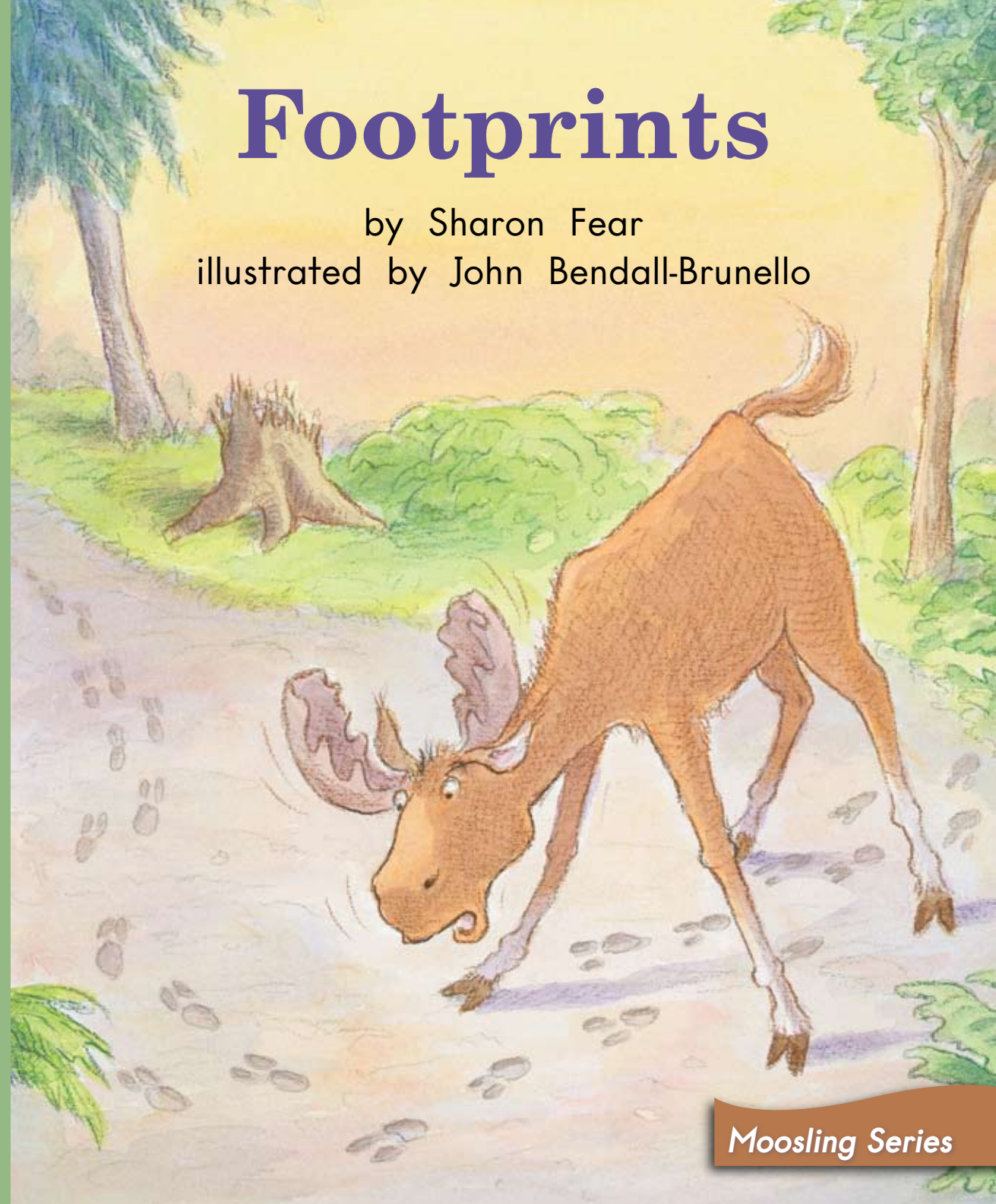

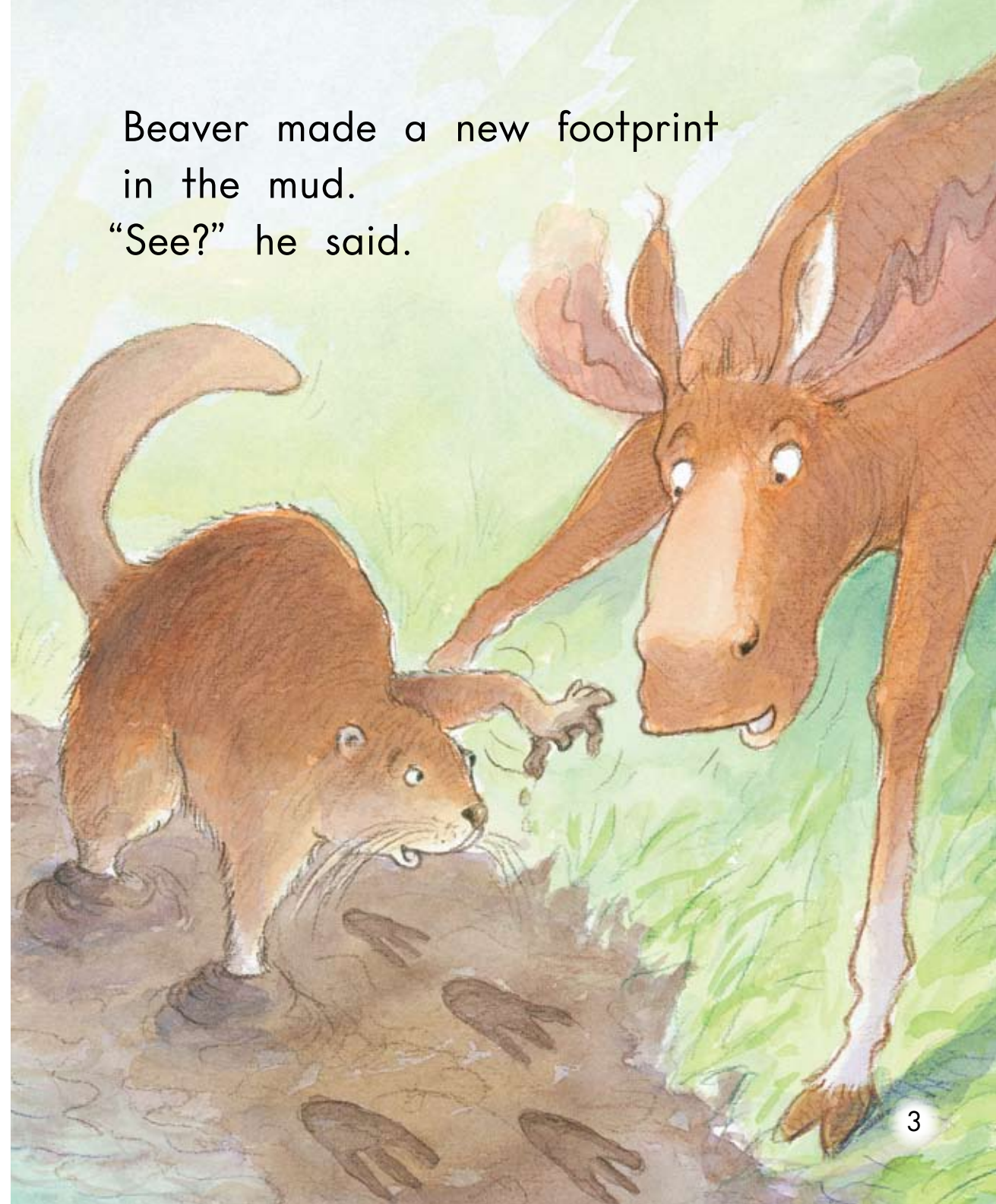


Moosling

“What is that?” asked Moosling.

