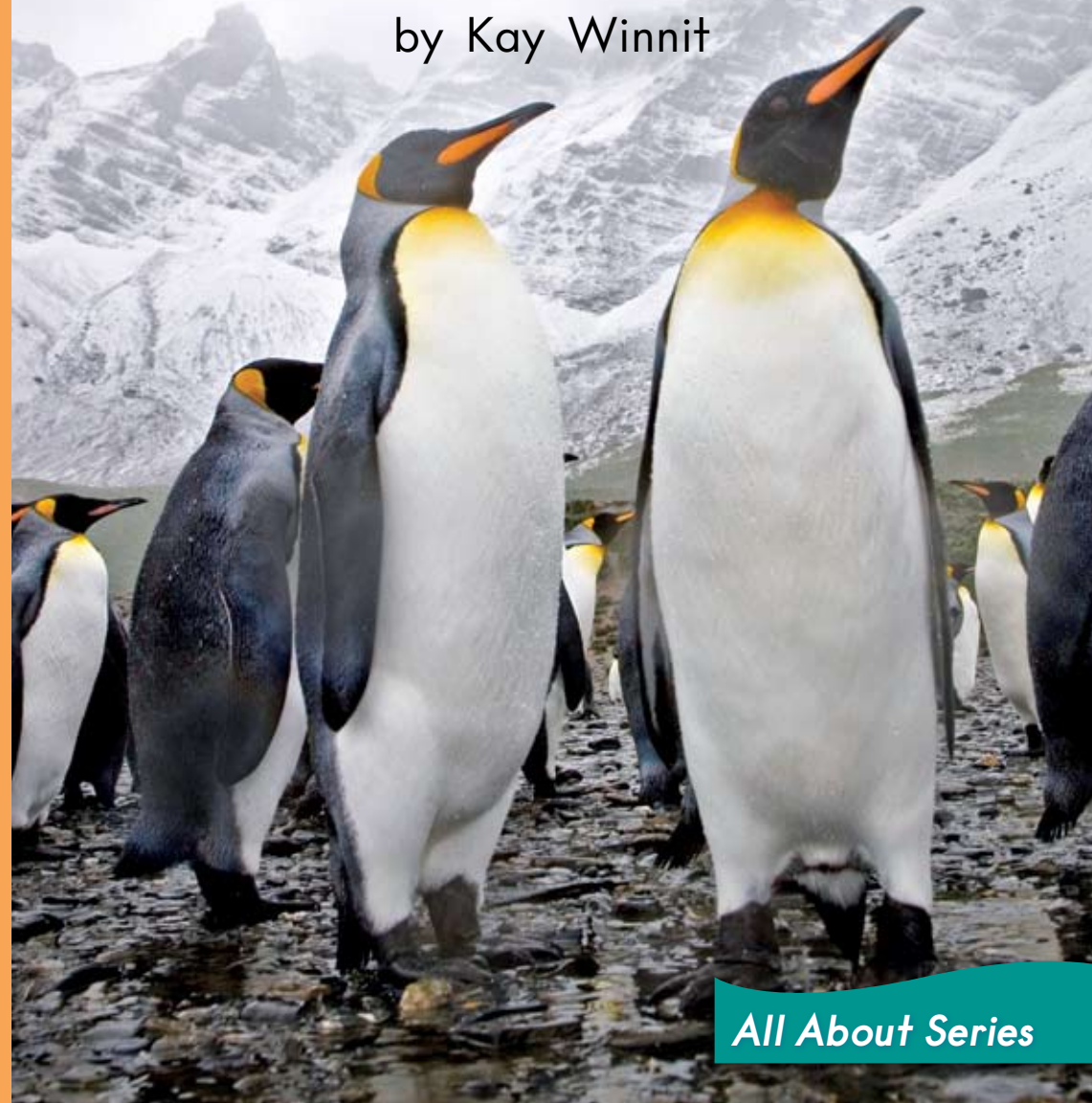

on the ice.



