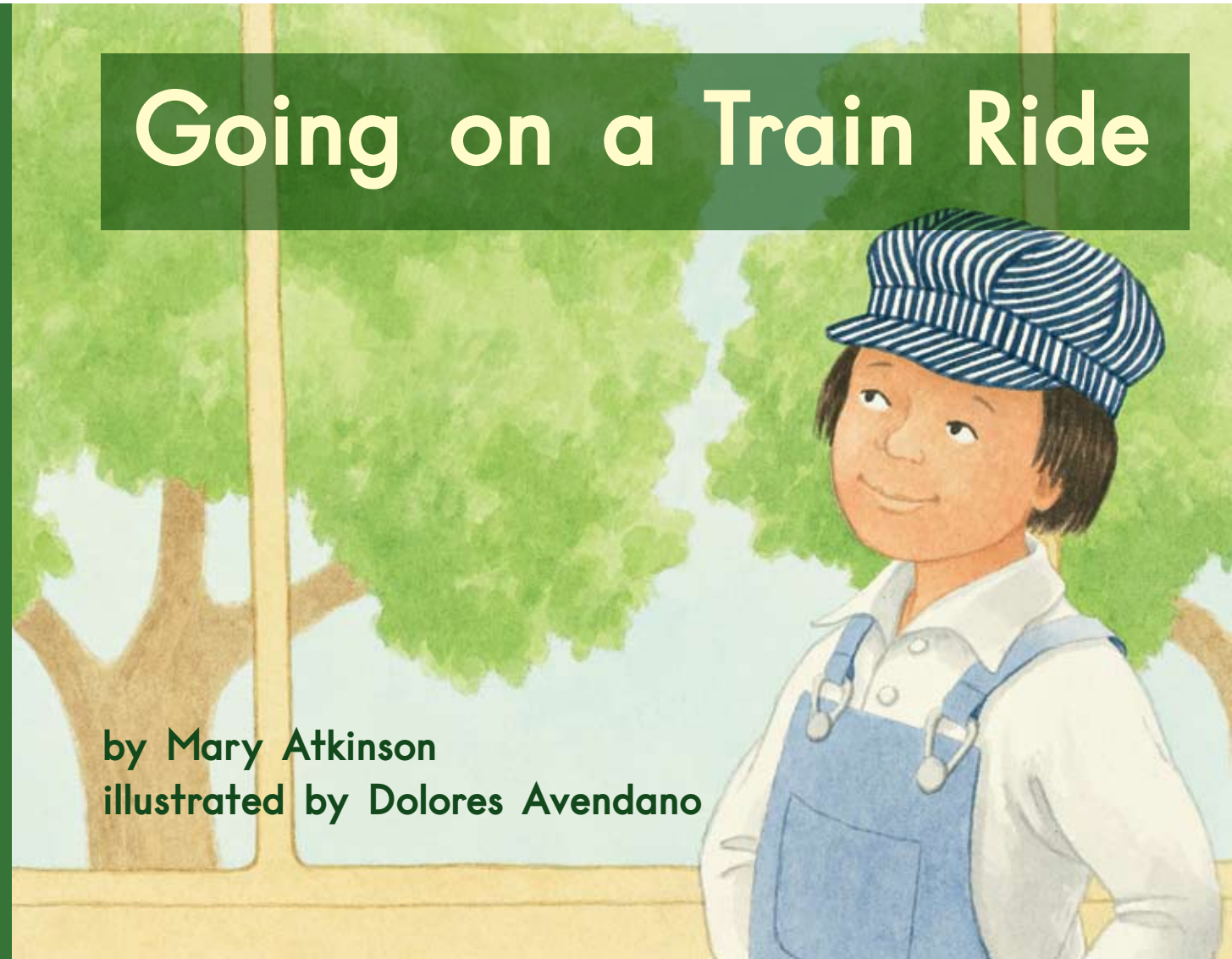

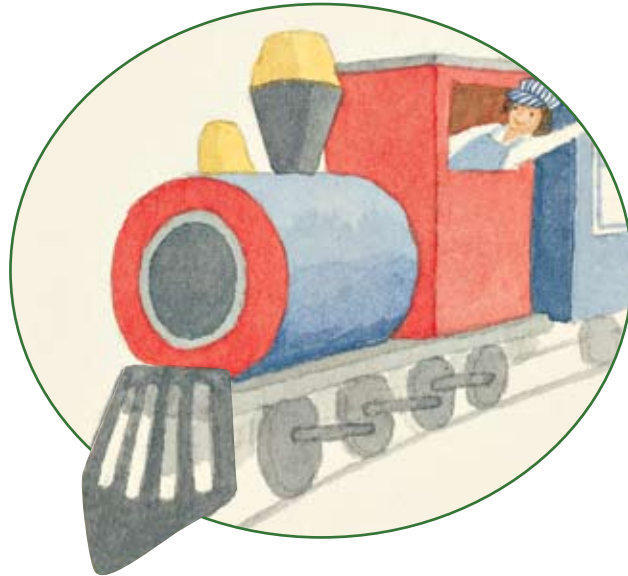

on a train ride.