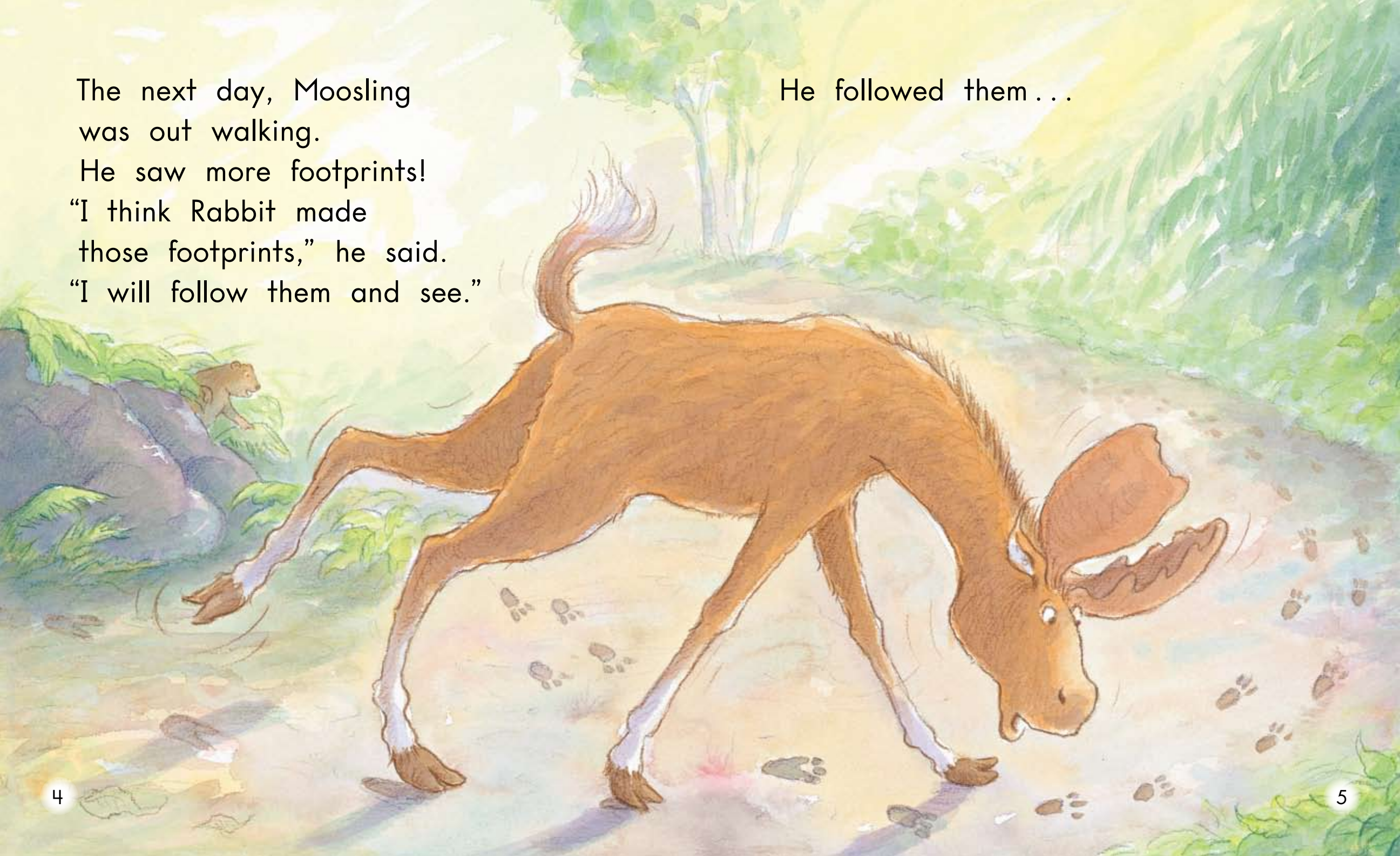
“Those are footprints,” said Beaver.

He followed them...