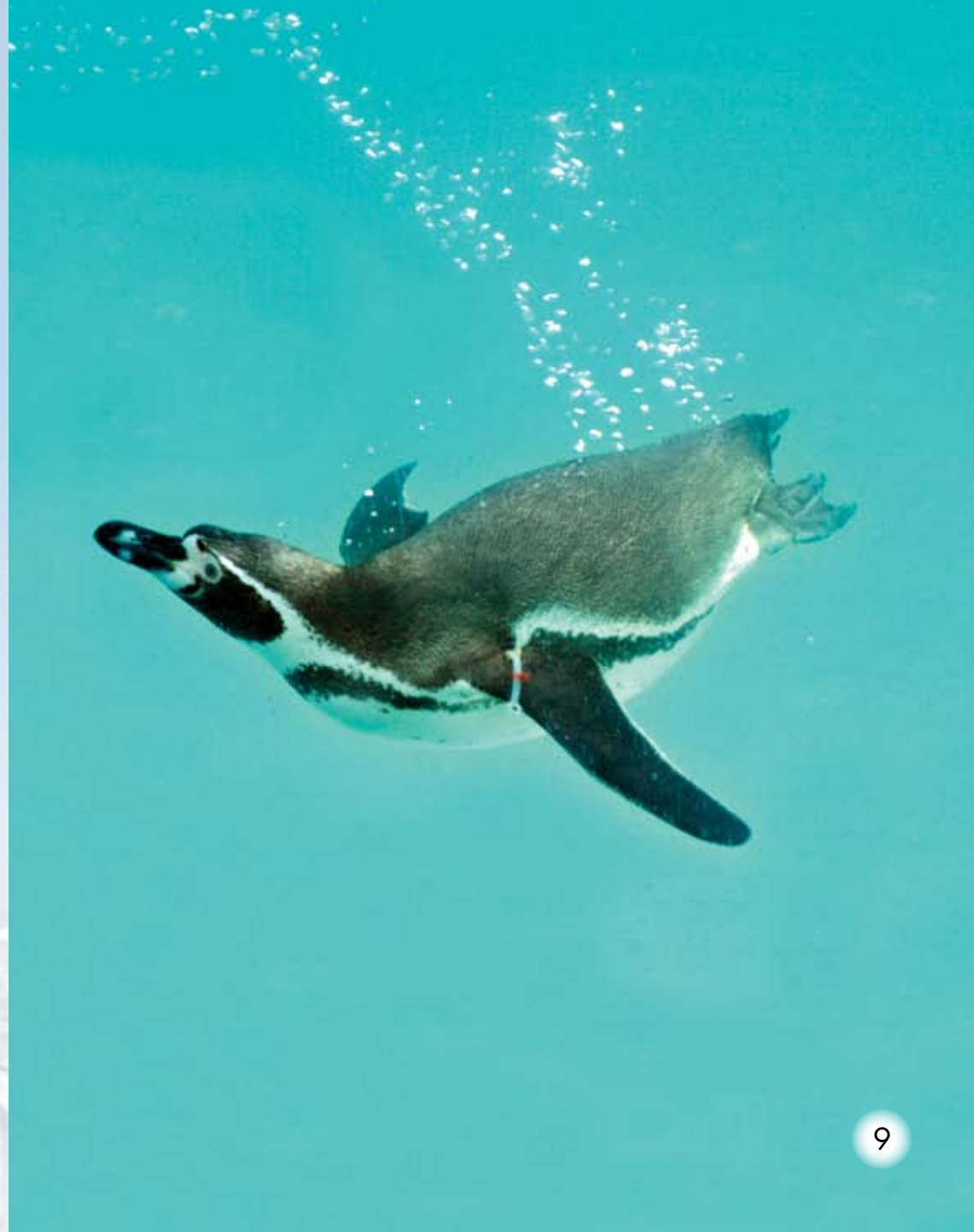
Look at the penguin.