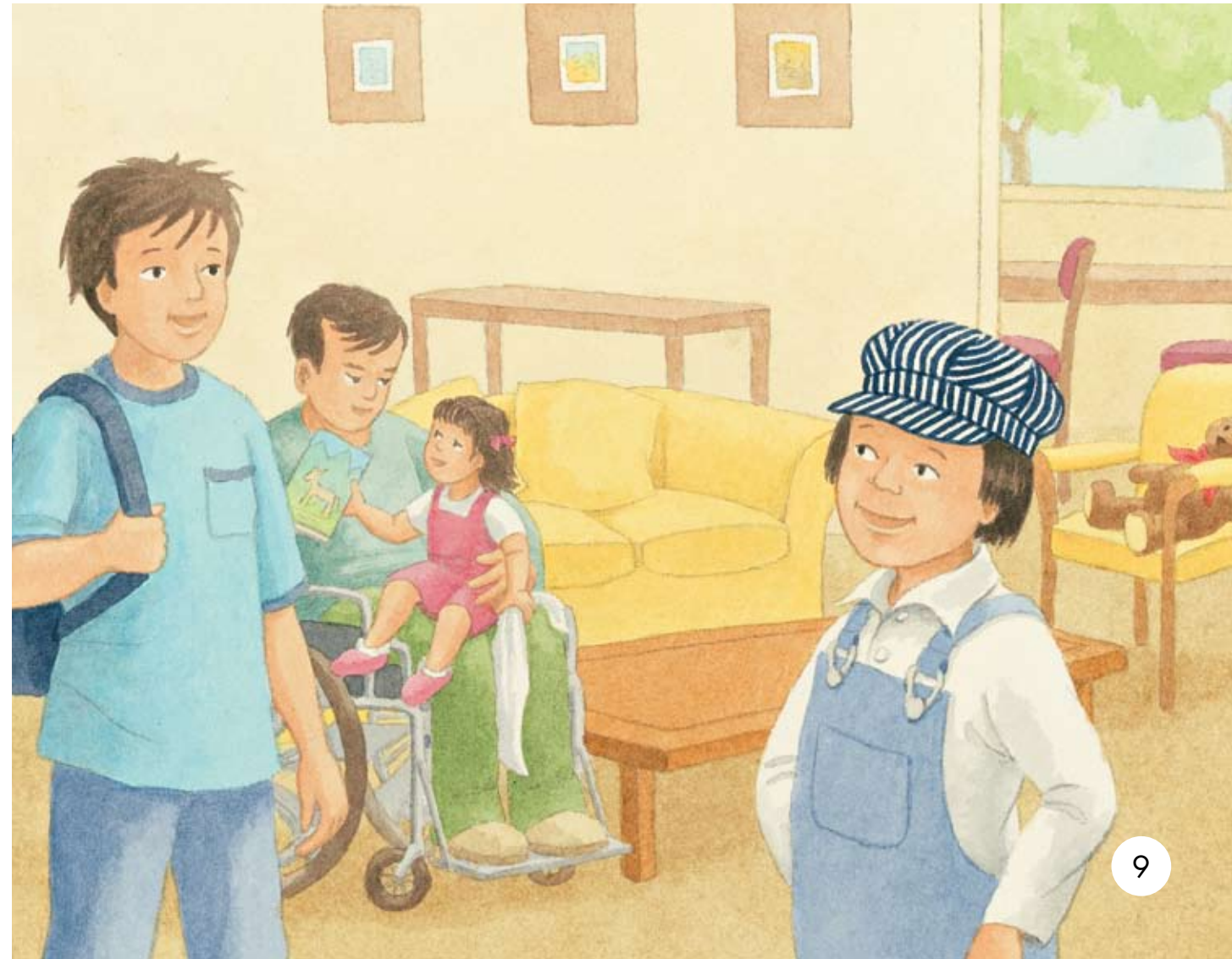
My dad likes trains.