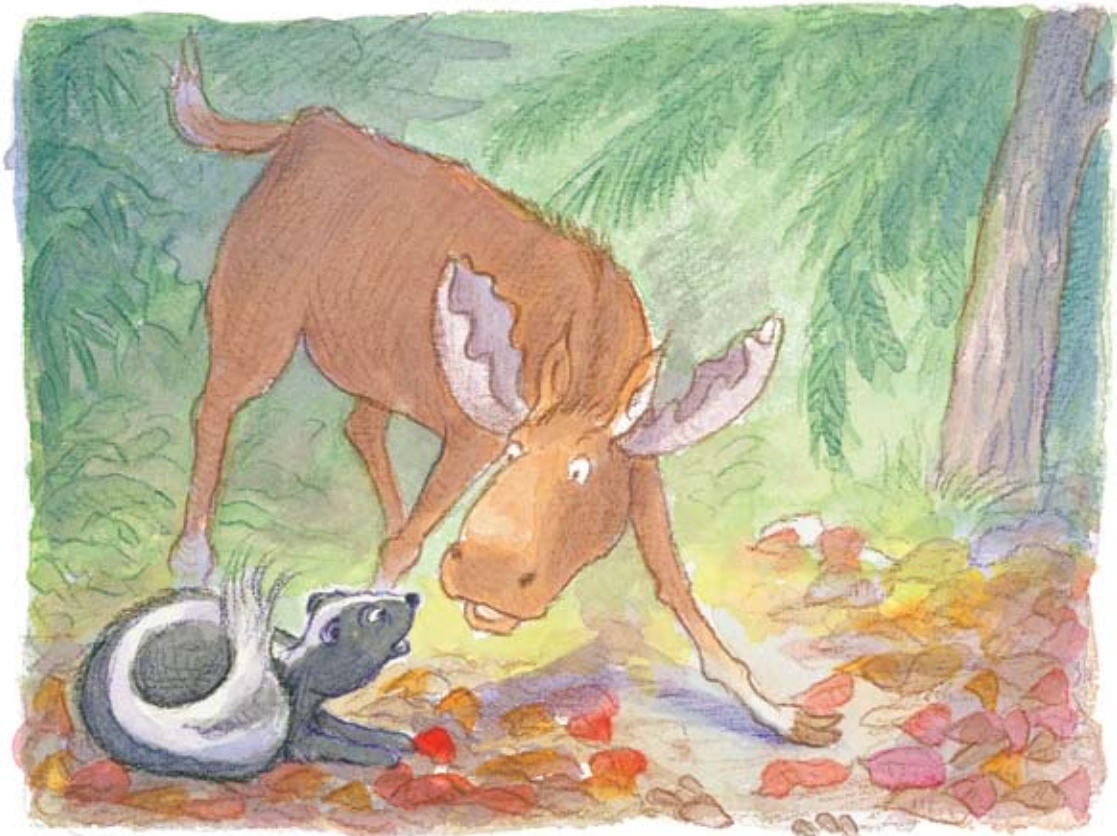




And there was Rabbit!

“You did?” asked Rabbit.

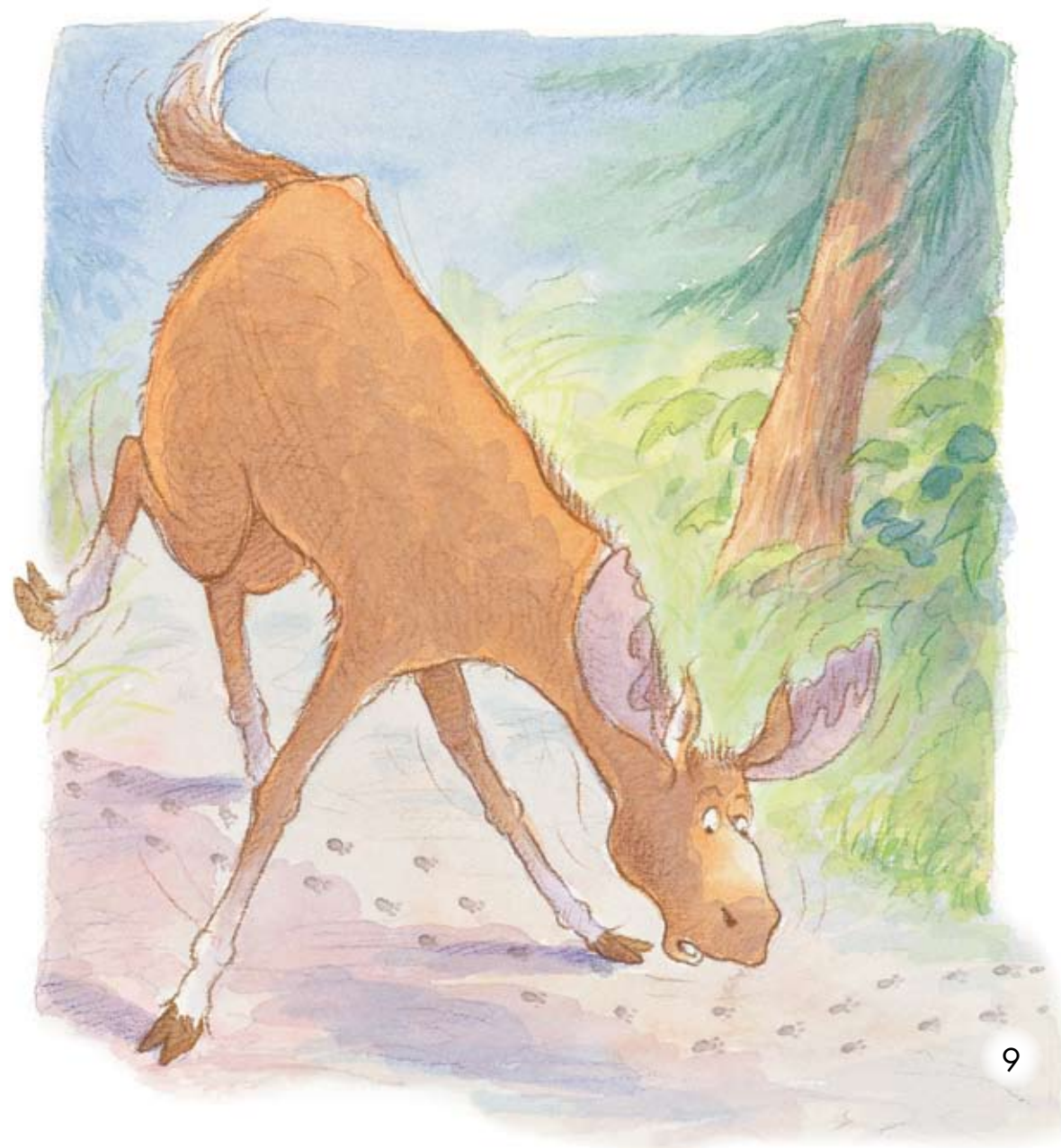
Soon Moosling saw

who had made them.

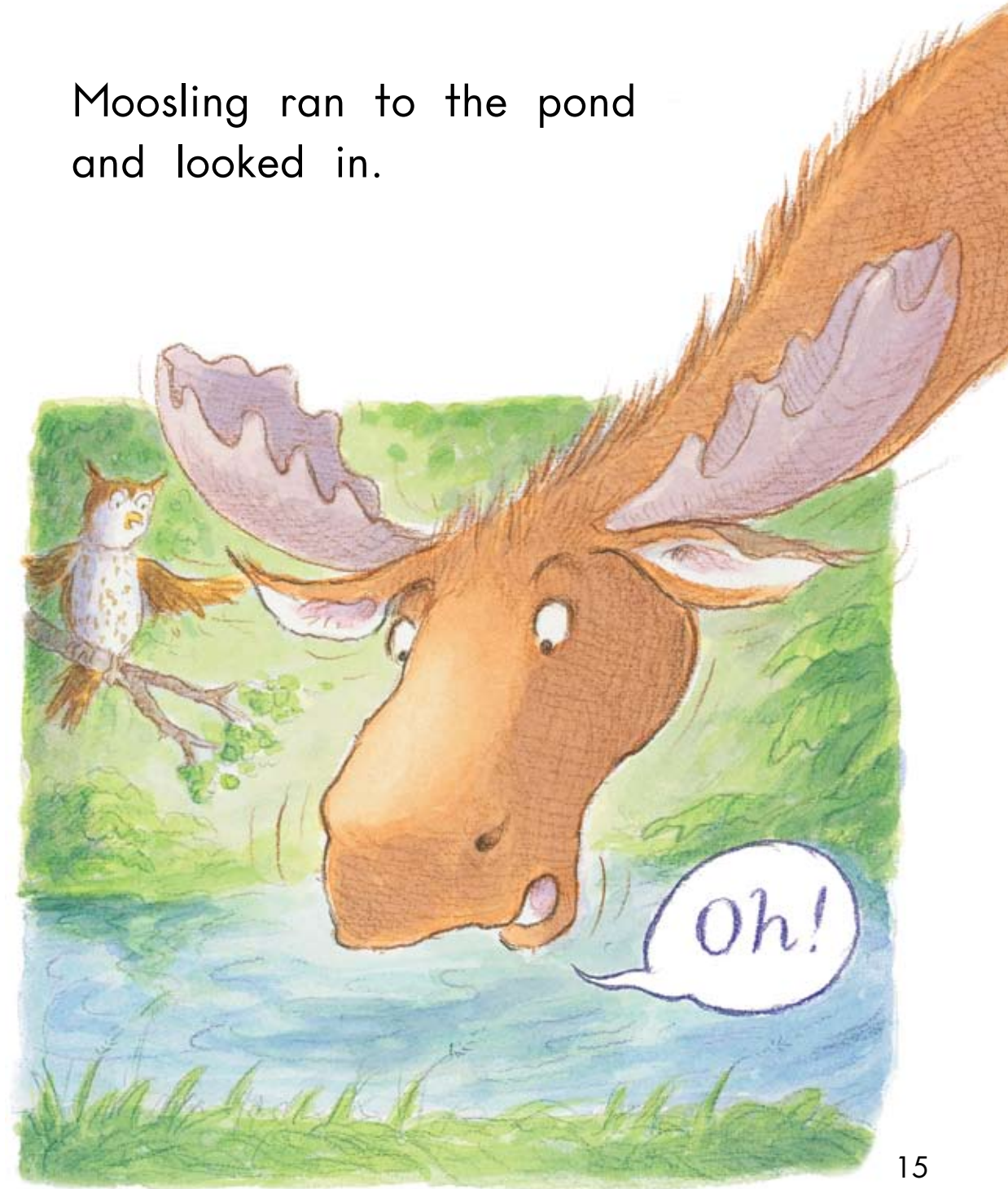




Moosling saw Hoot up in a tree.
